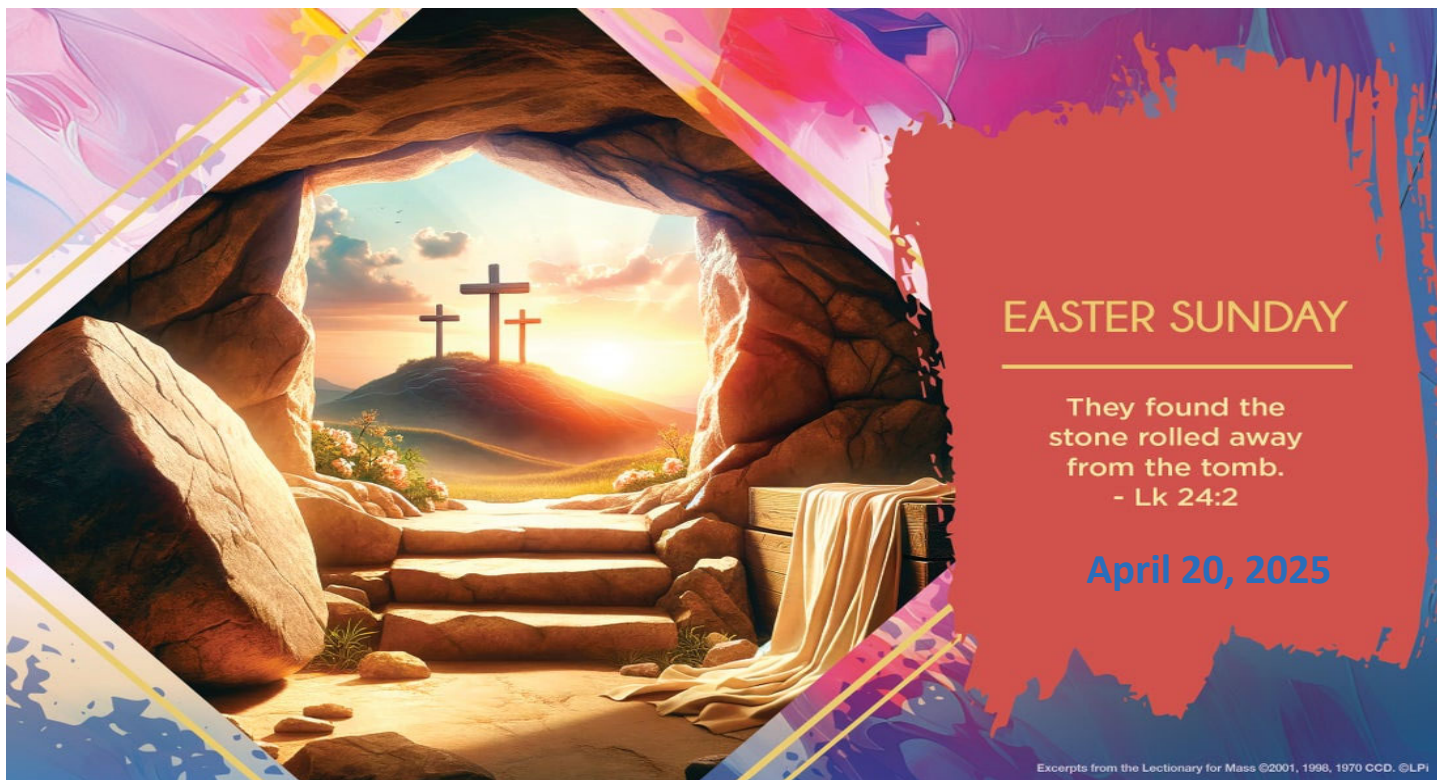

FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! What Would Mary Do?

This Easter morning, I am thinking of Mary Magdalene. I want to know her state of mind as she approached the tomb in the darkness. Was she afraid? Was she thinking clearly? Was she tired? Had grief and trauma robbed her of her sleep the last two nights? What did she intend to do? Anoint Christ's body, yes — but what else? Kiss his hands, trace the markings where the lash had fallen upon his skin? Say goodbye? Weep? Despair?

What were the words she planned to whisper into the cold, empty darkness that morning, as she wept over God's body? I don't know anything about her state of mind that Easter morning, except that I know she wanted to be with Christ. Perhaps that was all she knew, too. Perhaps she had no other thought, no other desire, than nearness to him. She didn't need to understand everything, and she didn't expect answers — she didn't dare hope for that.

But everything and everyone had fallen apart around her, and in Jesus' presence she knew her heart would be able to rest. If you have ever been in the midst of a crisis in your life and found yourself pacing the floors of your house when no one else is awake, muttering the words to a prayer you know by heart, you know what Mary Magdalene felt. In those moments, we do not always feel God's presence. Sometimes, when we look for Him, we only see an empty tomb.

When these dark moments come, I pray you will remember the faithfulness of this great saint. Be like Mary Magdalene. Look for Jesus, always. You may not always find him, but he will always find you.

"She ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them,

'They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him.'" — John 20:2

Esta mañana de Pascua pienso en María Magdalena.

Quiero saber su estado mental mientras se acercaba a la tumba en la oscuridad. ¿Tenía miedo? ¿Estaba pensando con claridad? ¿Estaba cansada? ¿El dolor y el trauma le habían robado el sueño las dos últimas noches? ¿Qué pretendía hacer? Ungir el cuerpo de Cristo, sí, pero ¿qué más? ¿Besar sus manos, trazar las marcas donde el látigo había caído sobre su piel? ¿Decir adiós? ¿Llorar? ¿Desesperarse?

¿Cuáles eran las palabras que planeaba susurrar en la fría y vacía oscuridad esa mañana, mientras lloraba sobre el cuerpo de Dios?

No sé nada sobre su estado mental esa mañana de Pascua, excepto que sé que quería estar con Cristo. Quizás eso también era todo lo que ella sabía. Quizás ella no tenía otro pensamiento, ningún otro deseo, que la cercanía a él. No necesitaba entenderlo todo y no esperaba respuestas; no se atrevía a esperar eso. Pero todo y todos se habían desmoronado a su alrededor, y en la presencia de Jesús sabía que su corazón podría descansar.

Si alguna vez has estado en medio de una crisis en tu vida y te has encontrado paseando por los pisos de tu casa cuando nadie más está despierto, murmurando las palabras de una oración que te sabes de memoria, sabes lo que sintió María Magdalena. En esos momentos, no siempre sentimos la presencia de Dios. A veces, cuando lo buscamos, sólo vemos una tumba vacía.

Cuando lleguen estos momentos oscuros, oro para que recuerdes la fidelidad de esta gran santa. Sean como María Magdalena.

Busquen a Jesús, siempre. Puede que no siempre lo encuentres, pero él siempre te encontrará a ti.

"Eché a correr, llegué a la casa donde estaban Simón Pedro y el otro discípulo, a quien Jesús amaba, y les dijo: "Se han llevado del sepulcro al Señor y no sabemos dónde lo habrán puesto." — Juan 20:2

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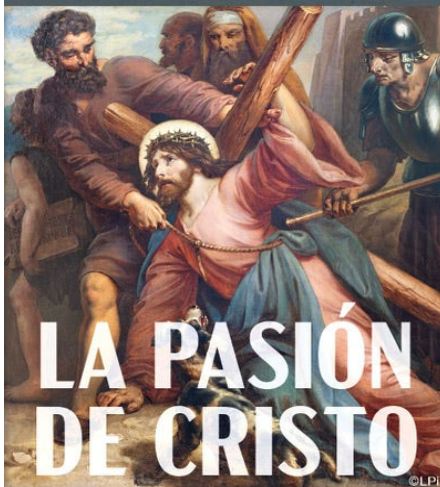
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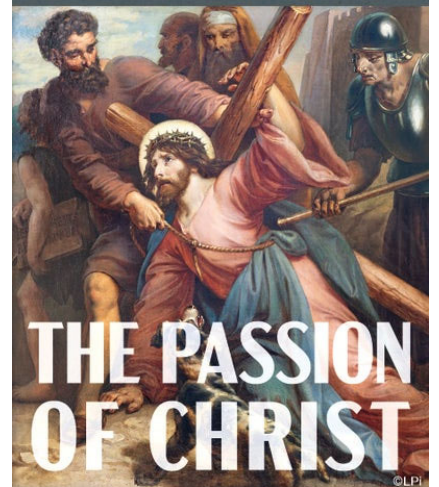
