FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! What's Most Important?

I hold to the belief that you cannot have allegiances to both Duke and UNC, the Packers and the Bears, or the Yankees and the Red Sox. In Matthew 6:24, it says, "He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other." That verse isn't talking about sports! It's talking about God and money. Most of us love both of those and that can be a problem. If you were to love any of the sets of teams mentioned above, you have a huge problem as well.

Simply put, you can only have one thing that is the most important in your life. When I ask my children what is the most important thing in their lives, they know to respond, "God." But just because you know that is the right answer doesn't make it the truthful answer. Total allegiance to a sports team seems easier. You won't find a Packers fans secretly wearing a Bear's jersey. However, we can find Christians secretly hoarding their money or doing things based solely on the love of money.

Maybe the problem lies in the fact that, at times, we are merely lukewarm fans of Jesus and not disciples. If we truly have matured in our faith and strengthened our relationship with him, then real commitment comes easier. There will always be a temptation for money to take the place of Jesus, but the more committed we are, the harder it is to allow anything to come between us and our God. The question we all must continually ask ourselves is, "Is God truly the most important thing in my life?"

¿Qué es lo más Importante?

Sostengo la creencia de que no se puede tener lealtades tanto con Duke como con UNC, los Packers y los Bears, o los Yankees y los Red Sox. En Mateo 6:24, dice: "... necesariamente odiará a uno y amará al otro, o bien cuidará al primero y despreciará al otro." ¡Ese versículo no habla de deportes! Está hablando de Dios y del dinero. La mayoría de nosotros amamos a ambos y eso puede ser un problema. Si amas alguno de los conjuntos de equipos mencionados anteriormente, también tienes un gran problema.

En pocas palabras, solo puedes tener una cosa que sea lo más importante en tu vida. Cuando le pregunto a mis hijos qué es lo más importante en sus vidas, saben que deben responder "Dios." Pero solo porque saben que esa es la respuesta correcta, no la hace la respuesta sincera. La lealtad total a un equipo deportivo parece más fácil. No encontrarás a los fanáticos de los Packers secretamente usando una camiseta de los Bears. Sin embargo, podemos encontrar cristianos acumulan secretamente su dinero o haciendo cosas basadas únicamente en el amor al dinero.

Tal vez el problema radica en el hecho de que, a veces, somos simplemente fanáticos tibios de Jesús y no discípulos. Si verdaderamente hemos madurado en nuestra fe y fortalecido nuestra relación con Él, entonces el compromiso verdadero se da más fácil. Siempre habrá una tentación por el dinero para tomar el lugar de Jesús, pero entre más comprometidos estamos, más difícil es permitir que algo se interponga entre nosotros y nuestro Dios. La pregunta que todos debemos preguntarnos continuamente es: "¿Es Dios verdaderamente lo más importante en mi vida?"

A Prayer for Catechists

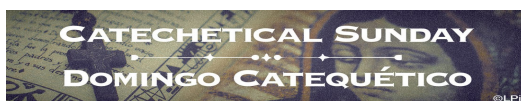
