OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear Parish Family,
Jesus tells us, *"Ask, and it shall be given to you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and the door will be opened to you."* It sounds so straightforward. Ask, seek, knock—God will respond. But what happens when our prayers seem to go unheard? When the silence is louder than the words we've offered? If you've ever prayed and felt disappointed, you're not alone.

And yet—here we are.

We still pray. Even when life knocks the wind out of us. Even when the past holds unanswered prayers. Even when we're uncertain. We keep reaching out to God, because deep down, we know there's something sacred in the connection.

We're in good company. The Bible is full of faithful people who wrestled with unanswered prayers:

- **Moses** led God's people for forty years but was not allowed to enter the Promised Land.

- **King David** fasted and prayed for his child's life, but the child died.

- **St. Paul** begged God to take away a painful affliction—his "thorn in the flesh"—but it remained.

- Even **Jesus** asked for the cup of suffering to be taken from him, yet he was crucified.

So what does this tell us?

It tells us that prayer isn't magic. It's not a formula. God is not a vending machine. Prayer is relationship. It's how we stay connected with the Divine—even when we don't get the answers we want.

Many people assume that unanswered prayers mean they didn't have enough faith. Or that they're being punished. That's not true. Remember Job? His friends told him he must've done something wrong to suffer the way he did, but Scripture makes it clear—that wasn't the case at all. And Jesus invited even the sinners and outcasts to pray.

So why keep praying? Because prayer changes us. It keeps our hearts open. It reminds us that we're not in control—but we are not alone, either.

Sometimes the answer to a prayer is exactly what we hoped for. Other times, it comes in the form of peace in a crisis, strength or healing of relationships before dying. A prayer for healing might begin as a cry for a cure and evolve into a deeper healing of the soul.

When you pray for someone, you may be the one God sends to comfort or care. Prayer can move you to act, and when you act in love, you make space for God to work.

Jesus may not have promised us everything on our wish lists. But he promised something even greater: the gift of the Holy Spirit—God's own presence with us.

That is the answer to every prayer.

So keep asking. Keep seeking. Keep knocking. Keep praying.

God bless you.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Mi querida Familia Parroquial:

Jesús nos dice: *"Pedid, y se os dará; buscad, y hallaréis; llamad, y se os abrirá la puerta.* Suenan tan sencillos. Pida, busque, llame, Dios responderá. Pero, ¿qué sucede cuando nuestras oraciones parecen no ser escuchadas? ¿Cuando el silencio es más fuerte que las palabras que hemos ofrecido? Si alguna vez has orado y te has sentido decepcionado, no estás solo.

Y, sin embargo, aquí estamos.

Todavía oramos. Incluso cuando la vida nos deja sin aliento. Incluso cuando el pasado tiene oraciones sin respuesta. Incluso cuando no estamos seguros. Seguimos acudiendo a Dios, porque en el fondo, sabemos que hay algo sagrado en la conexión.

Estamos en buena compañía. La Biblia está llena de personas fieles que lucharon con oraciones sin respuesta:

- **Moisés** guió al pueblo de Dios durante cuarenta años, pero no se le permitió entrar en la Tierra Prometida.

- **El rey David** ayunó y oró por la vida de su hijo, pero el niño murió.

- **San Pablo** le rogó a Dios que le quitara una aflicción dolorosa, su "aguijón en la carne", pero permaneció.

- Incluso **Jesús** pidió que se le quitara la copa del sufrimiento, pero fue crucificado.

Entonces, ¿qué nos dice esto?

Nos dice que la oración no es magia. No es una fórmula. Dios no es una máquina expendedora. La oración es relación. Es la forma en que nos mantenemos conectados con lo Divino, incluso cuando no obtenemos las respuestas que queremos.

Muchas personas asumen que las oraciones no contestadas significan que no tenían suficiente fe. O que están siendo castigados. No es verdad. ¿Te acuerdas de Job? Sus amigos le dijeron que debía haber hecho algo malo para sufrir de la manera en que lo hizo, pero Las Escrituras lo dejan claro: ese no fue el caso en absoluto. Y Jesús invitó incluso a los pecadores y marginados a orar.

Entonces, ¿por qué seguir orando? Porque la oración nos cambia. Mantiene nuestros corazones abiertos. Nos recuerda que no tenemos el control, pero tampoco estamos solos.

A veces la respuesta a una oración es exactamente lo que esperábamos. Otras veces, viene en forma de paz en una crisis, fortaleza o sanación de las relaciones antes de morir. Una oración por sanación puede comenzar como un grito por una cura y evolucionar hacia una sanación más profunda del alma.

Cuando oras por alguien, puedes ser a ti a quien Dios envía para consolarte o cuidarlo. La oración puede moverte a actuar, y cuando actúas con amor, haces espacio para que Dios obre.

Es posible que Jesús no nos haya prometido todo lo que tenemos en nuestras listas de deseos. Pero prometió algo aún más grande: el don del Espíritu Santo, la propia presencia de Dios con nosotros. Esa es la respuesta a cada oración.

Así que sigue preguntando. Sigue buscando. Sigue llamando a la puerta.

Sigan orando. Que Dios te bendiga.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Minha querida Família Paroquial,
Jesus nos diz: “Peçam, e lhes será dado; busquem, e encontrarão; batam, e a porta será aberta para vocês”. Parece tão simples. Peçam, busquem, batam — Deus responderá. Mas o que acontece quando nossas orações parecem não ser ouvidas? Quando o silêncio é mais alto do que as palavras que oferecemos? Se você já orou e se sentiu decepcionado, não está sozinho.

E, no entanto, aqui estamos.

Continuamos orando. Mesmo quando a vida nos tira o fôlego. Mesmo quando o passado guarda orações não atendidas. Mesmo quando estamos incertos. Continuamos buscando a Deus porque, no fundo, sabemos que há algo sagrado nessa conexão.

Estamos em boa companhia. A Bíblia está cheia de pessoas fiéis que lutaram com orações não atendidas:

- Moisés liderou o povo de Deus por quarenta anos, mas não lhe foi permitido entrar na Terra Prometida.
- O Rei Davi jejuou e orou pela vida de seu filho, mas ele morreu.

- São Paulo implorou a Deus que removesse uma aflição dolorosa — seu “espinho na carne” —, mas ela permaneceu.

- Até Jesus pediu que o cálice do sofrimento fosse tirado dele, mas ele foi crucificado.

Então, o que isso nos diz?

Nos diz que a oração não é mágica. Não é uma fórmula. Deus não é uma máquina de venda automática. Oração é relacionamento. É como nos mantemos conectados com o Divino — mesmo quando não recebemos as respostas que desejamos.

Muitas pessoas presumem que orações não atendidas significam que não tiveram fé suficiente. Ou que estão sendo punidas. Isso não é verdade. Lembra de Jó? Seus amigos lhe disseram que ele devia ter feito algo errado para sofrer daquela forma, mas as Escrituras deixam claro que não foi bem assim. E Jesus convidou até mesmo os pecadores e os rejeitados a orar.

Então, por que continuar orando? Porque a oração nos transforma. Ela mantém nossos corações abertos. Ela nos lembra que não estamos no controle — mas também não estamos sozinhos.

Às vezes, a resposta a uma oração é exatamente o que esperávamos. Outras vezes, ela vem na forma de paz em uma crise, força ou cura de relacionamentos antes da morte. Uma oração por cura pode começar como um clamor por cura e evoluir para uma cura mais profunda da alma.

Quando você ora por alguém, você pode ser a pessoa que Deus envia para confortar ou cuidar. A oração pode motivá-lo a agir e, quando você age com amor, abre espaço para Deus agir.

Jesus pode não ter prometido tudo o que queríamos. Mas ele prometeu algo ainda maior: o dom do Espírito Santo — a presença do próprio Deus conosco. Essa é a resposta para cada oração.

Então, continue pedindo. Continue buscando. Continue batendo.

Continue orando.

Deus te abençoe.

Reze por mim.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Droga Rodzino Parafialna!

Jezus mówi do nas: „Proście, a będzie wam dane, szukajcie, a znajdziecie, kołaczcie, a otworzą wam”. Brzmi to tak prosto. Proście, szukajcie, pukajcie, a Bóg odpowie. Ale co wtedy, gdy nasze modlitwy zdają się pozostawać bez odpowiedzi? Gdy cisza jest głośniejsza niż wypowiedziane przez nas słowa? Jeśli kiedykolwiek modliliście się i poczulście rozczarowanie, to nie jesteście sami.

A jednak wciąż się modlimy. Nawet, gdy życie nas przytłacza, gdy przeszłość skrywa niewysłuchane modlitwy. Nawet, gdy nie jesteśmy pewni jutra. Wciąż zwracamy się do Boga, ponieważ w głębi duszy wiemy, że w tej więzi jest coś świętego.

Jesteśmy w dobrym towarzystwie. Biblia jest pełna pobożnych ludzi, którzy zmagali się z niewysłuchanymi modlitwami:

- Mojżesz prowadził lud Boży przez czterdzieści lat, ale nie pozwolono mu wejść do Ziemi Obiecanej.

- Król Dawid pościł i modlił się o życie swojego dziecka, ale ono umarło.

- Święty Paweł błagał Boga, aby zabrał mu bolesną udrękę — „cierń w ciełe” — ale ona pozostała.

- Nawet Jezus prosił, aby kielich męki został od Niego oddalony, a jednak Go ukrzyżowano.

Co to nam mówi? Otóż modlitwa to nie magia. To nie tajemna formuła. Bóg nie jest automatem sprzedającym. Modlitwa to relacja. To sposób, w jaki utrzymujemy kontakt z Bogiem, nawet wtedy, gdy nie otrzymujemy odpowiedzi, których pragniemy.

Wiele osób zakłada, że brak odpowiedzi na modlitwy oznacza brak wiary. Albo, że to kara. To nieprawda. Pamiętacie Hioba? Jego przyjaciele mówili mu, że musiał zrobić coś złego, skoro tak cierpiał, ale Pismo Święte jasno stwierdza, że wcale tak nie było. Sam Jezus zachęcał do modlitwy nawet grzeszników i wyrzutków.

Po co więc się modlić? Ponieważ modlitwa nas zmienia. Utrzymuje nasze serca otwarte. Przypomina nam, że choć nie mamy nad wszystkim kontroli to nie jesteśmy sami.

Czasami odpowiedź na modlitwę jest dokładnie taka, na jaką liczyliśmy. Innym razem przychodzi w postaci pokoju serca w trudnościach, siły lub uzdrowienia relacji przed śmiercią. Modlitwa o uzdrowienie może zacząć się od wołania o lekarstwo i przekształcić się w głębokie uzdrowienie duszy.

Kiedy modlimy się za kogoś, to może Bóg posyła właśnie nas, by tę osobę pocieszyć lub zatroszczyć się o nią. Modlitwa może pobudzać do działania, a kiedy działamy z miłością, otwieramy przestrzeń dla działania Boga. Jezus nie obiecał nam wszystkiego, co znajduje się na naszej liście życzeń. Obiecał coś wspanialszego - dar Ducha Świętego, czyli obecność samego Boga z nami.

To jest odpowiedź na każdą modlitwę. Więc proście. Szukajcie. Kołaczcie. Nie przestawajcie się modlić. Niech Was Bóg błogosławi.

Módlcie się za mnie.
