FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th -12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Is Mary the "Queen of Heaven"?

If Christ were not King, Mary would not be Queen, as all her prerogatives and titles depend upon her being the Mother of the Son of God made Man for our salvation.

Christ succeeded on earth to the throne of King David.

However, unlike David, Christ's kingdom is not an earthly one, but a spiritual and eternal kingdom of truth, righteousness, and peace (Jn 16:36-37, Heb 7:2, Rev 19:6). In that Kingdom Mary sits as Queen, as queen mothers (gebirah) did in ancient Israel before her (1 Kings 2: 13-21). Their office often determined who would be king, how the kingdom would be ruled, and how the kingly favors would be given (cf. Jer. 13:18).

Mary's queenly and maternal reign is in the spiritual realm, however. Her raiment is charity and virtue surpassing all other creatures, and her favors are the graces of her Divine Son to be given to her spiritual children in accordance with His will.

In his 1954 encyclical on Mary's Queenship, *Ad Caeli Reginam*, Pope Pius XII wrote,

From the earliest ages of the Catholic church a Christian people, whether in time of triumph or more especially in time of crisis, has addressed prayers of petition and hymns of praise and veneration to the Queen of Heaven. And never has that hope wavered which they placed in the Mother of the Divine King, Jesus Christ; nor has that faith ever failed by which we are taught that Mary, the Virgin Mother of God, reigns with a mother's solicitude over the entire world, just as she is crowned in heavenly blessedness with the glory of a Queen.

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time FAITH

Our readings today explore how faith begins and how faith works. Faith begins with God's initiative of love, together with God's promise about the future. The passage from Hebrews urges readers to have an assured confidence in God, who promised and delivered a lasting legacy to Abraham. The book of Wisdom reminds readers of the God who promised and delivered freedom from slavery during the Exodus. In the Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus begins with the promise that "your Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom," before describing how to live faithfully during times when God seems absent. God's promises mean that God is fully invested in our future. Living in these promises, we can confidently let go of fear and insecurity. We can anticipate that when God intervenes in our lives, it will be for our benefit. And we can become God's partners in fulfilling these divine promises. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

***** All three Persons of the Most Blessed Trinity were present at the Transfiguration. St. Thomas Aquinas said, "The whole Trinity appeared: the Father in the voice; the Son in the man; the Spirit in the shining cloud."

What happened in the Assumption of Mary?

CCC 966 "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death" (Pope Pius XII, *Munificentissimus Deus*). The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians: In giving birth you kept your virginity; in your Dormition you did not leave the world, O Mother of God, but were joined to the source of Life. You conceived the living God and, by your prayers, will deliver our souls from death (Byzantine Liturgy, Troparion, Feast of the Dormition).

DESM UPDATE

In June DESM hosted Camp Rainbow, a week long day camp for children who have experienced the death of a loved one. This event was attended by 35 children, 8 youth and 9 adult volunteers. This was a great experience for all involved. The DESM food pantry served 776 families which is equivalent to 2611 individuals for the month of June. With the rising cost of food, new clients are being served each week. The ESL classes continue to meet on Tuesday evenings during the summer in the E room located on the northwest corner of the pastoral center. The police department has been very thankful for the bags that they are distributing to people who are coming to the police station in need of assistance.

If you feel called to donate to the police department bags, we could use small tubes of toothpaste, individually wrapped toothbrushes, deodorant, small packages of kleenex and small tubes of lotion. We currently have plenty of socks and hand sanitizer. If you feel called to donate to the DESM food pantry, we could use canned corn, canned green beans, tomato sauce and tuna.

What does the Assumption of Mary teach us?

In a homily for the Assumption, Pope St. John Paul II said, "Taken up into Heaven, Mary shows us the way to God, the way to Heaven, the way to life. She shows it to her children baptized in Christ and to all people of good will. She opens this way especially to the little ones and to the poor, those who are dear to divine mercy. The Queen of the world reveals to individuals and to nations the power of the love of God...."

Our Parish offers our condolences for the loss of Lorenzo Gutierrez to his wife Lorena, sons, parents and family. May God give them peace and comfort in this difficult moment.

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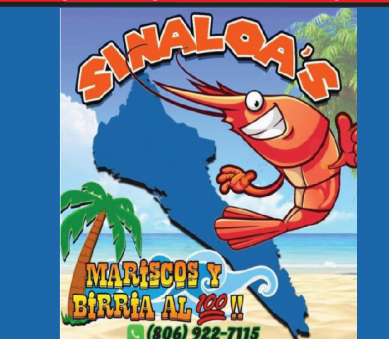
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
