FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Question:

What is Lectio Divina, and how is it associated with the Benedictine Monastic tradition, whose founder, St. Benedict, we honor on July 11?

Answer:

Benedict desired his monks to live in community, praying the Liturgy of the Hours together, contemplating sacred texts, and doing manual labor. The monks developed a technique to facilitate a spiritual and devotional reading of the Bible known as Lectio Divina, the holy reading of a text. This method encourages the reader to hear the biblical text with an open heart and focus on whatever God wants to highlight and then apply it to daily life.

There are variations on Lectio Divina, but essentially, the technique consists of a three-step process of reflection. When the reflection is done with a group, the responses are shared by all the participants. Once the text is selected, it is read meditatively, and the following are then explored: a word or phrase that attracts you; how and where the content of this reading touches your life today; what you believe that God wants you to do during this coming week (month, year, lifetime). Thanks to Benedict, the Christian community has been gifted with this special way of entering into the biblical text. This week, use the Lectio Divina process on one of the readings for the coming Sunday and make a note of the life connections you are making. How is this reflection on the biblical text drawing you closer to God and others?

Pregunta:

¿Qué es la Lectio Divina y cómo se asocia con la tradición monástica benedictina, cuyo fundador, San Benito, honramos el 11 de julio?

Respuesta:

Benedicto deseaba que sus monjes vivieran en comunidad, rezando juntos la Liturgia de las Horas, contemplando los textos sagrados y realizando trabajos manuales. Los monjes desarrollaron una técnica para facilitar una lectura espiritual y devocional de la Biblia conocida como Lectio Divina, la lectura sagrada de un texto. Este método alienta al lector a escuchar el texto bíblico con un corazón abierto y enfocarse en lo que Dios quiere resaltar y luego aplicarlo a la vida diaria.

Hay variaciones de la Lectio Divina, pero esencialmente, la técnica consiste en un proceso de reflexión de tres pasos. Cuando la reflexión se hace en grupo, las respuestas son compartidas por todos los participantes. Una vez seleccionado el texto, se lee meditativamente y luego se explora: una palabra o frase que te atraiga; cómo y dónde el contenido de esta lectura toca tu vida hoy; lo que crees que Dios quiere que hagas durante la próxima semana (mes, año, vida).

Gracias a Benedicto, la comunidad cristiana ha sido dotada de esta manera especial de entrar en el texto bíblico. Esta semana, usa el proceso de la Lectio Divina en una de las lecturas del próximo domingo y toma nota de las conexiones de vida que estás haciendo. ¿De qué manera esta reflexión sobre el texto bíblico te acerca a Dios y a los demás?

When I was in middle school, there were times I didn't want my fellow students to see my parents drop me off or pick me up in the school parking lot. I was embarrassed of my parents. Why? I have no idea. Maybe it was our station wagon. Or I didn't want to look like a little kid. But in retrospect that was a silly thing to do. I was a kid. And I had two parents who loved me and had built a wonderful family. I was afraid of the other kids' judgment. How silly! I should have been afraid of forgetting or downplaying my family, which is where my identity had its deep roots.

This is a way to understand Jesus' words to his disciples this Sunday, when he says, "Don't be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna." Fear, in this sense, refers to where we find our deepest identity and our highest love. That's why Jesus says next that when we acknowledge him before others, he will acknowledge us before the Father. It doesn't mean we're brash or boastful. But rather we unhesitatingly and humbly embrace our identity as followers of Jesus and children of God the Father. After all, if we love who we are and where we come from, who cares what the other kids think about us?
