

FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear Parishioners,
"For all that's been, thanks and for all that will be 'yes'" (Dag Hammarskjöld).

That quote holds one of the great secrets of life: to look forward – with hope and courage – while learning to look back with faith and gratitude. Haven't you already noticed that when you walk you've got to put one foot forward while one is at the back. Yet, "looking ahead" is not something automatic! It is a choice that you're called upon to make every day.

· Looking "back":

You can choose to spend your busy life worrying about what happened in the past; the possible mistakes you've made, your missed opportunities, dreams that haven't come true, the many "buts" "ifs" while everyone's lives are full. To you Jesus repeats what he once told a young man who wanted to follow him: *"No one who puts his hand to the plow and then turns back is fit for the kingdom of God"*. He would invite you to trust that your whole history, however scarred by difficulty, is the history of salvation which he himself wrote.

· Looking "up":

You can choose to spend your life waiting for a miracle that will change the direction of your life; waiting for the Lord's clear and evident sign that will make your doubts vanish and free you from the need to look further and maybe avoid any further mistakes. To you Jesus repeats what he said to the apostles: *"Not everyone who says to me 'Lord, Lord' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father in heaven"*. And he will invite you to go with him to seek out the path, accepting even the mistakes you may make while teaching you to be humble and wise.

· Looking "down" or "shutting your eyes";

You can choose to spend your life not feeling 'up to it,' preferring not to take responsibility, which means, not chasing your dreams; not letting yourself be provoked by reality or doing the minimum. To you Jesus repeats what he said to Peter on the Lake of Gennesaret: *"Put out into the deep"* and he invites you to take risks to reach high ideals.

· LOOK AHEAD!

Choose to spend your life letting yourself be challenged and provoked by what happens every day; learning to listen to your heart – where the Lord sows the seed of His word every day. And looking ahead of you, you'll find that you are walking behind Jesus the Master who repeats to you, as he stares into your eyes with love: *"Come, follow me!"*

Mis queridos feligreses,
"Por todo lo que ha sido, gracias y por todo eso será 'sí'" (Dag Hammarskjöld).

Esa cita contiene uno de los grandes secretos de la vida: mirar hacia adelante, con esperanza y coraje, mientras aprende a mirar hacia atrás con fe y gratitud. ¿No te has dado cuenta ya de que cuando caminas tienes que poner un pie hacia delante mientras el otro está atrás? Sin embargo, ¡"mirar hacia adelante" no es algo automático! Es una elección que estás llamado a hacer todos los días.

· Mirando "hacia atrás":

Puedes elegir pasar tu ajetreada vida preocupándote por lo que sucedió en el pasado; los posibles errores que has cometido, tus oportunidades perdidas, los sueños que no se han hecho realidad, los muchos "peros", "si" mientras la vida de todos está llena. Jesús os repite lo que una vez le dijo a un joven que quería seguirlo: *"Nadie que pone la mano en el arado y luego se vuelve es apto para el reino de Dios"*. Os invita a confiar en que toda vuestra historia, aunque esté marcada por las dificultades, es la historia de la salvación que él mismo escribió.

· Mirando "hacia arriba":

Puedes elegir pasar tu vida esperando un milagro que cambie el rumbo de tu vida; esperando la señal clara y evidente del Señor que hará que tus dudas se desvanezcan y te libere de la necesidad de mirar más allá y tal vez evitar más errores. A vosotros Jesús os repite lo que dijo a los apóstoles: *«No todo el que me dice: Señor, Señor, entrará en el reino de los cielos, sino el que hace la voluntad de mi Padre que está en los cielos»*. Y te invitará a ir con él a buscar el camino, aceptando incluso los errores que puedas cometer mientras te enseña a ser humilde y sabio.

· Mirar "hacia abajo" o "cerrar los ojos"; Puedes elegir pasar tu vida sin sentirte "a la altura", prefiriendo no asumir responsabilidades, es decir, no perseguir tus sueños; no dejarte provocar por la realidad o hacer lo mínimo. A vosotros Jesús os repite lo que dijo a Pedro en el lago de Genesaret: *«Rema mar adentro»* y os invita a arriesgaros para alcanzar altos ideales.

· ¡MIRA HACIA ADELANTE!

Elige pasar tu vida dejándote interpelar y provocar por lo que sucede todos los días; aprendiendo a escuchar tu corazón, donde el Señor siembra la semilla de su palabra todos los días. Y mirando hacia adelante, encontrarás que estás caminando detrás de Jesús, el Maestro, que te repite, mientras te mira a los ojos con amor: *"¡Ven, sígueme!"*

· Olhando “para cima”:

Você pode escolher passar a vida esperando por um milagre que mudará a direção da sua vida; esperando pelo sinal claro e evidente do Senhor que fará suas dúvidas desaparecerem e o libertará da necessidade de olhar mais além e, talvez, evitar novos erros. Para você, Jesus repete o que disse a Pedro no Lago de Genesaré: “Faz-te ao largo” e o convida a correr riscos para alcançar ideais elevados.

· OLHE PARA A FRENTE!

Escolha passar a sua vida deixando-se desafiar e provocar pelo que acontece todos os dias; aprendendo a ouvir o seu coração – onde o Senhor semeia a semente da Sua palavra todos os dias. INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

„Za wszystko, co było, dziękuję, a wszystkiemu, co będzie, mówię »tak«” (Dag Hammarskjöld). Ten cytat kryje w sobie jeden z największych sekretów życia - patrzeć w przyszłość z nadzieją i odwagą, ucząc się patrzeć wstecz z wiarą i wdzięcznością. Czy zauważyłeś już, że idąc musisz postawić jedną nogę do przodu, a druga zostaje z tyłu? Jednak „patrzeć w przyszłość” nie jest czymś automatycznym! To wybór, do którego jesteś wezwany każdego dnia.

· Patrzeć „w przeszłość”:

Możesz spędzić swoje zabiegane życie na martwieniu się o to, co wydarzyło się w przeszłości, na rozważaniu o możliwych błędach, które popełniłeś, straconych okazjach, niespełnionych marzeniach, licznych „ale” i „jeśli”, podczas gdy życie każdego człowieka stanowi pełnię. Jezus powtarza ci to, co powiedział kiedyś młodemu człowiekowi, który chciał pójść za Nim: „Ktokolwiek przykłada rękę do pługa, a wstecz się ogląda, nie nadaje się do Królestwa Bożego”. On zachęca cię do zaufania, bo twoja historia, choćby naznaczona trudnościami, jest historią twego zbawienia, którą On sam napisał.

· Patrzeć „w górę”:

Możesz spędzić swoje życie w oczekiwaniu na cud, który zmieni kierunek twojego życia, czekaniu na jasny i oczywisty znak od Pana, który sprawi, że twoje wątpliwości znikną i zostaniesz uwolniony/uwolniona od potrzeby szukania dalej i być może unikniesz dalszych błędów. Ale Jezus powtarza ci to, co powiedział apostołom: „Nie każdy, kto Mi mówi: «Panie, Panie», wejdzie do Królestwa Niebieskiego, lecz ten, kto spełnia wolę mojego Ojca, który jest w niebie”. On zaprasza cię, aby iść z Nim i szukać drogi, akceptując nawet błędy, które możesz popełnić, ale jednocześnie uczy cię pokory i mądrości.

· Spojrzenie „w dół” lub „zamknięcie oczu”:

Możesz spędzić życie w niepewności, wolać nie brać na siebie odpowiedzialności, co oznacza nie podążać za marzeniami, nie dać się sprowokować rzeczywistości, robić tylko konieczne minimum. Lecz Jezus powtarza ci to, co powiedział Piotrowi nad Jeziorem Genezaret: „Wypłyn na głębię” i zaprasza cię do podejmowania ryzyka, by osiągnąć wzniosłe ideały.

· PATRZ PRZED SIEBIE!

Wybierz, by spędzić życie pozwalając, aby to, co dzieje się każdego dnia, stawiało ci wyzwania i prowokowało, ucz się słuchać swojego serca, bo tam Pan każdego dnia sieje ziarno swojego Słowa. A patrząc przed siebie odkryjesz, że idziesz za Jezusem, Mistrzem, który powtarza ci, patrząc w oczy z miłością: „Pójdź za Mną!”

We can ask God for help and trust that God listens. **In what way will you ask for God's help this week?**
