‘The following night the curator decided to take his experiment a step further. He removed the painting altogether, leaving only the empty frame hanging there. And what happened? Everybody without exception stopped before the empty frame. And several went to the curator and asked, “What happened to the lovely little painting that used to hang there?”

Application:

Some people (children, for example) may have to do something desperate to be noticed and to get attention. Others may have to die before they are missed, and their contribution is recognized. Everyone comes out of the woodwork to praise them now that they are gone. We never appreciate the value of another person’s service until we need it ourselves.

One day in Jerusalem Jesus was sitting on the steps in front of the Temple. A collection box was standing nearby. Along came a poor widow and put a small offering into the box. Nobody paid any attention to her except Jesus. He noticed her offering and praised it. It’s nice to know that even such a small deed of love does not escape his attention.

How good are we at recognizing what others do and affirming them? Sadly, the truth may be that we are so preoccupied with ourselves that we don’t notice, and don’t care.

Prayer: Lord, give us eyes to see as you saw, and a heart to respond as you respond to the goodness of others.




