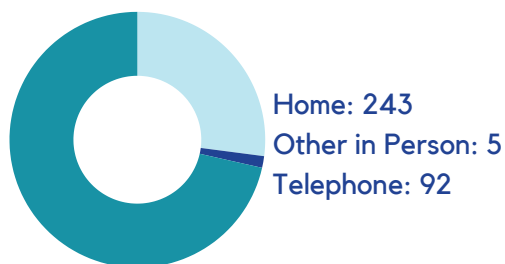

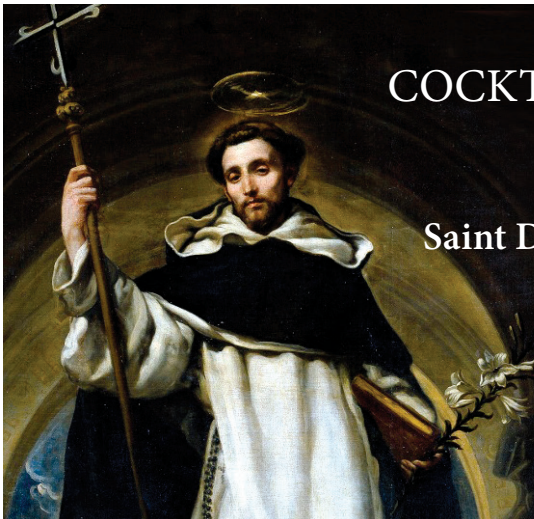

Called and Chosen

In this Sunday's readings, we hear a powerful reminder of who we are and whose we are. In Exodus, God tells His people, "You shall be my special possession... a kingdom of priests, a holy nation." Before asking anything of them, God first reminds them that they are chosen.

The same is true for us. St. Paul writes that "while we were still sinners Christ died for us." God's love is not earned. It is given.

We do not serve in order to be loved; we serve because we have already been loved beyond measure. In the Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds with compassion because they are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." Then He turns to His disciples and sends them into the harvest.

Notice the pattern: God calls. God loves. God sends. Stewardship begins there. Every gift we have—our time, talent, resources, experiences, and faith—has been entrusted to us for a purpose.

We are not merely spectators in God's plan. Each of us has a role to play in helping others encounter Christ. The harvest remains abundant today. There are people searching for hope, community, purpose, healing, and truth. Through a welcoming smile, a volunteer role, a prayer offered for another, a generous gift, or a simple invitation, God continues His work through ordinary disciples.

As members of Eastside Catholics, we are not just attending church. We are called and chosen to help build God's Kingdom together.

May we respond generously to that call.

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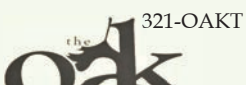
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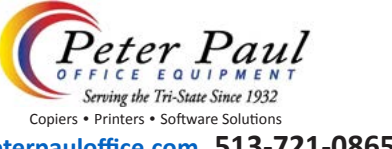
