**FAITH FORMATION:** Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

**SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:** Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

**YOUTH GROUP:** Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

**ADULT CONFIRMATION:** These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

**RCIA:** These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! ## Ascension of the Lord

### Question:

Couldn't Jesus have done more good if he stayed on earth, rather than ascended into heaven?

### Answer:

This is an interesting question! During his earthly life, Jesus gave sight to the blind, healed paralytics, drove out demons, and fed thousands with only a few loaves of bread. Imagine what he could have done if he'd never ascended into heaven! Imagine what our world could be! It's an interesting thought to consider, especially as the world faces challenges that only seem to deepen and expand. Yet at the Last Supper, Jesus says, "It is better for you if I go." Why? His response must have seemed strange to the Apostles at the time. In his place, Jesus says, he will send the Paraclete, the Comforter, the Advocate. He promises to send the Holy Spirit.

Jesus' departure allows the Apostles to become the leaders he has formed them to be. Jesus is no longer situated in only one geographical location, and his Church will never be a political kingdom. Soon after the Ascension, we celebrate Pentecost — the descent of the Holy Spirit and the radical empowerment of the followers of Jesus. We share in that empowerment and in that mission. Jesus is present in the sacraments, and he is present in us. Through our faith, hope, and love, we are called to be the good he does here on earth!

## Ascensión del Señor

### Pregunta:

¿No podría Jesús haber hecho más bien si se hubiera quedado en la tierra en lugar de ascender al cielo?

### Respuesta:

¡Esta es una pregunta interesante! Durante su vida terrenal, Jesús dio la vista a los ciegos, curó a los paralíticos, expulsó demonios y alimentó a miles de personas con sólo unas pocas hogazas de pan. ¡Imagínate lo que podría haber hecho si nunca hubiera ascendido al cielo! ¡Imagínate lo que podría ser nuestro mundo! Es interesante considerar esta idea, especialmente ahora que el mundo enfrenta desafíos que sólo parecen profundizarse y expandirse. Sin embargo, en la Última Cena, Jesús dice: "Es mejor para vosotros si yo voy." ¿Por qué? Su respuesta debió parecerles extraña a los Apóstoles en ese momento. En su lugar, dice Jesús, enviará al Paráclito, al Consolador, al Abogado. Promete enviar el Espíritu Santo.

La partida de Jesús permite a los Apóstoles convertirse en los líderes para los que él los ha formado. Jesús ya no está situado en un solo lugar geográfico y su Iglesia nunca será un reino político. Poco después de la Ascensión, celebramos Pentecostés: el descenso del Espíritu Santo y el empoderamiento radical de los seguidores de Jesús. Nosotros compartimos ese empoderamiento y esa misión. Jesús está presente en los sacramentos y está presente en nosotros. ¡A través de nuestra fe, esperanza y amor, estamos llamados a ser el bien que él hace aquí en la tierra!
