FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear parishioners,

We are still in the beginning of another calendar year, and I pause to dwell on what I'm gradually beginning to believe - that time is 'a gift!' It is a precious commodity that we can waste, spend or invest. The Psalmist prayed, "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom" (90:12). In a sense, nothing more clearly requires - or displays - a heart of wisdom than the way we use our time. This may be why Jesus - pressed by the crowds, confronted by the needs around Him, and threatened by the religious establishment - is never described in the Gospels as being in a hurry. When someone interrupts my silence in the office and peeps into the doorway asking: "Are you busy?" Most of the time I instinctively give the 'intruder' the impression that I am awfully busy. I cannot be seen to be wasting my time - that's awful... nay, shameful. Yet, 'time' is not mine, it's been gifted to me so I can't gloat and think it's my 'property.'

I remember once having to go to the DMV and as I came into the building I found a line spilling out of the door and I was frustrated. "Hurry up and wait," I muttered, glancing at my watch.

I had barely found my place in the line when an elderly stranger approached me. "I can't understand how to fill out this form," he said, pointing to the paper he had in his gnarled arthritic fingers. "They asked me to pay \$10 for it and I don't know what to do." Immediately I knew what God wanted me to do. I stepped out of line and was able to assist him with the problem in ten minutes.

The man thanked me and then left. As I turned to get back in line, it was gone. I walked straight to the service counter.

My experience that day reminds me of Jesus's words: "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you" (Luke 6:38).

My wait seemed shorter because God interrupted my hurry. By turning my eyes to others' needs and helping me give of my time, He gave me a gift. It's a lesson I hope to remember, next time I look at my watch.

In John 12:27 He affirmed, "Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour." Living wisely is rooted in understanding that our loving God has a purpose behind our seconds, minutes, hours and days.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Queridos feligreses,

Todavía estamos al comienzo de otro año, y me detengo a pensar en lo que poco a poco empiezo a creer: ¡que el tiempo es 'un regalo'! Es un bien precioso que podemos desperdiciar, gastar o invertir. El salmista oró: «Enséñanos a contar nuestros días, para que tengamos un corazón de sabiduría» (90:12). En cierto sentido, nada requiere —o demuestra— más claramente un corazón de sabiduría que la forma en que utilizamos nuestro tiempo. Puede que por eso Jesús —presionado por la multitud, confrontado por las necesidades que le rodean y amenazado por el establecimiento religioso— nunca se describe en los Evangelios como alguien con prisa.

Cuando alguien interrumpe mi silencio en la oficina y asoma la cabeza por la puerta preguntando: "¿Estás ocupado?" La mayoría de las veces, instintivamente le doy al 'intruso' la impresión de que estoy muy ocupado. No puedo parecer que estoy perdiendo el tiempo - eso es horrible... No, vergonzoso. Sin embargo, el 'tiempo' no es mío, me lo han regalado así que no puedo presumir y pensar que es mi 'propiedad'.

Recuerdo que una vez tuve que ir al DMV y, al entrar en el edificio, vi una línea que salía por la puerta y me frustré. "Date prisa y espera", murmuré, mirando mi reloj.

Apenas había encontrado mi sitio en la fila cuando un anciano desconocido se acercó a mí. "No entiendo cómo rellenar este formulario", dijo, señalando el papel que tenía entre sus dedos artríticos y retorcidos. "Me pidieron que pagara 10 dólares por ella y no sé qué hacer." Inmediatamente supe lo que Dios quería que hiciera. Me salí de la fila y pude ayudarlo con el problema en diez minutos.

El hombre me dio las gracias y luego se fue. Cuando me giré para volver a la fila, ya no estaba. Fui directo al mostrador de servicio.

Mi experiencia ese día me recuerda las palabras de Jesús: "Dad, y os será dado. Una buena medida, presionada, agitada y corriendo, se vertirá en tu regazo. Porque con la medida que usas, se te medirá a ti" (Lucas 6:38).

Mi espera pareció más corta porque Dios interrumpió mi prisa. Al dirigir mis ojos a las necesidades de los demás y ayudarme a dedicar mi tiempo, Él me dio un regalo. Es una lección que espero recordar la próxima vez que mire mi reloj.

En Juan 12:27 afirmó: "Ahora mi alma está perturbada, ¿y qué diré? ' Padre, ¿me salvas de esta hora? No, fue precisamente por esta razón que vine a esta hora." Vivir sabiamente se basa en entender que nuestro Dios amoroso tiene un propósito detrás de nuestros segundos, minutos, horas y días.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus queridos paroquianos,

Ainda estamos no início de mais um ano, e faço uma pausa para refletir sobre algo que estou começando a acreditar: que o tempo é um presente! É um bem precioso que podemos desperdiçar, gastar ou investir. O salmista orou: "Ensina-nos a contar os nossos dias, para que alcancemos um coração sábio" (Salmo 90:12). De certa forma, nada exige – ou demonstra – um coração sábio mais claramente do que a maneira como usamos nosso tempo. Talvez seja por isso que Jesus – pressionado pelas multidões, confrontado pelas necessidades ao seu redor e ameaçado pela elite religiosa – nunca é descrito nos Evangelhos como estando com pressa. Quando alguém interrompe meu silêncio no escritório e espreita pela porta perguntando: "Você está ocupado?", na maioria das vezes, instintivamente, dou ao "intruso" a impressão de que estou extremamente ocupado. Não posso ser visto desperdiçando meu tempo – isso seria terrível... ou melhor, vergonhoso. No entanto, o tempo não me pertence; ele me foi dado como um presente, então não posso me vangloriar e pensar que é minha "propriedade".

Lembro-me de uma vez em que precisei ir ao Departamento de Trânsito e, ao entrar no prédio, encontrei uma fila que se estendia para fora da porta, e fiquei frustrado. "Aprese-se e espere", murmurei, olhando para o meu relógio.

Mal havia encontrado meu lugar na fila quando um senhor idoso se aproximou de mim. "Não consigo entender como preencher este formulário", disse ele, apontando para o papel que segurava em seus dedos nodosos e artríticos. "Eles me pediram para pagar 10 dólares por ele e eu não sei o que fazer." Imediatamente, soube o que Deus queria que eu fizesse. Saí da fila e consegui ajudá-lo a resolver o problema em dez minutos.

O homem me agradeceu e foi embora. Quando me virei para voltar para a fila, ela havia desaparecido. Caminhei direto para o balcão de atendimento.

Minha experiência naquele dia me lembra das palavras de Jesus: "Dai, e ser-vos-á dado; boa medida, recalcada, sacudida e transbordante, vos será dada; porque com a mesma medida com que medirdes, vos medirão a vós" (Lucas 6:38).

Minha espera pareceu mais curta porque Deus interrompeu minha pressa. Ao me fazer voltar os olhos para as necessidades dos outros e me ajudar a dedicar meu tempo a eles, Ele me deu um presente. É uma lição que espero lembrar da próxima vez que olhar para o meu relógio.

Em João 12:27, Ele afirmou: "Agora a minha alma está perturbada, e que direi? 'Pai, salva-me desta hora'? Não, foi precisamente para esta hora que eu vim." Viver com sabedoria está enraizado na compreensão de que nosso Deus amoroso tem um propósito por trás de nossos segundos, minutos, horas e dias.

Que Deus vos abençoe.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Jesteśmy na początku kolejnego roku, a ja chcę zatrzymać się na chwilę, aby zastanowić się nad tym, w co stopniowo zaczynam wierzyć, mianowicie, że czas jest „darem”! To cenny skarb, który możemy zmarnować, wydać lub zainwestować. Psalmista modlił się: „Naucz nas liczyć dni nasze, abyśmy zdobyli mądrość serca” (Psalm 90:12). W pewnym sensie nic tak wyraźnie nie wymaga mądrego serca, albo też go nie ukazuje, jak sposób, w jaki wykorzystujemy nasz czas. Być może dlatego Jezus, otoczony tłumami, konfrontowany z potrzebami ludzi zgromadzonych wokół Niego i często zagrożony przez elity religijne, nigdy nie jest w Ewangeliach przedstawiany jako osoba, która się spieszy. Kiedy ktoś przerywa ciszę w moim biurze i zagląda przez drzwi, pytając: „Czy jesteś zajęty?”, najczęściej instynktownie sprawiam, że „intruz” odnosi wrażenie, że jestem strasznie zajęty. Nie chcę być postrzegany jako ktoś, kto marnuje czas – to byłoby okropne... a nawet niegodne. A jednak „czas” nie należy do mnie, dostałem go jako dar, więc nie mogę się chępliwie i myśleć, że to moja „własność”.

Pamiętam, jak kiedyś musiałem pójść do Urzędu Komunikacji i po wejściu do budynku zobaczyłem kolejkę ciągnącą się aż na zewnątrz. Byłem sfrustrowany. „Postaraj się załatwić to jak najszybciej” – mruknąłem, spoglądając na zegarek. Ledwo zdążyłem zająć swoje miejsce w kolejce, gdy wypędził do mnie starszy pan. „Nie rozumiem, jak wypełnić ten formularz” – powiedział, wskazując na papier, który trzymał w swoich pomarszczonych, artretycznych palcach.

„Kazali mi zapłacić za niego 10 dolarów i nie wiem, co teraz mam zrobić”. Natychmiast wiedziałem, czego Bóg ode mnie oczekuje. Wyszedłem z kolejki i w ciągu dziesięciu minut pomogłem mu rozwiązać problem. Mężczyzna podziękował mi i odszedł. Kiedy odwróciłem się, żeby wrócić do kolejki, już jej nie było. Podeszedłem prosto do okienka obsługi.

Moje doświadczenie z tamtego dnia przypomina mi słowa Jezusa: „Dawajcie, a będzie wam dane. Miarą dobrą, ubitą, utrzęsoną i przepelnioną wspaniałością w zanadrza wasze. Albowiem jaką miarą mierzycie, taką i wam odmierzają” (Łk 6:38). Oczekiwanie wydawało się krótsze, ponieważ Bóg przerwał mój pośpiech. Skierowanie mojej uwagi na potrzeby innych i poświęcenie im mojego czasu było dla mnie darem od Niego. To lekcja, o której mam nadzieję pamiętać, gdy następnym razem spojrzę niecierpliwie na zegarek.

W Ewangelii wg św. Jana (12:27) Jezus powiedział: „Teraz dusza moja jest zatruwiona, i co mam powiedzieć? «Ojczy, wybaw mnie od tej godziny»? Nie, przecież po to przyszedłem na tę godzinę”.

Mądre życie polega na zrozumieniu, że kochający Bóg ma swój pomysł dla każdej sekundy, minuty, godziny i każdego dnia mojego życia.

Niech Was Bóg błogosławi.






