

OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

The Parish of St. John Bosco is a multi-cultural, multi-lingual Catholic Faith community that proclaims Jesus Christ. In the spirit of St. John Bosco, we do this by being a **Home** that welcomes all especially the young and the poor; a **School** that prepares for life through religious, educational and social services; a **Parish** that evangelizes through Word & Sacrament, Worship and Faith Formation; a **Playground** where lasting friendship and relationships are formed and developed through recreational and social opportunities.

FROM THE DESK OF FR. PAT

Next weekend we celebrate *World Mission Sunday*, and this week we lost a great missionary — our **Father Tomasz!** He generously gave himself to the missions to various countries in Africa, New Zealand, to Ireland and finally here, to Port Chester.

There will be a second collection and I certainly hope we will be very generous in our support for the missions. Don Bosco's heart was a missionary heart and he made great sacrifices in personnel and money so that his Salesians could go to foreign countries, especially to help Italian immigrants who were losing their faith because no priests could speak their language. (Indeed this is why we Salesians came to New York in 1898; and to Port Chester in 1912!).

Yet, as I was thinking of all of this, it made me reflect on Father Tomasz and on *my* missionary vocation. Yes, we need to pray and support those who go to the foreign mission to bring the good news. Yes, we need to be generous and give the financial help missionaries desperately need to bring the Gospel to others. However, the challenge of the day is deeper. *By virtue of our baptism each one of us is called to be a missionary.* We are called to bring the Gospel, if not to a foreign country, then to our families, our neighborhoods, our places of work. Jesus sends each of us to proclaim His message. Father Tomasz asks us today: Am I truly a missionary? Do people at work or in the neighborhood realize what I do, I do because I want to imitate Jesus? Do I talk about the beauty of my faith and the richness it gives me? Do I celebrate the joy of the sacraments and their power in my life? Do I go about doing good and living the golden rule? Do I practice my Catholic faith openly and unashamedly? Do people come close to Jesus and His church because of my words and example? In short, am I a missionary? It is easy to pray for others far away. It is easy to send money to help the missions far away. It is another thing, entirely, to be a missionary and live as a missionary at home and yet, that is exactly what you and I are called to be. My life — my actions — my words — have to proclaim to everyone I meet or am with: "**I belong to Jesus; He is the Lord and Savior of my life.**" Father Tomasz's life certainly said that every day. Does my life say that? Am I truly living my Catholic/Christian vocation? Do I practice my Catholic faith? Am I a missionary?

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE P. PAT

El próximo fin de semana celebramos el *Domingo Mundial de las Misiones*. Y esta semana perdimos a un gran misionero: ¡nuestro Padre Tomasz! Se entregó generosamente a las misiones en varios países de África, Nueva Zelanda, Irlanda y, finalmente, aquí, en Port Chester.

Habrá una segunda colecta y ciertamente espero que seamos muy generosos en nuestro apoyo a las misiones. El corazón de Don Bosco era un corazón misionero e hizo grandes sacrificios en personal y dinero para que sus salesianos pudieran ir a países extranjeros, especialmente para ayudar a los inmigrantes italianos que estaban perdiendo su fe porque ningún sacerdote podía hablar su idioma. (De hecho, esta es la razón por la que los salesianos vinieron a Nueva York en 1898; y a Port Chester en 1912!).

Sin embargo, mientras pensaba en todo esto, me hizo reflexionar sobre *mi* vocación misionera. Sí, necesitamos orar y apoyar a aquellos que van a la misión extranjera para traer las buenas nuevas. *Sí*, debemos ser generosos y dar la ayuda financiera que los misioneros necesitan desesperadamente para llevar el Evangelio a los demás. Sin embargo, el desafío del día es más profundo. *En virtud de nuestro bautismo, cada uno de nosotros está llamado a ser misionero.* Estamos llamados a llevar el Evangelio, si no a un país extranjero, entonces a nuestras familias, nuestros vecindarios, nuestros lugares de trabajo. Jesús nos envía a cada uno de nosotros a proclamar su mensaje. El Padre Tomasz nos pregunta hoy: ¿Soy verdaderamente un misionero? ¿La gente en el trabajo o en el vecindario se da cuenta de lo que hago, lo hago porque quiero imitar a Jesús? ¿Hablo de la belleza de mi fe y de la riqueza que me da? ¿Celebro el gozo de los sacramentos y su poder en mi vida? ¿Voy a hacer el bien y vivir la regla de oro? ¿Practico mi fe católica abiertamente y sin vergüenza? ¿Las personas se acercan a Jesús y a su iglesia debido a mis palabras y ejemplo? En resumen, ¿soy misionero? Es fácil orar por otros que están lejos. Es fácil enviar dinero para ayudar a las misiones lejanas. Otra cosa es ser misionero y vivir como misionero en casa y, sin embargo, eso es exactamente lo que tú y yo estamos llamados a ser. Mi vida, mis acciones, mis palabras, tienen que proclamar a todos los que encuentro o con los que estoy: "**Pertenezco a Jesús; Él es el Señor y Salvador de mi vida**". La vida del Padre Tomasz ciertamente decía eso todos los días. ¿Mi vida dice eso? ¿Estoy realmente viviendo mi vocación católica/cristiana? ¿Practico mi fe católica? ¿Soy misionero? ¡Que dios te bendiga!

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

No próximo final de semana celebramos o Dia Mundial das Missões e, nesta semana, perdemos um grande missionário, nosso Padre Tomasz! Ele generosamente foi missionário na África, Nova Zelândia, Irlanda e, finalmente, aqui em Port Chester.


Haverá uma segunda coleta e tenho a esperança de todos sejam generosos para ajudar as missões. Dom Bosco era um missionário de coração e fez grandes sacrifícios pessoais e financeiros para ajudar os Salesianos a irem para outros países, especialmente onde havia imigrantes italianos que não praticavam a sua religião porque não havia padres que falassem a sua língua. É exatamente por isto que os Salesianos vieram para Nova Iorque em 1898 e Port Chester em 1912!

Enquanto pensava sobre tudo isto, fiquei a refletir na nossa vocação missionária. De fato temos que rezar e ajudar aqueles que vão para outros países espalhar o Evangelho, mas o nosso desafio é mais profundo: através do nosso Batismo, cada um de nós é chamado a ser missionário. Somos chamados a levar o Evangelho, não a outros países, mas para nossas famílias, vizinhança, lugar de trabalho. Jesus nos envia para proclamar a Sua mensagem. Padre Tomasz nos pergunta hoje: sou realmente um missionário? Será que as pessoas no nosso trabalho ou na nossa rua percebem que agimos de certa maneira por que queremos imitar a Cristo? Será que falo da beleza da minha fé e das bençãos que recebo? Será que celebro a alegria dos sacramentos e seu poder na minha vida? Será que testemunho Jesus através da minha vida e palavras? Será que estou fazendo o bem? Pratico minha fé católica de maneira aberta, sem vergonha? Será que sou um missionário?

É fácil rezar pelos outros que estão longe, enviar dinheiro para ajudar as missões distantes. Mas é mais difícil ser um missionário na nossa casa, que é exatamente o que somos chamados a ser. Minha vida, minhas ações, minhas palavras, devem proclamar que “**Eu pertenço a Jesus, Ele é o Senhor e Salvador da minha vida**”. Padre Tomasz dava este testemunho diariamente. E na minha vida, será que estou vivendo minha vocação cristã? Será que eu pratico minha fé? Sou um missionário?




