FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April.

These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! BIRTHDAYS

Question:

What do the colors of the priest's and deacon's vestments mean?

Answer:

In the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church, the colors of the vestments evolved over the course of several centuries and there was wide variation both in the colors used, and in the feasts and seasons associated with particular colors. It was Pope Innocent III (d. 1216) who gave us the basic outline that was later prescribed by Pope Saint Pius V in 1570. The various colors remind us of the dominant themes of a particular season or celebration.

· White: Used for the seasons of Christmas and Easter and in celebrations of the Lord, of Mary, the angels, and saints who were not martyrs. This color is also used in Masses for the dead, at baptisms, weddings and other festive celebrations.

· Red: As the color of both blood and fire, red is used on Palm Sunday and Good Friday, as well as Pentecost and special celebrations of the Holy Spirit. Moreover, red is used on the feasts and memorials of the Apostles and those saints who died as martyrs.

· Violet: The color for Advent and Lent. Violet may also be used in Masses for the dead and on All Souls Day (November 2).

· Green: A color of life and hope, green is used throughout Ordinary Time.

· Other colors: Rose may be used on the Third Sunday of Advent and the Fourth Sunday of Lent, black may be used in Masses of the dead and on All Souls Day, gold or silver may be used on solemn occasions in place of white, red, or green.

Happy Anniversary

Pregunta:

¿Qué significan los colores de las vestiduras de los sacerdotes y diáconos?

Respuesta:

En el rito romano de la Iglesia católica, los colores de las vestiduras han evolucionado a lo largo de varios siglos y hubo una amplia variación tanto en los colores utilizados y en las fiestas y los tiempos asociadas con colores particulares. El Papa Inocencio III (1216) nos dio el esquema básico que más tarde fue prescrito por el Papa San Pío V en 1570. Los diversos colores nos recuerdan los temas dominantes de una temporada o celebración en particular.

· Blanco: Utilizado para las temporadas de Navidad y Pascua y en las celebraciones del Señor, de María, los ángeles y los santos que no eran mártires. Este color también se utiliza en misas para los muertos, en bautismos, bodas y otras celebraciones festivas.

· Rojo: El color de la sangre y el fuego, usamos el rojo en el Domingo de Ramos y el Viernes Santo, así como en Pentecostés y celebraciones especiales del Espíritu Santo. Además, el rojo se usa en las fiestas y memoriales de los Apóstoles y de aquellos santos que murieron como mártires.

· Violeta/Morado: El color para el Adviento y Cuaresma. También se usa el violeta durante las misas celebrando los muertos y en el Día de los Muertos (2 de noviembre).

· Verde: El color de la vida y esperanza, usamos el verde a lo largo del tiempo ordinario.

Otros colores: La rosa se puede usar en el tercer domingo de Adviento y el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma; el negro se puede usar en las misas de los muertos y en el Día de los Muertos; el oro o la plata se pueden usar en ocasiones solemnes en lugar del blanco, rojo o verde.

On the First Sunday of Lent, begin your journey with self-reflection and allow yourself to experience the mercy of the Lord. How will you renew your commitment to prayer, fasting and almsgiving this season?

Sacrifice: What will I give up?

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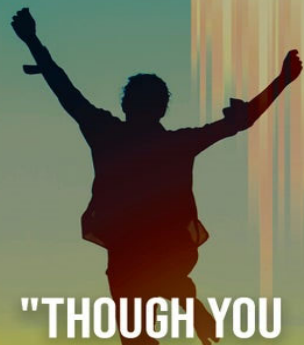
