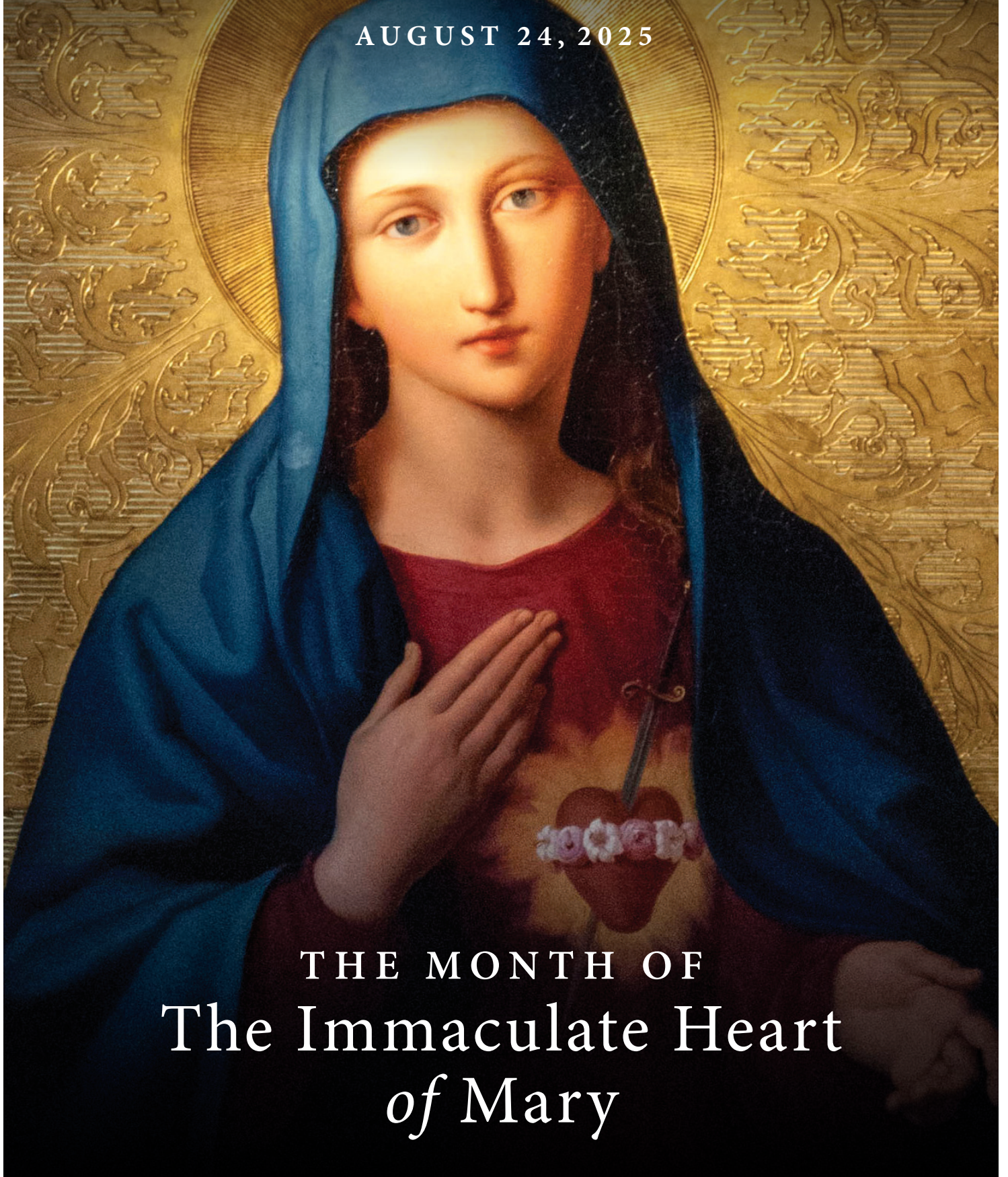

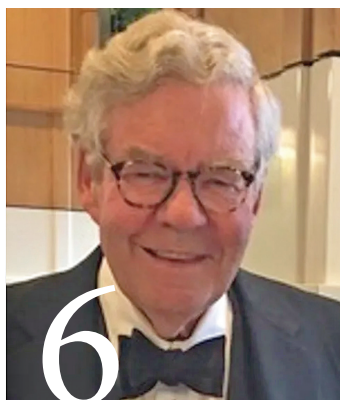



Archbishop Casey on the Mound

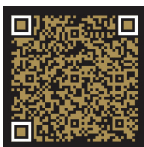

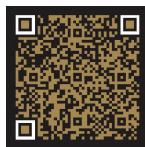
