FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Everyday Stewardship

Art Buchwald, the longtime humorist for the Washington Post who died in 2007 is credited with saying, "The best things in life aren't things." As Christians, we know this statement to be true. Certainly the best things in our lives are not those items that money can buy or things we can create in the material world. Faith, hope, and love are more precious than anything we can see with our eyes. Yet, as humans we often find ourselves longing for the very things that we claim are not nearly as valuable. We lose sight of what is real and true.

Paul wrote in the fourth chapter of his Letter to the Philippians that he has experienced both living with abundance and then with very little. Regardless of what we have in terms of worldly goods, Paul reminds us that God provides for all our needs. God may not provide for our wants, but he does give us what we need.

The flesh seeks what it wants, but the spirit seeks what it needs. In a stewardship way of life, we must always remind ourselves that true wealth never comes from material possessions and money. True wealth comes from the love we share, the faith we develop, and the hope we bring to others. The best things in life aren't free, though. They require work, commitment, and fortitude. We need to cultivate these things daily. If we are serious about living life in this way, we will find that when our days on this earth are through, we really had it all.

La corresponsabilidad diaria

Art Buchwald era un cómico estadounidense que trabajaba por el "Washington Post" y murió en 2007. A él le atribuye este dicho: "Las mejores cosas de la vida no son cosas". Como cristianos, sabemos que esto es verdad. Ciertamente, las mejores cosas de nuestras vidas no son cosas que podemos comprar ni las que se hacen en este mundo material. La fe, la esperanza y el amor son cosas más preciosas que cualquier cosa que podamos ver con nuestros ojos. Sin embargo, como humanos, muchas veces deseamos tener esas cosas que sabemos ser no tan valiosas.

Pablo escribió en el cuarto capítulo de su Carta a los Filipenses que él había experimentado vivir con una abundancia de cosas y vivir con muy poco. A pesar de las posesiones que tenemos, Pablo nos recuerda que Dios provee por nuestras necesidades. Dios quizás no nos da todo lo que deseamos pero sí nos da todo lo que necesitamos.

La carne busca lo que quiere pero el espíritu busca lo que necesita. En la vida del discipulado corresponsable, debemos recordarnos que la verdadera riqueza nunca se logra con cosas materiales ni con el dinero. La riqueza verdadera llega del amor que compartimos, la fe que desarrollamos y la esperanza que llevamos al mundo. Sin embargo, las mejores cosas no son gratis. Requieren trabajo, compromiso y fuerza. Necesitamos cultivar esas cosas diariamente. Si verdaderamente vivimos así nuestras vidas, nos daremos cuenta de que al fin de nuestras vidas lo tuvimos todo.

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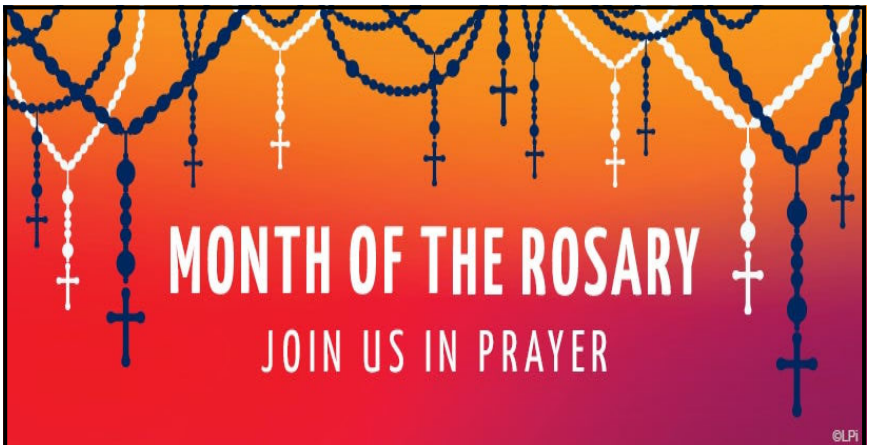
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
