FAITH FORMATION: Our Faith Formation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April. These classes are for our students in Kindergarten to 8th grade who have attended the prior years of Faith Formation and received their sacraments on time. Your student must be registered for these classes.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Our Sacramental Preparation classes are held from the first Sunday after Dumas schools start until the end of April or middle of May. These classes are for students in Kindergarten to 11th grade who have not regularly attended Faith Formation classes and are behind on sacrament reception. Your student must be registered for these classes.

YOUTH GROUP: Our Youth Group is open to students in 9th – 12th grades and meets on Wednesday from August to May. All students in our Youth Group must have already received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. Your student must be registered for our Youth Group

ADULT CONFIRMATION: These classes are offered once a year in February or March and are for adults in our parish who have been baptized and received First Communion but somehow missed receiving the sacrament of Confirmation but have been attending Mass and are active Catholics.

RCIA: These classes are for anyone wishing to know more about the Catholic faith and are open to both Catholics and non-Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic but just haven't been actively involved come and join us, if you aren't Catholic, but would like to know more about the Catholic faith, come and join us!! Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Did you know there are churches in Rome older than St. Peter's? St. John Lateran is one of four major basilicas in the Eternal City, and it is by far the oldest. The land was donated by an ancient Roman family to the Emperor Constantine, who in turn gave it to the Church. For hundreds of years, St. John Lateran was the "mother church." Popes lived on the grounds through the 14th century. The church itself suffered from pillaging by invaders, fires, and earthquakes. It has been restored and rebuilt five times since the 300s. On this feast, we remember more than a building. We celebrate the resiliency of our faith. Though trials may come in our parishes, personal lives, and the world, the Church endures through the grace of Jesus Christ.

Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán

¿Sabías que en Roma hay iglesias más antiguas que la Basílica de San Pedro? San Juan de Letrán es una de las cuatro basílicas mayores de la Ciudad Eterna, y es, con mucho, la más antigua. El terreno fue donado por una antigua familia romana al emperador Constantino, quien a su vez lo cedió a la Iglesia. Durante siglos, San Juan de Letrán fue la iglesia madre. Los papas residieron en sus terrenos hasta el siglo XIV. La iglesia sufrió saqueos, incendios y terremotos. Ha sido restaurada y reconstruida cinco veces desde el siglo IV. En esta fiesta, recordamos más que un edificio. Celebramos la fortaleza de nuestra fe. Aunque las pruebas puedan presentarse en nuestras parroquias, en nuestra vida personal y en el mundo, la Iglesia perdura por la gracia de Jesucristo.

December 5th Mass To Launch Centennial Celebration

The Diocese of Amarillo will begin its year-long celebration of its Centennial with a 5:30pm Mass Friday, Dec. 5 at St. Mary's Cathedral, 1200 South Washington.

Bishop Patrick J. Zurek will preside at the Mass, with priests of the diocese concelebrating and deacons assisting. It is the only Mass that will be celebrated that day in the Diocese of Amarillo, according to Father Lawrence John, JCL, Vicar General and Rector at St. Mary's Cathedral.

During the Mass, the Centennial Candle will be blessed and lit for the first time. After the Mass, each pastor will receive a candle to be lit during the weekend Masses in their own parishes and missions, symbolizing our unity in Faith and our shared journey as a diocesan family. The Kickoff Mass is the first of numerous events and celebrations taking place throughout the Diocese of Amarillo to mark its Centennial, culminating in a Mass of Thanksgiving to celebrate the 100th anniversary Saturday, Aug. 22 at 10:00am, also at St. Mary's Cathedral.
