The Feast of Saint Sebastian

On Tuesday, we celebrate the Feast of St. Sebastian. Evening Prayer will be held on Tuesday, January 20, at 5:30 PM in St. Cecilia Church as we honor this holy martyr. I hope you can join us to pray evening prayer. If you've never been to vespers, we will have a program to assist you. It is a wonderful way to practice praying together with fellow believers. If you haven't heard of St. Sebastian, he was a Roman soldier who courageously supported persecuted Christians. When his faith was discovered, he was brutally tortured and martyred for his steadfast devotion to Christ. Though he endured severe suffering, he remained faithful to the end. St. Sebastian is a powerful witness to perseverance, courage, and integrity in the face of great trials. His example continues to inspire believers to remain strong in faith and to use their gifts in service of God and others. For this reason, he is honored as the patron saint of athletes, soldiers, and police officers, those called to lives of discipline, bravery, and enduring faith.


