SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Question:

Can a divorced Catholic receive holy Communion?

Answer:

Unfortunately, too many people today — Catholics and non-Catholics alike — mistakenly believe that divorce separates one from the Communion of the Church and that divorced persons may not receive Communion. However, as the Church has communicated in a number of places, the issue at hand is not the reality of divorce, but is more often the reality of re-marriage outside of the Church (such as in the case of a Catholic who was previously married within the Church, divorced, and remarried without receiving an annulment).

Divorced persons are called to live chastely as single people and to observe the same call to avoid sin as anyone else who desires to receive the Eucharist. Beyond this, however, Pope Francis has reminded us that the healing power of the Eucharist can be especially significant for those who have “endured separation, divorce, or abandonment ... divorced people who have not remarried, and often bear witness to marital fidelity, ought to be encouraged to find in the Eucharist the nourishment they need to sustain them in their present state of life.” (Amoris Laetitia, no. 242) Moreover, he continues, “The local community and pastors should accompany these people with solicitude, particularly when children are involved or when they are in serious financial difficulty.” (AL, no 242)

As Pope Francis has also reminded us, the Eucharist is “not a prize for the perfect,” but “a powerful medicine and nourishment” (Evangelii Gaudium, no. 47). Because we all stand in need of healing and wholeness, the Church invites all who seek to live their faith in integrity and devotion to come and receive the grace offered in the Eucharist.

Pregunta:

¿Puede un católico divorciado recibir la sagrada Comunión?

Respuesta:

Desafortunadamente, demasiadas personas hoy en día, católicos y no católicos por igual, creen erróneamente que el divorcio separa a uno de la Comunión de la Iglesia y que las personas divorciadas no pueden recibir la Comunión. Sin embargo, como la Iglesia ha comunicado en varios lugares, el tema en cuestión no es la realidad del divorcio, sino más a menudo la realidad de las segundas nupcias fuera de la Iglesia (como en el caso de un católico que se casó previamente dentro de la Iglesia, se divorció y se volvió a casar sin recibir una anulación).

Los divorciados están llamados a vivir castamente como solteros y a observar la misma llamada a evitar el pecado que cualquier otra persona que desee recibir la Eucaristía. Más allá de esto, sin embargo, el Papa Francisco nos ha recordado que el poder sanador de la Eucaristía puede ser especialmente significativo para aquellos que han “soportado la separación, el divorcio o el abandono... a los divorciados que no se han vuelto a casar, y que a menudo dan testimonio de fidelidad conyugal, hay que animarlos a encontrar en la Eucaristía el alimento que necesitan para sostenerse en su actual estado de vida”. (Amoris laetitia, n. 242) Además, prosigue, “la comunidad local y los pastores deben acompañar con solicitud a estas personas, especialmente cuando hay niños de por medio o cuando se encuentran en graves dificultades económicas”. (AL, n. 242)

Como también nos ha recordado el Papa Francisco, la Eucaristía “no es un premio para los perfectos”, sino “una poderosa medicina y alimento” (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 47). Debido a que todos necesitamos sanación y plenitud, la Iglesia invita a todos los que buscan vivir su fe con integridad y devoción a venir y recibir la gracia ofrecida en la Eucaristía.
