OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

The Parish of St. John Bosco is a multi-cultural, multi-lingual Catholic Faith community that proclaims Jesus Christ. In the spirit of St. John Bosco, we do this by being a **Home** that welcomes all especially the young and the poor; a **School that prepares for life** through religious, educational and social services; a **Parish that evangelizes** through Word & Sacrament, Worship and Faith Formation; a **Playground where lasting friendship** and relationships are formed and developed through recreational and social opportunities.

FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear Parishioners,

The most important temple is the temple of a person's soul because God dwells within each one of us.

In addition to the temple of the soul, there are many sacred places throughout the world.

There are shrines, churches, basilicas, grottos, cathedrals, and other holy places that are set aside for the sole purpose of worship of God. Today's feast commemorates one such place, the most important church on earth.

In the city of Rome, there are four major basilicas. The first three are Saint Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, and the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. The fourth is the Archbasilica Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran, also called Saint John Lateran, or the Lateran Basilica for short. Of the four major basilicas, the oldest and most important is Saint John Lateran, the dedication of which is remembered today.

Though the pope now lives next to Saint Peter's Basilica, Saint John Lateran is the official cathedral of Rome. That means Saint John Lateran is not only the mother church of the Archdiocese of Rome but also the mother church of the entire world. The church building has a long and storied history. In the year 64, the erratic and cruel Roman Emperor Nero blamed a devastating fire in Rome on the Christians. In retaliation, he ordered the execution of many Christians, including Saints Peter and Paul. In 65, there was a conspiracy to kill Nero with the help of the Counsel-designate Plautius Lateranus (Lateran). When Nero learned of the plot, he immediately beheaded Lateranus and confiscated his home, the Lateran Palace. Subsequent Roman emperors used the palace in various ways over the next 250 years. In 312, when Constantine the Great became the sole ruler of the Western Roman Empire, he took possession of the Lateran Palace. The following year, after issuing the Edict of Milan with Emperor Licinius of the Eastern Roman Empire, Constantine donated the Lateran Palace to Pope Miltiades who first used it to conduct a synod of bishops and then began constructing the first Basilica in Rome. Upon its completion in the year 324, it was dedicated by Pope Sylvester and given the name the "House of God," with a special designation to Christ the Savior. With that, the first cathedral in the most important diocese was established.

As we honor the mother church of the whole world, ponder the importance of a church building. A church is sacred because it is exclusively dedicated to the worship of God. Saint John Lateran is an exclusive-purpose church. It is the pope's cathedral from which the entire Church is governed and the central place of worship for the world.

As we honor the dedication of that church in 324, pray for the Church today. Pray for St. John Bosco Parish. Our churches and sacred places exist to be places where we come to encounter God. Pray for the pope in a particular way today, that Saint John Lateran will always be a place where he, and every pope after him, will encounter God in a profound way.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mis queridos feligreses,

El templo más importante es el templo del alma de una persona porque Dios habita dentro de cada uno de nosotros.

Además del templo del alma, hay muchos lugares sagrados en todo el mundo.

Hay santuarios, iglesias, basílicas, grutas, catedrales y otros lugares santos que están reservados con el único propósito de adorar a Dios. La fiesta de hoy conmemora uno de esos lugares, la iglesia más importante de la tierra.

En la ciudad de Roma, hay cuatro basílicas principales. Las tres primeras son la Basílica de San Pedro en la Ciudad del Vaticano, la Basílica de San Pablo Extramuros y la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor. La cuarta es la Archibasílica Catedral del Santísimo Salvador y de los Santos Juan Bautista y Juan Evangelista en Letrán, también llamada San Juan de Letrán, o la Basílica de Letrán para abreviar. De las cuatro basílicas principales, la más antigua e importante es la de San Juan de Letrán, cuya dedicación se recuerda hoy.

Aunque el papa ahora vive al lado de la Basílica de San Pedro, San Juan de Letrán es la catedral oficial de Roma. Eso significa que San Juan de Letrán no solo es la iglesia madre de la Arquidiócesis de Roma, sino también la iglesia madre del mundo entero. El edificio de la iglesia tiene una larga historia. En el año 64, el errático y cruel emperador romano Nerón culpó a los cristianos de un devastador incendio en Roma. En represalia, ordenó la ejecución de muchos cristianos, incluidos los santos Pedro y Pablo. En el año 65, hubo una conspiración para matar a Nerón con la ayuda del Consejo designado Plaucio Lateranus (Letrán). Cuando Nerón se enteró del complot, inmediatamente decapitó a Letrán y confiscó su casa, el Palacio de Letrán. Los emperadores romanos posteriores usaron el palacio de varias maneras durante los siguientes 250 años. En 312, cuando Constantino el Grande se convirtió en el único gobernante del Imperio Romano de Occidente, tomó posesión del Palacio de Letrán. Al año siguiente, después de emitir el Edicto de Milán con el emperador Licinio del Imperio Romano de Oriente, Constantino donó el Palacio de Letrán al Papa Milciades, quien primero lo usó para llevar a cabo un sínodo de obispos y luego comenzó a construir la primera basílica en Roma. Tras su finalización en el año 324, fue dedicada por el Papa Silvestre y se le dio el nombre de "Casa de Dios", con una designación especial a Cristo Salvador. Con eso, se estableció la primera catedral de la diócesis más importante.

Al honrar a la iglesia madre de todo el mundo, medita en la importancia de un edificio de la iglesia. Una iglesia es sagrada porque está dedicada exclusivamente a la adoración de Dios. San Juan de Letrán es una iglesia de propósito exclusivo. Es la catedral del Papa desde la que se gobierna toda la Iglesia y el lugar central de culto para el mundo.

Al honrar la dedicación de esa iglesia en el año 324, oremos por la Iglesia hoy. Oremos por la Parroquia de San Juan Bosco. Nuestras iglesias y lugares sagrados existen para ser lugares donde nos encontramos con Dios. Oremos por el Papa de una manera particular hoy, para que San Juan de Letrán sea siempre un lugar donde él, y todos los Papas después de él, se encuentren con Dios de una manera profunda.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus queridos paroquianos,

O templo mais importante é o templo da alma de uma pessoa, pois Deus habita dentro de cada um de nós.

Além do templo da alma, existem muitos lugares sagrados em todo o mundo. Existem santuários, igrejas, basílicas, grutas, catedrais e outros lugares sagrados que são reservados exclusivamente para a adoração a Deus. A festa de hoje comemora um desses lugares, a igreja mais importante da Terra.

Na cidade de Roma, existem quatro basílicas principais. As três primeiras são a Basílica de São Pedro no Vaticano, a Basílica de São Paulo Extramuros e a Basílica de Santa Maria Maior. A quarta é a Arquibasílica Catedral do Santíssimo Salvador e dos Santos João Batista e João Evangelista no Latrão, também chamada de São João de Latrão, ou Basílica de Latrão, para abreviar. Das quatro basílicas principais, a mais antiga e mais importante é a de São João de Latrão, cuja dedicação é lembrada hoje.

Embora o papa agora more ao lado da Basílica de São Pedro, São João de Latrão é a catedral oficial de Roma. Isso significa que São João de Latrão não é apenas a igreja-mãe da Arquidiocese de Roma, mas também a igreja-mãe do mundo inteiro. O edifício da igreja tem uma longa e rica história. No ano 64, o errático e cruel imperador romano Nero culpou os cristãos por um incêndio devastador em Roma. Em retaliação, ele ordenou a execução de muitos cristãos, incluindo os Santos Pedro e Paulo. Em 65, houve uma conspiração para matar Nero com a ajuda do cônsul-designado Plautius Lateranus (Latrão). Quando Nero descobriu a trama, imediatamente decapitou Lateranus e confiscou sua casa, o Palácio de Latrão. Os imperadores romanos subsequentes usaram o palácio de várias maneiras nos 250 anos seguintes.

Em 312, quando Constantino, o Grande, tornou-se o único governante do Império Romano do Ocidente, ele tomou posse do Palácio de Latrão. No ano seguinte, após emitir o Édito de Milão com o Imperador Licínio do Império Romano do Oriente, Constantino doou o Palácio de Latrão ao Papa Melquíades, que o utilizou primeiramente para realizar um sínodo de bispos e, em seguida, iniciou a construção da primeira Basílica em Roma.

Após sua conclusão, no ano 324, foi dedicada pelo Papa Silvestre e recebeu o nome de "Casa de Deus", com uma designação especial a Cristo Salvador. Assim, foi estabelecida a primeira catedral da diocese mais importante. Ao honrarmos a igreja-mãe de todo o mundo, refletimos sobre a importância de um edifício religioso. Uma igreja é sagrada porque é exclusivamente dedicada à adoração de Deus. São João de Latrão é uma igreja com uma finalidade exclusiva. É a catedral do Papa, de onde toda a Igreja é governada e o principal local de culto para o mundo.

Ao celebrarmos a dedicação dessa igreja em 324, rezemos pela Igreja hoje. Rezemos pela Paróquia de São João Bosco. Nossas igrejas e lugares sagrados existem para serem locais onde nos encontramos com Deus.

Rezemos de maneira especial pelo Papa hoje, para que São João de Latrão seja sempre um lugar onde ele, e todos os papas depois dele, encontrem Deus de uma maneira profunda.

Deus os abençoe.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Najważniejszą świątynią jest świątynia ludzkiej duszy, ponieważ Bóg mieszka w każdym z nas. Ale oprócz tego na całym świecie istnieje wiele świętych miejsc. Sanktuaria, katedry, kościoły, bazyliki, grotty oraz inne miejsca, które są przeznaczone wyłącznie do sprawowania kultu Bożego.

Dzisiejsze święto upamiętnia jedno z tych miejsc, najważniejszy kościół na ziemi. W Rzymie znajdują się cztery Bazyliki Większe. Są to Bazylika Świętego Piotra na Watykanie, Bazylika Świętego Pawła za Murami, Bazylika Matki Boskiej Większej oraz czwarta Arcybazylika Najświętszego Zbawiciela i świętych Jana Chrzciciela i Jana Ewangelisty na Lateranie, zwana w skrócie Bazyliką Świętego Jana na Lateranie lub po prostu Bazyliką Laterańską. Spośród czterech Bazylik Większych jest ona najstarsza i najważniejsza, a dzisiaj wspominamy rocznicę jej poświęcenia. Chociaż papież mieszka obecnie obok Bazyliki Świętego Piotra, kościół Św. Jana na Lateranie jest oficjalną katedrą Rzymu. Oznacza to, że jest on nie tylko kościołem-matką archidiecezji rzymskiej, ale także kościołem-matką całego świata.

Budowla ta ma długą i bogatą historię. W roku 64 kapryśny i okrutny cesarz rzymski Neron zrzucił winę za niszczycielski pożar w mieście na chrześcijan. W odwecie nakazał egzekucję wielu chrześcijan, w tym świętych Piotra i Pawła. Rok później, z pomocą nominowanego na radcę prawnego Plaucjusza Laterana sprzysiężono się, by zabić Nerona. Ten jednak dowiedział się o spisku, natychmiast ścigał Laterana i skonfiskował jego dom, Pałac Laterański. Kolejni cesarze rzymscy wykorzystywali obiekt w różny sposób przez następne 250 lat. W 312 roku, kiedy Konstantyn Wielki został władcą Zachodniego Cesarstwa Rzymskiego, objął w posiadanie także Pałac Laterański. W następnym roku, po wydaniu edyktu mediolańskiego, wraz z cesarzem Licyniuszem z Cesarstwa Wschodniorzymskiego Konstantyn podarował Pałac Laterański papieżowi Miltiadesowi, który najpierw przeprowadził w nim synod biskupów, a następnie rozpoczął budowę pierwszej Bazyliki w Rzymie. Po jej ukończeniu w 324 roku, została ona poświęcona przez papieża Sylwestra i nazwana „Domem Bożym”, szczególnie poświęconym Chrystusowi Zbawicielowi. W ten sposób powstała pierwsza katedra w najważniejszej diecezji Kościoła.

Pragnąc uczcić kościół-matkę całego świata zastanówmy się nad znaczeniem budynku sakralnego. Kościół jest święty, ponieważ jest poświęcony wyłącznie kultowi Bożemu. Bazylika św. Jana na Lateranie jest kościołem o wyjątkowym znaczeniu. Jest katedrą papieża, z której kieruje on całym Kościołem, więc także stanowi ona centralne miejsce kultu dla całego świata. Świętując jej poświęcenie w 324 roku modlimy się dziś za cały Kościół Powszechny. Modlimy się za parafię św. Jana Bosko. Nasze kościoły i miejsca święte istnieją po to, abyśmy przychodząc do nich mogli spotkać Boga. Modlimy się szczególnie za papieża, aby Bazylika św. Jana na Lateranie zawsze była miejscem, w którym on i każdy papież po nim będzie mógł spotykać Boga w głębi swojej duszy.

***Celebrating Sunday Throughout the Week
The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica John
2:13-22***

In today's Gospel, listen to find out what makes Jesus angry.

On today's feast, we are reminded that the Saint John Lateran Basilica is the cathedral of Rome, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, the pope. The basilica dates back to the time of Constantine the Great in the fourth century and was dedicated on November 9 in AD 324. Constantine was an emperor who converted to Christianity. He allowed Christians to worship in public after a long time of persecution. Therefore today's feast celebrates freedom of worship. In today's Gospel, Jesus is angry. He does not harm anyone, but he tips over tables and drives the animals from the Temple. Jesus is angry because greedy people were using the Temple as a marketplace. Jesus was upset with the money changers because they did not show respect for a sacred place. Jesus shows us that it is okay to get angry when someone does something that is not right. Today's Gospel reminds us that our churches are sacred places. **How can your words and actions this week show that you are a member of the Catholic Church?**



***Celebrando el Domingo a lo Largo de la Semana
La Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán Juan 2:13-22***

En el Evangelio de hoy, escucha para descubrir qué enfurece a Jesús. En la fiesta de hoy, recordamos que la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán es la catedral de Roma, la catedral del obispo de Roma, el papa. La basílica data de la época de Constantino el Grande en el siglo IV y fue consagrada el 9 de noviembre del año 324 d. C. Constantino fue un emperador que se convirtió al cristianismo. Permitió a los cristianos practicar su culto en público tras un largo período de persecución. Por lo tanto, la fiesta de hoy celebra la libertad de culto. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús está enojado. No daña a nadie, pero vuelca las mesas y expulsa a los animales del Templo. Jesús está enojado porque la gente codiciosa usaba el Templo como mercado. Jesús estaba molesto con los cambistas porque no mostraban respeto por un lugar sagrado. Jesús nos enseña que está bien enojarse cuando alguien hace algo que no está bien. 
