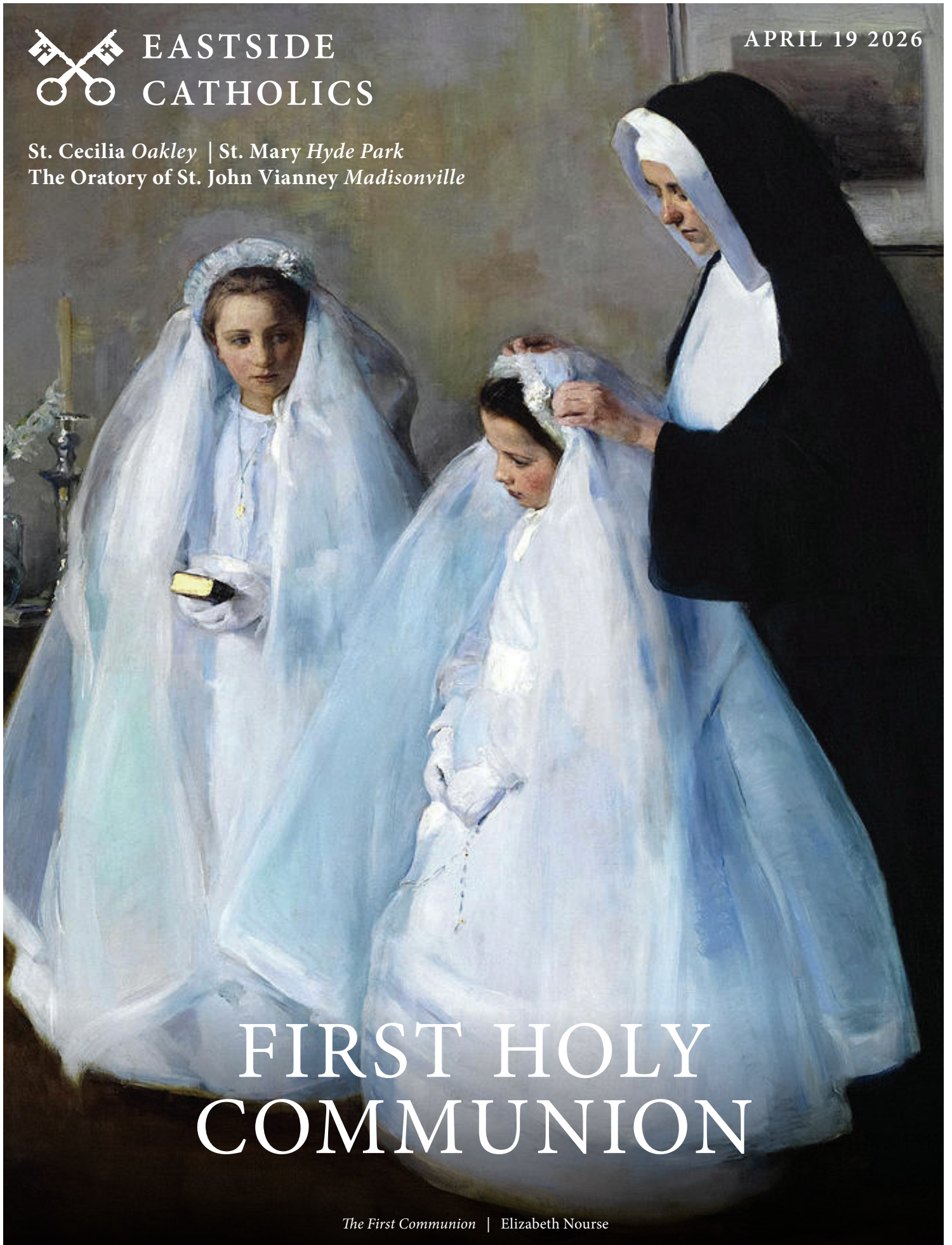


PASTOR'S RAMBLINGS | 5

Because of You

Two weekends ago, many came. Some for the first time in years. Some, unsure of what they would find. Some simply taking a step they didn't expect to take. And when they arrived, they were welcomed. They found a place to sit. A place to pray. A place to begin again. They heard the Word proclaimed. They came to the altar, where Christ gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. And there—often quietly, often gradually—something begins to change. Just as the disciples on the road to Emmaus came to recognize the Risen Lord in the breaking of the bread, many are beginning to recognize His presence again. This does not happen on its own. It happens because a community is present. Because people show up. Because people give—not out of obligation, but as a response to what they have received. Because of you.

For the Pascal Triduum and Easter, The Oratory saw 463 people come to Masses (average weekend attendance is 290), at St. Mary, 1,879 people attended (average weekend attendance is 1,100), and St. Cecilia saw 1,929 in the pews (with 1,400 as the weekend average)

If this place has been meaningful to you—even in a quiet or unexpected way—this may be your next step. Stay. Come back next Sunday. And, when you are ready, consider helping make this possible for someone else.

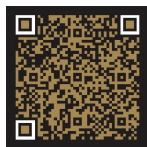

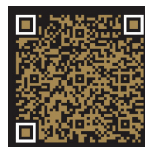


