OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

The Parish of St. John Bosco is a multi-cultural, multi-lingual Catholic Faith community that proclaims Jesus Christ. FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear parishioners,

The temple at Jerusalem was an incredibly large and imposing building. It was a feat of ancient engineering, finished under the oversight of Herod the Great shortly before Jesus was born. In real terms, the temple itself was about the size of an NFL football field. That was the main temple building and the inner courts. However, if you include the outer courts the whole temple campus, we're talking about the size of 28 football fields. It was big!

But the temple was not only large in size, but it was also large in significance: it was one of the cornerstones of the Jewish faith. The temple was the place where sacrifices laid out in the OT were to be offered: it was the very place where atonement for sin could be made. It was God's house: it contained the holy of holies - the sacred space in which God himself dwelled and into which only the high priest would go only once a year on the Day of Atonement. The temple was the sacred center for the hustle and bustle of the various different annual feasts and festivals.

And the disciples hear from Jesus that the temple is going to be razed to the ground. On the contrary they expected Jesus to speak of the destruction of the Romans who occupied Jerusalem or the fall of Rome. But instead he tells them it is their house that is going to fall, an event which actually happened at the hands of the Romans in 70AD.

What is Jesus' point here? Don't get too attached to the world around you. It will not last. It will not endure. The things of this life are temporary—even the good and God-pleasing things like the temple was. Everything has an expiration date.

That's a challenge in this life, right? Jesus reminds us that it's all temporary, it will all pass away. Nothing endures, and we need to stay focused on what is eternally coming, not only on what is right in front of us. But what about between now and then? We still have responsibilities. We still have family to care for, a Church to worship at, people to share the gospel with. We still have tasks to complete and promises to keep. We still need to do our best in whatever vocations we are serving in. We still have love to show and empathy to be poured out. So we need to tend to those tasks.

What's the take away? We do well to serve in our roles that we've been given faithfully and honestly. But whether we are nurturing our children or going about our daily chores, we have to recognize that we cannot change the impact sin has on the world around us, on the people we love, and on our own hearts. Only Jesus can do that. So great is the love and victory of our Savior that not even the most fragile part of our body will be lost; by God's grace we will reach the coming glory unscathed because Jesus has died for our sins so that we might be saved.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mis queridos feligreses,

El templo de Jerusalén era un edificio increíblemente grande e imponente. Fue una hazaña de ingeniería antigua, terminada bajo la supervisión de Herodes el Grande poco antes de que naciera Jesús. En términos reales, el templo en sí era del tamaño de un campo de fútbol de la NFL. Ese era el edificio principal del templo y los patios interiores. Sin embargo, si incluye las canchas exteriores de todo el espacio del templo, estamos hablando del tamaño de 28 campos de fútbol. ¡Fue grande!

Pero el templo no solo era grande en tamaño, sino también en importancia: era una de las piedras angulares de la fe judía. El templo era el lugar donde se ofrecían los sacrificios establecidos en el Antiguo Testamento: era el mismo lugar donde se podía hacer expiación por el pecado. Era la casa de Dios: contenía el lugar santísimo, el espacio sagrado en el que Dios mismo moraba y al que solo el sumo sacerdote entraba solo una vez al año en el Día de la Expiación. El templo era el centro sagrado para el ajetreo y el bullicio de las diferentes fiestas y festivales anuales.

Y los discípulos escuchan de Jesús que el templo va a ser arrasado hasta los cimientos. Por el contrario, esperaban que Jesús hablara de la destrucción de los romanos que ocuparon Jerusalén o de la caída de Roma. Pero en lugar de eso, les dice que es su casa la que va a caer, un evento que en realidad sucedió a manos de los romanos en el año 70 d.C.

¿Cuál es el punto de Jesús aquí? No te apegues demasiado al mundo que te rodea. No durará. No perdurará. Las cosas de esta vida son temporales, incluso las cosas buenas y agradables a Dios como lo era el templo. Todo tiene fecha de expiración.

Ese es un desafío en esta vida, ¿verdad? Jesús nos recuerda que todo es temporal, que todo pasará. Nada perdura, y debemos mantenernos enfocados en lo que viene eternamente, no solo en lo que está justo frente a nosotros.

Pero, ¿qué pasa entre ahora y en ese entonces? Todavía tenemos responsabilidades. Todavía tenemos una familia que cuidar, una Iglesia a la que adorar, personas con las que compartir el Evangelio. Todavía tenemos tareas que completar y promesas que cumplir. Todavía tenemos que hacer nuestro mejor esfuerzo en cualquier vocación en la que estemos sirviendo. Todavía tenemos amor que mostrar y empatía que derramar. Así que tenemos que ocuparnos de esas tareas.

¿Cuál es la conclusión? Hacemos bien en servir en nuestros roles que se nos han dado de manera fiel y honesta. Pero ya sea que estemos criando a nuestros hijos o realizando nuestras tareas diarias, tenemos que reconocer que no podemos cambiar el impacto que el pecado tiene en el mundo que nos rodea, en las personas que amamos y en nuestros propios corazones. Solo Jesús puede hacer eso.

Tan grande es el amor y la victoria de nuestro Salvador que ni siquiera la parte más frágil de nuestro cuerpo se perderá; por la gracia de Dios alcanzaremos la gloria venidera ilesos porque Jesús ha muerto por nuestros pecados para que podamos ser salvos.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus queridos paroquianos,

O templo de Jerusalém era um edifício incrivelmente grande e imponente. Era uma obra-prima da engenharia antiga, concluída sob a supervisão de Herodes, o Grande, pouco antes do nascimento de Jesus. Em termos práticos, o templo principal tinha o tamanho de um campo de futebol americano. Isso incluía o edifício principal e os pátios internos. No entanto, se incluirmos os pátios externos, todo o complexo tinha o tamanho de 28 campos de futebol americano. Era enorme!

Mas o templo não era grande apenas em tamanho, mas também em significado: era um dos pilares da fé judaica. O templo era o lugar onde os sacrifícios descritos no Antigo Testamento deveriam ser oferecidos: era o próprio lugar onde a expiação pelos pecados podia ser feita. Era a casa de Deus: continha o Santo dos Santos — o espaço sagrado onde o próprio Deus habitava e onde apenas o sumo sacerdote entrava, uma vez por ano, no Dia da Expição. O templo era o centro sagrado para a celebração das diversas festas e festivais anuais.

E os discípulos ouvem de Jesus que o templo será arrasado. Pelo contrário, eles esperavam que Jesus falasse da destruição dos romanos que ocupavam Jerusalém ou da queda de Roma. Mas, em vez disso, ele lhes diz que é a casa deles que vai cair, um evento que de fato aconteceu pelas mãos dos romanos em 70 d.C. Qual é o ponto de Jesus aqui? Não se apeguem demais ao mundo ao seu redor. Ele não durará. Não permanecerá. As coisas desta vida são temporárias — mesmo as coisas boas e agradáveis a Deus, como era o templo. Tudo tem prazo de validade.

Esse é um desafio nesta vida, não é? Jesus nos lembra que tudo é temporário, tudo passará. Nada dura para sempre, e precisamos nos manter focados no que virá eternamente, e não apenas no que está bem à nossa frente. Mas e o que acontece entre agora e então? Ainda temos responsabilidades. Ainda temos família para cuidar, uma igreja para frequentar, pessoas com quem compartilhar o Evangelho. Ainda temos tarefas a cumprir e promessas a manter. Ainda precisamos dar o nosso melhor em qualquer serviço que estejamos exercendo, também precisamos demonstrar amor e empatia. Portanto, precisamos cuidar dessas tarefas.

Qual é a mensagem principal? Fazemos bem em cumprir fielmente e honestamente os papéis que nos foram confiados. Mas, quer estejamos cuidando de nossos filhos ou realizando nossas tarefas diárias, precisamos reconhecer que não podemos mudar o impacto que o pecado tem no mundo ao nosso redor, nas pessoas que amamos e em nossos próprios corações. Somente Jesus pode fazer isso.

Tão grande é o amor e a vitória do nosso Salvador que nem mesmo a parte mais frágil do nosso corpo se perderá; pela graça de Deus, alcançaremos a glória vindoura ílesos, porque Jesus morreu por nossos pecados para que fôssemos salvos.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Świątynia jerozolimska była niezwykle wielką i imponującą budowlą. Była dziełem starożytnej inżynierii, ukończonym pod nadzorem Heroda Wielkiego na krótko przed narodzinami Jezusa. W rzeczywistości sama Świątynia miała mniej więcej wielkość boiska futbolowego. Składała się z głównego budynku świątyni i dziedzińców wewnętrznych. Jeśli jednak wliczymy dziedzińce zewnętrzne czyli cały teren świątyni, to mówimy o wielkości około 28 boisk futbolowych. Była ona naprawdę ogromna! Świątynia była duża i równie ogromne było jej znaczenie: stanowiła jeden z fundamentów wiary żydowskiej.

Była miejscem składania ofiar Starego Testamentu, to tam można było dokonać przebłagania za grzechy. Była domem Bożym, zawierała Miejsce Najświętsze – przestrzeń sakralną, w której mieszkał sam Bóg, do której arcykapłan wchodził tylko raz w roku, w Dniu Przebłagania. Była liturgicznym centrum pełnym gwaru i wrzawy podczas dorocznych świąt i uroczystości.

Tymczasem uczniowie słyszą od Jezusa, że świątynia zostanie zrównana z ziemią. Spodziewali się czegoś przeciwnego, że Jezus będzie mówił o zniszczeniu Rzymian okupujących Jerozolimę lub o upadku Rzymu. Zamiast tego mówi im, że ich dom upadnie, co rzeczywiście Rzymianie uczynili w 70 roku n.e. O co chodzi Jezusowi? Nie przywiązujcie się zbyt mocno do otaczającego was świata.

On nie przetrwa. Nie przetrwa. Rzeczy w tym życiu są tymczasowe, nawet te dobre i miłe Bogu tak jak świątynia. Wszystko ma swoją datę ważności.

Taki punkt widzenia to dla nas wyzwanie, czyż nie? Jezus przypomina nam, że wszystko jest tymczasowe, wszystko przemienie. Tutaj nic nie trwa wiecznie i dlatego musimy skupiać się na tym, co kieruje nas ku wieczności, a nie tylko na tym, co jest tuż przed nami. Ale co z czasem znajdującym się między teraz a potem? Nadal mamy obowiązki. Nadal mamy rodziny, o które musimy się troszczyć, kościół, w którym czcimy Boga, ludzi, z którymi możemy dzielić się Ewangelią. Wciąż mamy zadania do wykonania i obietnice do dotrzymania. Wciąż musimy dawać z siebie wszystko w tym, do czego jesteście powołani. Wciąż mamy okazywać miłość i empatię.

Musimy więc zająć się tym wszystkim. Jaki z tego wniosek? Pewnie dobrze, wiernie i uczciwie wykonujemy powierzone nam zadania. Ale niezależnie od tego, czy wychowujemy dzieci, czy wykonujemy codzienne obowiązki, musimy zdawać sobie sprawę, że nie możemy zatrzymać wpływu grzechu na otaczający nas świat, na ludzi, których kochamy, a nawet na nasze serca. Tylko Jezus może to uczynić. Miłość i zwycięstwo Zbawiciela są tak wielkie, że nie zginie nawet najszabsza część naszego ciała, a dzięki łasce Bożej osiągniemy przyszłą chwałę bez szwanku, ponieważ Jezus umarł za nasze grzechy, abyśmy mogli być zbawieni.




