

OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

The Parish of St. John Bosco is a multi-cultural, multi-lingual Catholic Faith community that proclaims Jesus Christ. In the spirit of St. John Bosco, we do this by being a **Home** that welcomes all especially the young and the poor; a **School** that prepares for life through religious, educational and social services; a **Parish** that evangelizes through Word & Sacrament, Worship and Faith Formation; a **Playground** where lasting friendship and relationships are formed and developed through recreational and social opportunities.

FROM THE DESK OF FR. PAT

Today, the fourth Sunday of Easter, Good Shepherd Sunday, and we celebrate the **World Day of Prayer for Vocations!**

This is a Sunday the Church gives us to pray especially for an increase in Vocations to the priesthood and religious life and to reflect on the importance of these vocations in the life of the Church. I believe all of us are aware that world wide we are experiencing a crisis in vocations to priesthood and religious life. Since 2019, there has been a dramatic drop in vocations especially in North America and Europe. This situation is serious. Here, in our parish, we are blessed with five Salesian priests and a Salesian Brother, but this is not the case in many parishes. Most parishes, even around us, have one or maybe two priests. Many parishes in the U.S. have no priests and Mass only once-a-week. Remember: without a priest there is no Eucharist, and without the Eucharist there is no Church! Our Catholic Faith depends on the Eucharist. We need the Body and Blood of Christ to survive. We need priests, and Brothers and Sisters. What can we do? I suggest three things that can help:

First, we must be **CONVINCED** *that God is calling young people to follow HIM*; the problem is too many are not responding. We must speak more about vocations in our families, in our groups, with our friends. We must not take vocations for granted and expect they will just be there; they may not!

Second, we must **INVITE**. I look around in our parish and there is *no doubt in my mind* that there are a number of young women and men God is calling — this is a gift. When we see a young adult we feel God might be calling — **say something!!** Ask the simple question: Did you ever think about becoming a sister, a brother, a priest? Sometimes that's all a person needs — an invitation and the assurance people see in them what they might be sensing. **Be Bold!** *Invite young people to think about a vocation.* There is nothing to lose: **you** may be the person God is waiting for to plant the seed. There are so many wonderful young people in our parish. We must invite.

Third, we must **PRAY!** Tomorrow we begin the month of Our Lady. Every day we will be reciting the Rosary in front of the image of Our Blessed Mother outside the Church; join us and pray your Rosary for this intention: **Vocations.** In fact, I invite all of us in this month, let this be our number one intention in our daily Rosary: an increase in vocations! Our Blessed Mother will touch young people to follow in Her Son's footsteps!!

And, as we celebrate this day of Prayer for Vocations, please pray for the members of the Salesian Community who serve you at your Parish of St. John Bosco.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE P. PAT

Hoy, cuarto domingo de Pascua, Domingo del Buen Pastor, y celebramos la **Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones.**

Este es un domingo que la Iglesia nos da para orar especialmente por un aumento de las vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa y para reflexionar sobre la importancia de estas vocaciones en la vida de la Iglesia. Creo que todos somos conscientes de que en todo el mundo estamos experimentando una crisis en las vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa. Desde 2019, ha habido una caída dramática en las vocaciones especialmente en América del Norte y Europa. Esta situación es grave. Aquí, en nuestra parroquia, somos bendecidos con cinco sacerdotes salesianos y un hermano salesiano, pero este no es el caso en muchas parroquias. La mayoría de las parroquias, incluso a nuestro alrededor, tienen uno o tal vez dos sacerdotes. Muchas parroquias en los Estados Unidos no tienen sacerdotes y misa solo una vez a la semana. Recuerden: ¡sin sacerdote no hay Eucaristía, y sin Eucaristía no hay Iglesia! Nuestra fe católica depende de la Eucaristía. Necesitamos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo para sobrevivir. Necesitamos sacerdotes y hermanos y hermanas. ¿Qué podemos hacer? Sugiero tres cosas que pueden ayudar:

Primero, debemos estar **CONVENCIDOS** de que *Dios está llamando a los jóvenes a seguirlo*; el problema es que muchos no están respondiendo. Debemos hablar más sobre las vocaciones en nuestras familias, en nuestros grupos, con nuestros amigos. No debemos suponer que las vocaciones simplemente estén allí; ¡Puede que no!

Segundo, debemos **INVITAR**. Miro a mi alrededor en nuestra parroquia y *no hay duda en mi mente* de que hay un número de mujeres y hombres jóvenes que Dios está llamando, esto es un regalo. Cuando vemos a un joven adulto, sentimos que Dios podría estar llamando, ¡**¡di algo!!** Haz la simple pregunta: ¿Alguna vez pensaste en convertirte en hermana, hermano, sacerdote? A veces eso es todo lo que una persona necesita: una invitación y la seguridad de que las personas ven en ellos lo que podrían estar sintiendo. **¡Sé audaz!** *Invita a los jóvenes a pensar en una vocación.* No hay nada que perder: **puedes** ser la persona que Dios está esperando para plantar la semilla. Hay tantos jóvenes maravillosos en nuestra parroquia. Debemos invitar.

Tercero, ¡debemos **ORAR!** Mañana comenzamos el mes de Nuestra Señora. Todos los días estaremos rezando el Rosario frente a la imagen de Nuestra Santísima Madre fuera de la Iglesia; únete a nosotros y reza tu Rosario por esta intención: **Vocaciones.** De hecho, invito a todos a que en este mes esta sea nuestra intención número uno en nuestro Rosario diario: ¡un aumento de las vocaciones! ¡Nuestra Santísima Madre tocara a los jóvenes a seguir los pasos de Su Hijo!

Y, mientras celebramos este día de oración por las vocaciones, por favor oren por los miembros de la Comunidad Salesiana que les sirven en su parroquia de San Juan Bosco.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Hoje, quarto domingo do Tempo de Páscoa, o Domingo do Bom Pastor, celebramos o Dia Mundial das Vocações!

Este é o domingo em que a Igreja dá uma atenção especial ao aumento das vocações sacerdotais e religiosas, além de refletir na importância destas vocações para a vida da Igreja. Acredito que todos nós estamos cientes que no mundo todo há uma crise de vocações, desde 2019 há uma dramática queda no número de jovens vocacionados, especialmente nos Estados Unidos e Europa. Esta é uma situação séria. Em nossa paróquia somos abençoados por termos cinco padres e um irmão salesiano, mas na maioria das paróquias há apenas um ou dois padres. Em muitas paróquias neste país, não há um padre e a Missa é celebrada apenas uma vez por mês por um padre que visita a paróquia. Lembremos, sem padres não há Eucaristia, sem Eucaristia não há Igreja! Nossa fé católica depende da Eucaristia, precisamos do Corpo e Sangue de Cristo para sobrevivermos, precisamos de padres, irmãos e irmãs. O que podemos fazer? Sugiro três coisas que podem ajudar:

Primeiro, estou convencido que Deus chama os jovens à segui-Lo, o problema é que muitos não estão respondendo. Precisamos falar sobre vocações nas nossas famílias, grupos e com nossos amigos. Não podemos considerar que vocações vão surgir do nada, elas não irão!

Segundo, precisamos convidar. Olho ao redor da nossa paróquia e não tenho dúvida que Deus está chamando muitos dos nossos jovens, isto é um dos seus dons. Quando vemos que Deus está chamando um jovem, digamos algo! Faça uma pergunta simples: você já pensou seriamente em se tornar um sacerdote ou entrar em uma comunidade religiosa. Seja corajoso, convide aos jovens para seguir sua vocação. Não há nada a perder, você pode ser a pessoa que Deus está esperando para plantar uma semente. Há muitos jovens maravilhosos em nossa paróquia, devemos convidá-los.

Terceiro, devemos rezar! A partir de amanhã, no mês de Maio, mês de Nossa Senhora, rezaremos o Rosário em frente à Igreja todos os dias. Junte-se a nós e reze pelas vocações. Convido a todos que esta seja nossa principal vocação neste mês, um aumento no número de vocações! Nossa Senhora irá ajudar nossos jovens a seguir os passos do seu Filho!

Hoje, quando celebramos o Dia de Oração pelas Vocações, por favor rezem também pela Comunidade Salesiana que serve a Paróquia de São João Bosco.

Informações od proboszcza

Dzisiaj już czwarta niedziela wielkanocna, zwana Niedzielą Pasterską, dziś obchodzimy Światowy Dzień Modlitwy o Powołania.

Jest to niedziela, kiedy Kościół zachęca i szczególnie nawołuje do modlitwy o wzrost powołań kapłańskich i zakonnych, oraz do refleksji nad znaczeniem tych powołań w życiu Kościoła. Myślę, że wszyscy jesteśmy świadomi, że na całym świecie przeżywamy kryzys powołań kapłańskich i zakonnych. Od 2019 roku nastąpił dramatyczny spadek powołań zwłaszcza w Ameryce Północnej i Europie. Ta sytuacja z roku na rok staje się coraz poważniejsza. W naszej parafii mamy to błogosławieństwo że posiadamy liczną rodzinę salezjańską: pięciu księży i kleryków/diakonów, niestety nie każda parafia ma tyle szczęścia. Większość parafii, nawet tych w bliskim otoczeniu, ma jednego czy też tylko dwóch księży. Wiele parafii w USA cierpi na deficyt księży, poprzez to bywa że Msza Święta jest odprawiana tylko raz w tygodniu.

Bez kapłana nie ma Eucharystii, a bez Eucharystii nie ma Kościoła! Nasza wiara katolicka opiera się na Eucharystii. Do pełni życia duchowego i fizycznego potrzebujemy Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa. Potrzebujemy księży, braci i siostr. Co możemy zrobić? Proponuję trzy rzeczy, które mogą pomóc: Po pierwsze, musimy być PRZEKONANI, że Bóg powołuje młodych ludzi do pójścia za NIM; problem polega na tym, że zbyt wielu nie odpowiada na to wołanie. Musimy więcej i częściej mówić o powołaniach w naszych rodzinach, w naszych społecznościach, z naszymi przyjaciółmi, bliskimi. Nie wolno nam przyjmować powołań za coś oczywistego i oczekiwać, że się po prostu pojawią. Po drugie, musimy ZAPRASZAĆ. Rozglądam się po naszej parafii i nie mam wątpliwości, że jest wielu młodych kobiet i mężczyzn, których Bóg powołuje – a powołanie to olbrzymi dar. Kiedy widzimy że Pan Bóg powołuje młodą osobę, wspierajmy ją w tym powołaniu, w tej niejednokrotnie trudnej, aczkolwiek pięknej i potrzebnej całej światu drodze posługi. Zadajmy sobie proste pytanie: Czy kiedykolwiek myślałem o zostaniu siostrą zakonną, zakonnikiem, księdzem?

Czasami wszystko czego niepewny, młody człowiek potrzebuje, szczególnie w zgiełku tego świata, to otworzyć się aby usłyszeć Głos Wzywającego i to zaakceptować. A mając realne poczucie, pewność, że ludzie też w nim to widzą oraz że nie zostanie sam na drodze wyboru, że jest otoczony modlitwą i ma wsparcie na drodze powołania, stanie się to dla niego zdecydowanie klarowniejszym i doda odwagi do zrobienia pierwszego kroku. A i wy bądźcie odważni! Zapraszajcie, inspirujcie młodych ludzi do rozważania i do odnalezienia ich powołania.

Młody człowieku-nie masz nic do stracenia: możesz być osobą, na którą Bóg czeka, aby być tym zasianym ziarnem a wzrastając w Bogu w przyszłości służyć innym na chwałę Pana. W naszej parafii jest wielu wspaniałych młodych ludzi. Musimy im pomóc w odnalezieniu drogi powołania. Po trzecie, musimy się MODLIĆ!

Jutro rozpoczynamy Miesiąc Maryjny. Codziennie będziemy odmawiać Różaniec przed wizerunkiem Matki Najświętszej na przodzie kościoła, dołącz do nas i módl się różańcem między innymi i w tej intencji, w intencji powołań.

Zapraszam nas wszystkich w tym miesiącu, niech to będzie nasza wspólna intencja, niechaj w naszym codziennym różańcu zagłoszą prośba o wzrost powołań! Nasza Wspomożycielka Wiernych na pewno będzie drogowskazem i pomocą dla młodych ludzi pragnącymi pójść śladami Jej Syna!!

A ponieważ obchodzimy dzień modlitwy za Powołania, proszę módlcie się też za członków wspólnoty salezjańskiej, którzy służą wam każdego dnia w naszej Parafii św. Jana Bosko.





Clothe the Naked Reflection by Anthony Chica Confirmation Candidate


