FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear Parishioners,
This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. Although, in truth, every day is the feast of our Triune God, because all of creation, and every moment of time, praises and extolls our Creator, our Redeemer and our Sanctifier.

This Sunday follows the feast of Pentecost celebrated last Sunday. The descent of the Holy Spirit in the tongues of fire, both concludes the saving ministry of the Son of God and also commences the continuing ministry of the salvation of the world.

For the Spirit, Who proceeds from the Father, is distributed throughout the world at the petition of the Son. And this is something I would like to emphasize today: that the Holy Spirit is present among us, because our Lord Jesus Christ desired it to be so. He even said it to His Disciples: "If you love Me, keep my commandments, and I will ask the Father to give you still another Advocate – the Paraclete – to abide with you forever."

And the Paraclete, Whose feast we celebrate today, reveals Himself in and through the Church – the Body of Believers.

That is why we invoke the Person of the Holy Trinity upon the Holy Gifts of Bread and Wine for them, to become the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. That is why we invoke the Holy Spirit upon the waters of Baptism to sanctify the most essential element of biological life, and make of it the sustenance and foundation of our spiritual life. That is why we invoke the Holy Spirit upon the oil in order to receive healing and forgiveness.

My Beloved Friends, If we are serious about our Faith and our Church; If we truly believe that the Church is the living Body of Christ; If we have confidence that the Eucharist is the Risen Body of Christ; And if we trust what our Lord Jesus Christ told us on the night in which He gave Himself up for the life of the world:

Then our lives must be full of love, compassion, understanding, mercy and forgiveness for one another — especially for those who hate us, oppose us, criticize us and revile us.

Then, and only then, can we say with confidence that the Holy Spirit dwells in us, because the proof – or the fruit – of the Spirit is to love as Christ loved – without condition, reservation or measure. "Love one another, as I have loved you."

This is the life of the Holy Spirit, Who will grant us the power, the ability and the willingness to do so, if we but only ask.

Therefore, let us ask of our Lord, as He asked of His Father, that the Spirit may fill our hearts, our souls and our minds with the knowledge of God's love for the world, as well as for each and every one of us, so that we may be able to love one another, and follow in the way of all His commandments.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mis queridos feligreses,

Este domingo celebramos la Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad. Aunque, en verdad, cada día es la fiesta de nuestro Dios Uno y Trino, porque toda la creación, y cada momento del tiempo, alaba y ensalza a nuestro Creador, nuestro Redentor y nuestro Santificador.

Este domingo sigue a la fiesta de Pentecostés celebrada el domingo pasado. El descenso del Espíritu Santo en las lenguas de fuego, concluye el ministerio salvador del Hijo de Dios y también comienza el ministerio continuo de la salvación del mundo.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Obchodzimy Święto Trójcy Przenajświętszej.

Chociaż w istocie każdy dzień jest świętym naszego Trójjedynego Boga, ponieważ całe stworzenie i każda chwila chwali i uwielbia naszego Stwórcę i Odkupiciela, Tego, który nas uświęca.

W zeszłą niedzielę obchodziliśmy Uroczystość Pięćdziesiątnicy. Zstąpienie Ducha Świętego w językach ognia kończy zbawczą posługę Syna Bożego na ziemi i kontynuuje dzieło zbawienia.

Duch bowiem, który pochodzi od Ojca, na prośbę Syna działa na całym świecie. I to chciałbym dziś podkreślić: Duch Święty jest obecny wśród nas, ponieważ nasz Pan Jezus Chrystus tego chciał.

Powiedział do swoich uczniów: „Jeśli mnie miłujecie, zachowujcie moje przykazania, a Ja poproszę Ojca, aby dał wam innego Pocieszczyela – Parakleta, aby pozostał z wami na zawsze”. Paraklet, którego świętą obchodziliśmy, objawia się w Kościele i poprzez Kościół, który jest Ciałem Wierzących. Dlatego wzywamy Osoby Trójcy Świętej nad świętymi darami chleba i wina, aby stały się one Ciałem i Krwią naszego Pana Jezusa Chrystusa.

Dlatego też wzywamy Ducha Świętego nad wodą chrzcielną, aby uświecić ten najbardziej istotny element życia biologicznego i uczynić z niego podstawę i fundament naszego życia duchowego.

Wzywamy Ducha Świętego nad świętym olejem, aby otrzymać uzdrowienie i przebaczenie. Moi Ukochani Przyjaciele! Jeśli poważnie traktujemy Wiarę i Kościół; jeśli naprawdę wierzmy, że Kościół jest żywym Ciałem Chrystusa; jeśli mamy pewność, że Eucharystia jest Zmartwychwstałym Ciałem Chrystusa; jeśli ufamy temu, co powiedział nam nasz Pan Jezus Chrystus w noc, w którą oddał siebie za życie świata — to nasze życie musi być pełne miłości, współczucia, zrozumienia, miłosierdzia i przebaczenia dla siebie nawzajem, szczególnie dla tych, którzy nas nienawidzą, sprzeciwiają się nam, krytykują nas i lżą. Wtedy, i tylko wtedy, możemy z ufnością powiedzieć, że Duch Święty mieszka w nas, ponieważ dowodem lub owocem Ducha jest kochać tak, jak kochał Chrystus — bez warunków, bez zastrzeżeń, bez miary. „Miłość się wzajemnie, jak Ja was umiłowałem”.

To jest życie Ducha Świętego, który udziela nam mocy, zdolności i chęci, aby tak właśnie czynić, jeśli tylko Go o to poprosimy.

Dlatego prosimy naszego Pana, tak jak On prosił swojego Ojca, aby Duch Święty napełnił nasze serca, nasze dusze i nasze umysły poznaniem miłości Boga do świata i do każdego z nas, abyśmy mogli kochać się nawzajem i postępować zgodnie ze wszystkimi Jego przykazaniami.


**Celebrando el Domingo a lo Largo de la Semana

Registration for our 2025-26 Religious Education Year will begin Monday, June 9, 2025

All currently enrolled families in our Religious Education Program MUST re-register. NEW students or families registering must bring a copy of their child's Baptism certificate in order to complete registration. (registrations will not be accepted without Baptism Certificates) Classes offered for Grades 1 through 8 meet Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. It will be on a first come basis regarding the day & time.

Registration fees:

\$100 for one child, \$175 for two children and \$225 for three or more children. Sacramental fee- \$50 Reconciliation, \$50 First Holy Communion, \$100 Confirmation.

Please register before August 8, 2025. After August 9 there will be a late fee of \$20 incurred and the possibility that classes will be full.




