FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April.

These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Catholic Faith

Question:

My neighbor is just beginning to explore the Catholic faith but was raised agnostic. I grew up believing in God, praying, and attending Mass. How does one start from scratch as an adult to develop a relationship with God?

Answer:

Start on a personal level! How did you and your neighbor become friends? How did you begin to discuss such a personal topic as faith? Communication, spending time together, and getting to know each other are essential to forming the bonds of a relationship. Personal prayer is essential to our relationship with God. We can't be close to someone we don't know! Invite your friend to explore the stories of Jesus in the Bible. Introduce them to the lives of the saints, especially ones you think they might be interested in.

Your neighbor might also have questions about the Catholic faith that you don't know how to answer. If your friend hasn't yet enrolled in RCIA classes, invite them to Mass at your parish. Introduce your friend to the faith formation director to make a connection. Personal support can be helpful as well, especially if few of your neighbor's current friends are practicing their faith. Connect your neighbor to other people in your parish living their faith well. The good examples of other faithful people could help your neighbor to feel welcomed and supported. Our Church is vibrant and alive!

Fe Católica

Pregunta:

Mi vecino recién está comenzando a explorar la fe católica, pero fue criado como agnóstico. Yo crecí creyendo en Dios, orando y asistiendo a misa. ¿Cómo se puede empezar desde cero cuando se es adulto para desarrollar una relación con Dios?

Respuesta:

¡Empieza a un nivel personal! ¿Cómo se hicieron amigos tú y tu vecino? ¿Cómo empezaron a hablar de un tema tan personal como la fe? La comunicación, el pasar tiempo juntos y empezarse a conocer son esenciales para formar los vínculos de una relación. La oración personal es esencial para nuestra relación con Dios. ¡No podemos estar cerca de alguien que no conocemos! Invita a tu amigo a explorar las historias de Jesús en la Biblia. Preséntale la vida de los santos, especialmente aquellos que creas que podrían interesarle.

Es posible que tu vecino también tenga preguntas sobre la fe católica que no sepas cómo responder. Si tu amigo aún no se ha inscrito en las clases de RICA, invítalo a misa en tu parroquia. Presenta a tu amigo al director de formación en la fe para establecer una conexión. El apoyo personal también puede ser útil, especialmente si pocos de los amigos actuales de tu vecino practican su fe. Conecta a tu vecino con otras personas de tu parroquia que viven bien su fe. Los buenos ejemplos de otras personas fieles podrían ayudar a tu vecino a sentirse acogido y apoyado. ¡Nuestra Iglesia es vibrante y está viva!
