FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear parishioners,

One of the stunning parts of this text is the location. This passage comes on the heels of Judas leaving the last supper to betray Jesus.

It is an amazing moment in the text. We know what is coming and we know where Judas is off to. And in this moment, Jesus wants to prepare his disciples for that reality and to command them to love one another.

It's a command!

The new commandment in this text — to love one another — is arguably one of the more famous statements in the biblical text. Even folks who are not active participants in the church know this commandment.

Loving those with whom we agree or are partial to is the easy part. Loving the rest of the folks we come in contact with is much harder. It is a part of the human condition to love and to want to be loved. Reality is ... it's easier to love those who are more loving and lovable.

Here is something to think about: When we love one another — no matter who they are — justice and peace become part of our reality. When we work for justice and peace, we are living into the love we are commanded to show by Jesus.

For Jesus, love did not mean a sweet sentimental feeling. It meant action. It meant actively loving — putting one's love into real world activities. This new commandment comes as part of a farewell address by Jesus to his followers... at a time he knows that he is going to be betrayed by his own disciple and crucified. Yet, he says, love one another. And he does this with a sense of tenderness and mercy. That to me is love in action!

He commands the disciples to love one another, but he also reminds them that they will continue to feel his presence despite the fact that he will not be with them.

This act, to love others, is a distinguishing mark of the followers of Christ then and will continue to be. "They will know we are Christians by our love."

Some would say that one of the weaknesses of the church today is the way many Christians do not embody this commandment — commanding his followers to love their neighbor.

Jesus makes plain his call to the disciples. "Let me give you a new command: Love one another. In the same way I loved you, you love one another. This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples — when they see the love you have for each other".

Jesus was bold and clear then.

How much clearer do we need Jesus to be for our own lives of discipleship now?

Pray for me.

God bless you.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mis queridos feligreses,

una de las partes impresionantes de este texto es la ubicación. Este pasaje llega justo después de que Judas dejara la última cena para traicionar a Jesús.

Es un momento increíble en el texto. Sabemos lo que viene y sabemos a dónde va Judas. Y en este momento, Jesús quiere preparar a sus discípulos para esa realidad y mandarles que se amen unos a otros.

¡Es una orden!

El nuevo mandamiento en este texto, amarnos los unos a los otros, es posiblemente una de las declaraciones más famosas en el texto bíblico. Incluso las personas que no son participantes activos en la iglesia conocen este mandamiento.

Amar a aquellos con los que estamos de acuerdo o con los que somos parciales es la parte fácil, mientras que amar al resto de las personas con las que entramos en contacto es mucho más difícil. Es parte de la condición humana amar y querer ser amado. La realidad es ... Es más fácil amar a aquellos que son más amorosos y dignos de ser amados.

Aquí hay algo en lo que pensar: cuando nos amamos unos a otros, sin importar quiénes sean, la justicia y la paz se convierten en parte de nuestra realidad. Cuando trabajamos por la justicia y la paz, estamos viviendo en el amor que Jesús nos manda mostrar.

Para Jesús, el amor no significa un dulce sentimiento. Significa acción, significa amar activamente, poner el amor de uno en las actividades del mundo real. Este nuevo mandamiento llega como parte de un discurso de despedida de Jesús a sus seguidores... En un momento sabe que va a ser traicionado por su propio discípulo y crucificado. Sin embargo, dice, ámense los unos a los otros. Y lo hace con un sentido de ternura y misericordia. ¡Eso para mí es amor en acción!

Ordena a los discípulos que se amen unos a otros, pero también les recuerda que seguirán sintiendo su presencia a pesar de que El no estará con ellos.

Este acto, amar a los demás, es una marca distintiva de los seguidores de Cristo de entonces y lo seguirá siendo. "Sabrán que somos cristianos por nuestro amor".

Algunos dirían que una de las debilidades de la iglesia hoy en día es la forma en que muchos cristianos no encarnan este mandamiento: ordenar a sus seguidores que amen a su prójimo.

Jesús deja claro su llamado a los discípulos. "Permítanme darles un nuevo mandamiento: Amaos los unos a los otros. De la misma manera que yo os amé, os amáis los unos a los otros. Así es como todos reconocerán que ustedes son mis discípulos, cuando vean el amor que se tienen los unos a los otros".

Jesús fue audaz y claro entonces.

¿Cuánto más claro necesitamos que Jesús sea para nuestras propias vidas de discipulado ahora?

Rezad por mí. Que Dios te bendiga.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus queridos paroquianos,
Uma das partes impressionantes do Evangelho deste domingo é a localização. Esta passagem vem logo após Judas deixar a última ceia para trair Jesus. É um momento incrível no texto. Sabemos o que está por vir e sabemos para onde Judas está indo. E neste momento Jesus quer preparar os seus discípulos para essa realidade e ordenar-lhes que se amem uns aos outros.

O novo mandamento neste texto – amar uns aos outros – é sem dúvida uma das declarações mais famosas do texto bíblico. É um comando! Mesmo as pessoas que não são participantes ativos na igreja conhecem este mandamento.

Amar aqueles com quem concordamos ou com quem temos parcialidade é a parte fácil. Amar o resto das pessoas com quem temos contato é muito mais difícil. Faz parte da condição humana amar e querer ser amado. A realidade é... é mais fácil amar aqueles que são mais amorosos e amáveis. Aqui está algo em que pensar: quando amamos uns aos outros - não importa quem sejam - a justiça e a paz tornam-se parte da nossa realidade. Quando trabalhamos pela justiça e pela paz, vivemos o amor que Jesus nos ordenou demonstrar.

Para Jesus, o amor não significava apenas algo sentimental, significava ação. Significava amar ativamente – colocar o amor em atividades do mundo real. Este novo mandamento surge como parte de um discurso de despedida de Jesus aos seus seguidores... num momento em que ele sabe que será traído pelo seu próprio discípulo e crucificado. No entanto, ele diz, amem uns aos outros. E ele faz isso com um sentimento de ternura e misericórdia. Isso para mim é amor em ação!

Ele ordena aos discípulos que amem uns aos outros, mas também lhes lembra que continuarão a sentir a sua presença, apesar de ele não estar com eles. Este ato, de amar os outros, é uma marca distintiva dos seguidores de Cristo do passado e continuará a ser no futuro. “Eles saberão que somos cristãos pelo nosso amor.”

Alguns diriam que uma das fraquezas da igreja hoje é a forma como muitos cristãos não incorporam este mandamento – ordenando aos seus seguidores que amem o seu próximo.

Jesus deixa claro seu chamado aos discípulos. "Deixe-me dar-lhes um novo mandamento: amem-se uns aos outros. Da mesma forma que eu os amei, vocês se amam. É assim que todos reconhecerão que vocês são meus discípulos - quando virem o amor que vocês têm uns pelos outros".

Jesus foi ousado e claro. Quão mais claro precisamos que Jesus seja para nossas próprias vidas agora?

Orem por mim.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Jedną z oszałamiających części tekstu z Ewangelii jest jego umiejscowienie w czasie. Pojawia się on tuż po tym, jak Judasz opuszcza ostatnią wieczerzę, aby zdradzić Jezusa. To niesamowity moment. Wiemy, co nadchodzi i dokąd zmierza Judasz. W tym momencie Jezus chce przygotować swoich uczniów na zbliżającą się rzeczywistość i nakazuje im, aby się wzajemnie miłowali. To jest przykazanie!

Nowe przykazanie, aby się wzajemnie miłować, jest prawdopodobnie jednym z bardziej znanych zdań w tekście biblijnym. Nawet osoby, które niezbyt aktywnie uczestniczą w życiu Kościoła, znają to przykazanie.

Kochać tych, z którymi się zgadzamy, którzy są po naszej stronie, jest rzeczą łatwą. Ale kochanie reszty ludzi, których spotykamy, jest znacznie trudniejsze. Częścią ludzkiej natury jest miłość oraz chęć bycia kochanym. Jednak wiemy, że łatwiej jest kochać tych, którzy nas bardziej kochają i zasługują na miłość.

Oto temat do przemyślenia: Kiedy miłujemy się nawzajem, bez względu na to, kim jesteśmy, wtedy sprawiedliwość i pokój stają się częścią naszej rzeczywistości. Kiedy pracujemy na rzecz sprawiedliwości i pokoju to żyjemy miłością, którą Jezus nakazał nam okazywać innym. Dla Jezusa miłość nie oznaczała słodkiego sentymentalnego uczucia. Oznaczała działanie.

Oznaczała aktywne kochanie czyli zaangażowanie miłości i jej urzeczywistnienie w realnym świecie. To nowe przykazanie pojawia się jako część pożegnalnego przemówienia Jezusa do Jego naśladowców, w czasie, gdy wie, że zostanie zdradzony przez własnego ucznia i ukrzyżowany. A jednak mówi: „miłujcie się wzajemnie”. I robi to z czułością i miłosierdziem. Dla mnie to prawdziwa miłość w działaniu!

Nakazuje uczniom, aby się wzajemnie miłowali, ale przypomina im również, że będą nadal odczuwać Jego obecność, pomimo faktu, że nie będzie Go z nimi. Miłość bliźniego ma być znakiem rozpoznawczym naśladowców Chrystusa, także dzisiaj. Inni mają poznawać, że jesteśmy chrześcijanami, po naszej wzajemnej miłości.

Niektórzy mogą powiedzieć, że jedną ze słabości dzisiejszego Kościoła jest to, że wielu chrześcijan nie wciela przykazania miłości bliźniego w życie. Jezus jasno mówi uczniom: „Przykazanie nowe daję wam, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali, tak jak Ja was umiłowałem; żebyście i wy tak się miłowali wzajemnie. Po tym wszyscy poznają, że jesteście uczniami moimi, jeśli będziecie się wzajemnie miłowali”.

Przekaz Jezusa do Apostołów był wyraźny i zrozumiały. O ile bardziej potrzebujemy dzisiaj Jezusa, aby być Jego uczniami?

Proszę, módlcie się za mnie.

Niech Bóg Was błogosławi.
