### FR. THOMAS PROVENZANO, SDB (1967-2023)

Fr. Thomas M. Provenzano died unexpectedly on July 21 in his room in the Salesian residence of St. John Bosco Parish in Port Chester, N.Y. He was 56 years old and had been a professed Salesian of Don Bosco for more than 29 years and a priest for over 21 years. He was parochial vicar in the parish and vice director in the Salesian community.

According to Fr. Pat Angelucci, director and pastor, Fr. Tom's alarm went off at 6:00 a.m. and he got up to turn it off. When he did not come to celebrate the 8:00 a.m. Mass, Fr. Pat went to his room and found him lying on the floor; he had died of a massive heart attack. The evening before, he engaged in lively table conversation with his confreres, heard confessions, and taped an upcoming talk on the Eucharist.

Tom Provenzano was born on March 18, 1967, in Bronxville, N.Y., the youngest of Anthony and Edythe Volpe Provenzano's four sons. He was baptized at Immaculate Conception Church in Tuckahoe, N.Y., the family's parish, within a month of his birth and confirmed there in 1980. He attended Salesian High School in New Rochelle, graduating in 1985, then spent three years at Xavier University in Cincinnati. Although he admired the Salesians' "great sense of camaraderie," he entered the New York Archdiocese's candidacy program for the priesthood in 1988. As a diocesan candidate, he completed a B.A. in philosophy at Iona College in New Rochelle in 1991.

But Don Bosco staked a claim on Tom, and in January 1992 he entered the Salesian formation program at South Orange, N.J. In August that year he began a year of novitiate with seven classmates in Rosemead, Calif., under the guidance of Fr. Harry Rasmussen. Seven of them professed on August 15, 1993, in Rosemead. Bro. Tom made his perpetual profession in New Rochelle on August 21, 1999.

Following his First Profession, Bro. Tom spent two years of post novitiate formation in South Orange, where he earned an M.A. in education from Seton Hall University (1995). He did practical training at his alma mater, Salesian High, between 1995 and 1997, teaching history and religion. He began theological studies at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Worthington, Ohio, in 1997. When the Salesians withdrew from the PCJ the following year, Bro. Tom was sent to the Salesian Theological Institute at Tlaquepaque, Mexico. There, he earned a bachelor's degree in theology as well as learned Spanish.

Fr. Tom was ordained in his home parish of the Immaculate Conception in Tuckahoe on August 25, 2001, by Cardinal Oscar Rodriguez Maradiaga, SDB, archbishop of Tegucigalpa, Honduras. He began his priestly ministry at St. Anthony of Padua Church in Paterson, N.J., as parochial vicar for a year. In 2002 he was sent to St. John Bosco Parish in Chicago as parochial vicar, and in 2003 became vice director of the Salesian community there.

Fr. Tom returned to Salesian High in New Rochelle in 2007 as campus minister (CYM) and religion teacher. Three years later he was assigned to St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Elizabeth, N.J., as director and pastor. In 2013, Fr. Tom returned to Chicago as director and pastor of St. John Bosco. Completing six years with those responsibilities, he moved to College Park, Md., in 2019 to begin studies for a doctorate in theology at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. He didn't complete that project, but instead took up parish ministry once more in 2021 at St. John Bosco in Port Chester. Fr. Tom blogged at [The AX: 2021 \(theaxattheroot.blogspot.com\)](http://theax2021.blogspot.com), trying "to give a Catholic-Christian perspective on pop culture, current events and whatever else strikes me at the moment."

Adam Rudin, program director of the Salesian Lay Missioners, regretted Fr. Tom's death: "I always found him to be very personable, jolly, and a great conversationalist. I would always look forward to seeing him and spending time with him when the Salesian Lay Missionary Program would stay in Port Chester. He was always so welcoming and took a genuine interest in getting to know the young volunteers."

Fr. Tom is survived by his brothers Joseph, Anthony, and Salvatore and their families. Funeral Mass, presided over by Bishop John Bonnici, DD, Auxiliary Bishop of New York, was held at St. John Bosco Parish, Port Chester on Wednesday, July 26 and burial was at the Salesian Cemetery in Goshen, NY on Thursday, July 27. *Funeral Arrangements by Tuter Funeral Home, Port Chester, NY.*

### PADRE THOMAS PROVENZANO, SDB (1967-2023)

El Padre Thomas M. Provenzano murió inesperadamente el 21 de julio en su habitación en la residencia salesiana de la parroquia de San Juan Bosco en Port Chester, Nueva York. Tenía 56 años y había sido salesiano profeso de Don Bosco durante más de 29 años y sacerdote durante más de 21 años. Fue vicario parroquial en la parroquia y vicedirector en la comunidad salesiana.

Según el Padre Pat Angelucci, director y párroco, la alarma del Padre Tom sonó a las 6:00 a.m. y se levantó para apagarla. Cuando no vino a celebrar la misa de las 8:00 a.m., el Padre Pat fue a su habitación y lo encontró tirado en el suelo; Había muerto de un ataque cardíaco masivo. La noche anterior, entabló una animada conversación de mesa con sus hermanos, escuchó confesiones y grabó una próxima charla sobre la Eucaristía.

Tom Provenzano nació el 18 de marzo de 1967 en Bronxville, Nueva York, el más joven de los cuatro hijos de Anthony y Edythe Volpe Provenzano. Fue bautizado en la Iglesia de la Inmaculada Concepción en Tuckahoe, Nueva York, la parroquia de la familia, un mes después de su nacimiento y confirmado allí en 1980. Asistió a la Escuela Secundaria Salesiana en New Rochelle, graduándose en 1985, luego pasó tres años en la Universidad Xavier en Cincinnati. Aunque admiraba el "gran sentido de camaradería" de los salesianos, ingresó al programa de candidatura de la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York para el sacerdocio en 1988. Como candidato diocesano, completó una licenciatura en filosofía en Iona College en New Rochelle en 1991.

Pero Don Bosco reclamó a Tom, y en enero de 1992 entró en el programa de formación salesiana en South Orange, N.J. En agosto de ese año comenzó un año de noviciado con siete compañeros de clase en Rosemead, California, bajo la guía del Padre Harry Rasmussen. Siete de ellos profesaron el 15 de agosto de 1993 en Rosemead. El Hermano Tom hizo su profesión perpetua en New Rochelle el 21 de agosto de 1999.

Después de su primera profesión, el Hermano Tom pasó dos años de formación postnoviciado en South Orange, donde obtuvo una maestría en educación de la Universidad Seton Hall (1995). Hizo una formación práctica en su alma mater, la Secundaria Salesiana, entre 1995 y 1997, enseñando historia y religión. Comenzó sus estudios teológicos en el Pontificio Colegio Josephinum en Washington, Ohio, en 1997. Cuando los salesianos se retiraron de la PCJ al año siguiente, el Hno. Tom fue enviado al Instituto Teológico Salesiano en Tlaquepaque, México. Allí, obtuvo una licenciatura en teología y aprendió español.

El Padre Tom fue ordenado en su parroquia natal de la Inmaculada Concepción en Tuckahoe el 25 de agosto de 2001, por el cardenal Oscar Rodríguez Maradiaga, SDB, arzobispo de Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Comenzó su ministerio sacerdotal en la Iglesia de San Antonio de Padua en Paterson, Nueva Jersey, como vicario parroquial durante un año. En 2002 fue enviado a la parroquia de San Juan Bosco en Chicago como vicario parroquial, y en 2003 se convirtió en subdirector de la comunidad salesiana allí. El Padre Tom regresó a la Secundaria Salesiana en New Rochelle en 2007 como ministro del campus (CYM) y profesor de religión. Tres años más tarde fue asignado a la parroquia de San Antonio de Padua en Elizabeth, Nueva Jersey, como director y párroco. En 2013, el Padre Tom regresó a Chicago como director y párroco de San Juan Bosco. Al completar seis años con esas responsabilidades, se mudó a College Park, Maryland, en 2019 para comenzar los estudios para un doctorado en teología en la Universidad Católica de América en Washington, DC. No completó ese proyecto, sino que asumió el ministerio parroquial una vez más en 2021 en St. John Bosco en Port Chester. El Padre Tom blogueó en [The AX: 2021 \(theaxattheroot.blogspot.com\)](http://The AX: 2021 (theaxattheroot.blogspot.com)), tratando de "dar una perspectiva católico-cristiana sobre cultura, eventos actuales y cualquier otra cosa que me llame la atención en este momento".

Adam Rudin, director del programa de los Misioneros Laicos Salesianos, lamentó la muerte del Padre Tom: "Siempre lo encontré muy agradable, alegre y un gran conversador. Siempre esperaba verlo y pasar tiempo con él cuando el Programa Misionero Laico Salesiano se quedara en Port Chester. Siempre fue muy acogedor y se interesó genuinamente en conocer a los jóvenes voluntarios".

Al Padre Tom le sobreviven sus hermanos Joseph, Anthony y Salvatore y sus familias. La misa fúnebre, presidida por el obispo John Bonnici, DD, obispo auxiliar de Nueva York, se celebró en la parroquia de San Juan Bosco, Port Chester, el miércoles 26 de julio y el entierro fue en el cementerio salesiano de Goshen, Nueva York, el jueves 27 de julio. *Arreglos funerarios por Tutera Funeral Home, Port Chester, NY.*



### Celebrating Sunday Throughout the Week The Transfiguration of the Lord

**In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals to his disciples that he is the Son of God. Listen to learn the way they responded to this news.** In today's Gospel, Jesus leads Peter, James, and John up a high mountain. Mountains are often places of prayer, and—in the Old Testament—places where people meet God. Jesus' face and clothes shine bright as light, and the disciples see Moses and Elijah with him. Moses represents the Law from the Old Testament, and Elijah represents the prophets. The voice of God, coming from the cloud, reveals that Jesus is his Son, and that the disciples should listen to him. Moses and Elijah disappear, suggesting that everything the Law and prophets revealed about God is fully revealed in Jesus. **This week, ask Jesus to help you see God's presence around you.** When you see a picture, drawing, statue, or other image of Jesus, think about what that image shows you about God's love.

La voz de Dios, que viene de la nube, revela que Jesús es su Hijo, y que los discípulos deben escucharlo. Moisés y Elías desaparecen, lo que sugiere que todo lo que la Ley y los profetas revelaron acerca de Dios se revela plenamente en Jesús. **Esta semana, pídele a Jesús que te ayude a ver la presencia de Dios a tu alrededor. 
