My dear parishioners,
Jesus said to the crowds: "Everything that the Father gives me will come to me, and I will not reject anyone who comes to me, because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me."

On this day, as youngsters my parents would take me and my siblings to the cemetery to visit and pray for the dead. As morbid as this may sound, it has been a blessing in my life.

I reflect on the meaning of life and death. I truly appreciate both events. I walk over to a site and take a close look at the dates that appear on the tombstone. I calculate their age. While some lived very short lives, others lived a lifetime. I take notice of when they were born, but also when they died, and I think about the events that have passed since their departure. I wonder what they would think of it all.

For me, death has always been an outstanding "proof" of an intelligent being's existence. It is definitely by design, because it is independent of all human considerations. Death ignores wealth and power. It is indiscriminate: it takes us all, and often by surprise. Death is very practical. It is the great grinding mill. It reduces all of us to dust and into a memory. Its purpose is twofold: it nudges us along to get something done, and it remind us to be grateful of others, before we/they are gone.

Of course not everyone heeds the warnings. For this reason, we pray for them today. Unlike so many things in life, with life we have one chance to live it. We can't keep trying over and over again, even if most of us would be much better at it if we had another chance at it. Nope, there is only a certain amount of time to do it, and then it is time to say goodbye. We all have jobs to do; some are short, some are long, some are known by many, some are known only by God. But God knows them all!

Of course, not all these jobs were according to the Lord's Will. Some of our departed brothers and sisters may have lived for years in conflict with their very own conscience. For this reason, we pray for them today.

What will our prayers do for them? God loves those who imitate Him. The Lord helped everyone, even those who did not know Him or believe in Him. He helped whenever and wherever he could. Today, go visit a cemetery and leave some flowers and prayers at someone's tomb. If you can't make it, please pray for the dead. You will be showing your love for them in the only way you can and in the only place you can.

Believe me, that will be worth more than you could ever imagine. It will do you and that person a lot of good.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mis queridos feligreses,

En este día, cuando éramos jóvenes, mis padres nos llevaban a mí y a mis hermanos al cementerio para visitar y orar por los muertos. Por morboso que parezca, ha sido una bendición en mi vida.

Reflexiono sobre el significado de la vida y la muerte. Realmente aprecio ambos eventos. Me acerco a un sitio y miro de cerca las fechas que aparecen en la lápida. Calculo su edad. Mientras que algunos vivieron vidas muy cortas, otros vivieron toda la vida. Me fijo en cuándo nacieron, pero también en cuándo murieron, y pienso en los acontecimientos que han pasado desde su partida. Me pregunto qué pensarían de todo esto.

Para mí, la muerte siempre ha sido una "prueba" sobresaliente de la existencia de un ser inteligente. Definitivamente es por diseño, porque es independiente de todas las consideraciones humanas. La muerte ignora la riqueza y poder. Es indiscriminado: nos toma a todos, y a menudo por sorpresa. La muerte es muy práctica. Es el gran molino. Nos reduce a todos a polvo y a un recuerdo. Su propósito es doble: nos empuja a hacer algo y nos recuerda que debemos estar agradecidos con los demás, antes de que nos vayamos.

Por supuesto, no todos prestan atención a las advertencias. Por esta razón, oramos por ellos hoy. A diferencia de tantas cosas en la vida, con la vida tenemos una oportunidad de vivirla. No podemos seguir intentándolo una y otra vez, incluso si la mayoría de nosotros seríamos mucho mejores si tuviéramos otra oportunidad. Estarás mostrando tu amor por ellos de la única manera que puedes y en el único lugar que puedes.

Créeme, eso valdrá más de lo que puedas imaginar. Te hará y hará a esa persona mucho bien.

Você estará demonstrando seu amor por eles da única maneira que puder e no único lugar que puder. Acredite, isso valerá mais do que você jamais poderia imaginar. Fará muito bem a você e a essa pessoa.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

W dzisiejszym fragmencie Ewangelii Jezus mówi do tłumów: „Wszystko, co Mi daje Ojciec, do Mnie przyjdzie, a tego, który do Mnie przychodzi, precz nie odrzucę, ponieważ z nieba zstąpiłem nie po

to, aby pełnić swoją wolę, ale wolę Tego, który Mnie posłał”.

Gdy byłem dzieckiem, we Wspomnienie wszystkich wiernych zmarłych moi rodzice zabierali mnie i moje rodzeństwo na cmentarz, abyśmy odwiedzali zmarłych i modlili się za nich. Choć dla niektórych może brzmieć to dziwnie, było to błogosławieństwo w moim życiu. Gdy zastanawiam się nad sensem życia i śmierci, to naprawdę doceniam tamten czas. Na cmentarzu często podchodzę do grobu i uważnie przyglądam się datom widniejącym na płycie nagrobnej. Obliczam wiek zmarłych. Niektórzy żyli bardzo krótko, inni dożyli pięknego wieku. Zwracam uwagę na to, kiedy się urodzili, ale także na to, kiedy zmarli i myślę o wydarzeniach, które miały miejsce po ich odejściu. Zastanawiam się, co pomyśleliby o tym, co dzieje się dzisiaj.

Dla mnie śmierć zawsze była niezwykłym „dowodem” istnienia ponad nami „istoty rozumnej”. Śmierć z pewnością jest zaplanowana, ponieważ jest niezależna od wszelkich ludzkich uwarunkowań. Ignoruje ona bogactwo i władzę. Jest bezwzględna, zabiera nas wszystkich, często z zaskoczenia. Śmierć jest bardzo praktyczna. Jest jak wielki młyn. Sprawia, że wszyscy zamieniamy się w proch i we wspomnienie. Jej cel jest dwójaki: popycha nas do działania i przypomina nam, żebyśmy byli wdzięczni innym, zanim stąd odejdziemy.

Oczywiście nie wszyscy zwracają uwagę na te ostrzeżenia. Dlatego modlimy się za nich dzisiaj. W przeciwieństwie do wielu innych szans, mamy tylko jedną szansę na dobre życie. Nie możemy próbować w kółko, nawet jeśli większość z nas byłaby w czymś o wiele lepsza, gdybyśmy mieli drugą możliwość. Ale nie, mamy tylko określoną ilość czasu, by coś zrobić, a potem przychodzi czas pożegnania. Wszyscy mamy zadania do wykonania. Niektóre są krótkie, niektóre długie, niektóre znane są wielu, niektóre znane są tylko Bogu. Ale Bóg zna je wszystkie! Oczywiście, nie wszystkie nasze działania były zgodne z Wolą Bożą. Niektórzy z naszych zmarłych braci i siostr mogli latami żyć w konflikcie z własnym sumieniem. Dlatego modlimy się za nich dzisiaj.

Co przyniosą im nasze modlitwy? Bóg kocha tych, którzy Go naśladową. Pan pomagał wszystkim, nawet tym, którzy Go nie znali ani w Niego nie wierzyli. Pomagał zawsze i wszędzie, gdzie tylko mógł. Dlatego pamiętajcie dziś odwiedzić cmentarz, zanieść kwiaty i odmówić modlitwy przy czyimś grobie. Jeśli z jakiegoś powodu nie możecie pójść, proszę, pomódlcie się za zmarłych.

Okażecie im swoją miłość w jedyny możliwy sposób, w miejscu, w którym aktualnie jesteście. Uwiercie mi, to będzie warte więcej, niż możecie sobie wyobrazić. Przyniesie to wiele dobrego zarówno Wam jak i zmarłym.

Niech Was Bóg błogosławi.

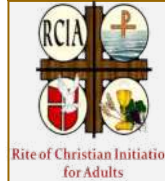
***Celebrando el Domingo a lo Largo de la Semana

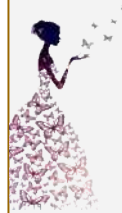

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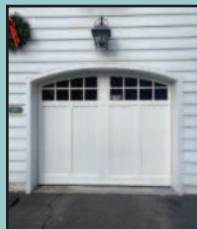
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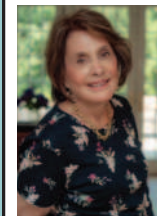
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
