OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear parishioners,

We were having dinner one day in November and one of our priests mentioned that I should do a little catechesis in the bulletin.

I thought it was a good idea. I figured I'd do a topic or two every now and again. Today is one of them.

Is going to mass obligatory?

Yes! Let me explain:

For Catholics, going to mass on Sundays and Holy days is an obligation. But it's not just a rule. The Church teaches this because Sunday mass is when we remember Jesus' resurrection and we receive Jesus in the Eucharist which is very important in our faith.

The early Christians gathered every Sunday, and the church continues this tradition today.

Going to mass help us stay close to God and to the Catholic community.

But here's the good part... if you are sick, or caring for someone or truly can't go, you are excused. The church understands that sometimes it is not possible.

So yes! It is an obligation. But the goal is to help us grow in faith. Not to make life harder.

Leaving mass early:

For some of us that are breaking a little bit of mass etiquette:

Please do not leave Mass early.

After the priest has declared the mass over and he is processing out during the final hymn, that's not for you to suddenly get up and leave.

If you are having an emergency, that's understandable but if you are just worried about a lunch reservation or catching a game of something else that's disrespectful to the body of Christ, the Church.

Remember you are not in Church just for yourself.

So, the next time you are in Church for Mass and the priest says, "The Mass is ended, go in peace" just stand there for a little longer and sing along with the recessional hymn.

Don't get up and leave right away... don't be disrespectful.

Thinking about this, Judas left the Lord's supper early.

My dear parishioners, please stay at least 1 minute more after the priest has processed out.

God bless you.

Hope this helps a little bit.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Queridos feligreses,

Un día de noviembre estábamos cenando y uno de nuestros sacerdotes mencionó que debería hacer un poco de catequesis en el boletín.

Me pareció una buena idea. Pensé en hablar de algún tema de vez en cuando. Hoy es uno de ellos.

¿Es obligatorio ir a la misa?

¡Sí! Déjame explicarte:

Para los católicos, ir a misa los domingos y días festivos es una obligación. Pero no es solo una norma. La Iglesia enseña esto porque la misa dominical es cuando recordamos la resurrección de Jesús y recibimos a Jesús en la Eucaristía, que es muy importante en nuestra fe.

Los primeros cristianos se reunían todos los domingos, y la iglesia continúa esta tradición hoy en día.

Ir a misa nos ayuda a mantenernos cerca de Dios y de la comunidad católica.

Pero aquí viene la parte buena... Si estás enfermo, cuidando a alguien o realmente no puedes ir, estás excusado. La iglesia entiende que a veces no es posible.

¡Así que sí! Es una obligación. Pero el objetivo es ayudarnos a crecer en la fe. No para complicar la vida.

Salir de misa antes de tiempo:

Para algunos de nosotros que estamos rompiendo un poco la etiqueta de las misas: por favor, no abandonéis la misa antes de tiempo.

Después de que el sacerdote haya declarado la misa terminada y esté en procesión durante el himno final, no te corresponde levantarte y marcharte de repente.

Si tienes una emergencia, es comprensible, pero si solo te preocupa una reservación para comer o ver un partido, eso es una falta de respeto al cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. Recuerda que no estás en la Iglesia solo por ti.

Así que, la próxima vez que estés en la iglesia para la misa y el sacerdote diga: "La misa ha terminado, ve en paz", simplemente quédate un poco más y canta el himno de la recesión.

No te levantes y te vayas enseguida... No seas irrespetuoso. Pensando en esto, Judas abandonó la cena del Señor antes de tiempo.

Queridos feligreses, por favor, permanezcan al menos un minuto más después de que el sacerdote haya procesado la salida.

Que Dios te bendiga.

Espero que esto ayude un poco.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus queridos paroquianos,

Um dia em Novembro, durante o jantar, um dos nossos padres mencionou que eu deveria fazer uma pequena catequese no boletim paroquial.

Achei uma boa ideia. Pensei em abordar um ou dois tópicos de vez em quando. Hoje é um desses dias.

Ir à missa é obrigatório? Sim! Deixe-me explicar:

Para os católicos, ir à missa aos domingos e dias santos é uma obrigação. Mas não é apenas uma regra. A Igreja ensina isso porque a missa dominical é o momento em que recordamos a ressurreição de Jesus e recebemos Jesus na Eucaristia, que é fundamental para a nossa fé. Os primeiros cristãos se reuniam todos os domingos, e a Igreja continua essa tradição até hoje. Ir à missa nos ajuda a permanecer perto de Deus e da comunidade católica. Mas aqui está a boa notícia... se você estiver doente, cuidando de alguém ou realmente não puder ir, você está dispensado. A Igreja entende que às vezes não é possível. Então, sim! É uma obrigação. Mas o objetivo é nos ajudar a crescer na fé, não tornar a vida mais difícil.

Sair da missa mais cedo:

Para alguns de nós que estão quebrando um pouco a etiqueta da missa: Por favor, não saiam da missa mais cedo. Depois que o padre declara o fim da missa e está saindo em procissão durante o canto final, não é hora de se levantar e sair repentinamente. Se você estiver em uma emergência, é compreensível, mas se estiver apenas preocupado com uma reserva para o almoço ou com algum jogo, isso é desrespeitoso com o Corpo de Cristo, com a Igreja. Lembrem-se de que vocês não estão na Igreja apenas para si mesmos. Então, da próxima vez que estiverem na Igreja para a missa e o padre disser: "A missa terminou, ide em paz", fiquem um pouco mais e cantem junto com o canto de saída. Não se levantem e saiam imediatamente... não sejam desrespeitosos.

Pensando nisso, Judas saiu da Última Ceia mais cedo. Meus queridos paroquianos, por favor, fiquem pelo menos mais um minuto depois que o padre sair em procissão.

Espero que isso ajude um pouco.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Katecheza pierwsza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Pewnego listopadowego dnia podczas obiadu na plebanii jeden z księży zasugerował, żebym zamieszczał w biuletynie krótką katechezę.

Pomyślałem, że to dobry pomysł, aby od czasu do czasu poruszyć jeden lub dwa tematy. Oto pierwszy z nich. Czy chodzenie na Mszę jest obowiązkowe?

Tak!

Pozwólcie, że to wyjaśnię: Dla katolików chodzenie na Mszę w niedziele i święta jest obowiązkiem. Ale to nie tylko zasada. Kościół tak naucza, ponieważ niedzielna Msza jest czasem, kiedy wspominamy zmartwychwstanie Pana Jezusa i przyjmujemy Go w Eucharystii, co jest bardzo

ważne dla naszej wiary. Pierwsi chrześcijanie gromadzili się w każdą niedzielę, a Kościół kontynuuje tę tradycję do dziś. Chodzenie na Mszę pomaga nam pozostać blisko Boga i wspólnoty katolickiej. Ale są też wyjątki... jeśli jesteś chory, opiekujesz się kimś lub naprawdę nie możesz iść, jesteś zwolniony. Kościół rozumie, że czasami nie jest to możliwe.

Podsumowując! To obowiązek, ale jego celem jest pomóc nam wzrastać w wierze, a nie utrudniać życie. Wcześniejsze wychodzenie ze Mszy. Dla tych z nas, którzy łamią zasady etykiety mszalnej: Proszę, nie wychodźcie ze mszy wcześniej! Do czasu, kiedy ksiądz ogłosi koniec Mszy i wyjdzie podczas ostatniej pieśni nie powinno się nagle wstawać i wychodzić.

To zrozumiałe tylko w nagłych wypadkach, ale nie jeśli ktoś martwi się o rezerwację na lunch lub o to, żeby zobaczyć mecz. Wtedy jest to brak szacunku dla Ciała Chrystusa i dla Kościoła.

Pamiętajcie, że nie jesteście w kościele tylko dla siebie. Tak więc następnym razem, gdy będziecie na Mszy Świętej i ksiądz powie: „Idźcie w pokoju Chrystusa”, po prostu zostańcie jeszcze chwilę, aby zaśpiewać razem z innymi pieśń na zakończenie.

Nie wstawajcie i nie wychodźcie od razu, nie okazujcie braku szacunku. Pomyślcie o tym, że Judasz wcześniej opuścił Wieczerzę Pańską.

Drodzy Parafianie, proszę, zostańcie jeszcze co najmniej minutę po wyjściu księdza.

Niech Bóg Was błogosławi.

Mam nadzieję, że ta katecheza będzie choć trochę pomocna.

Módlcie się za mnie.

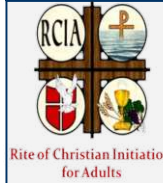

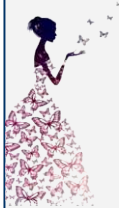

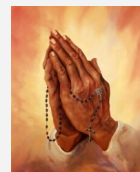
