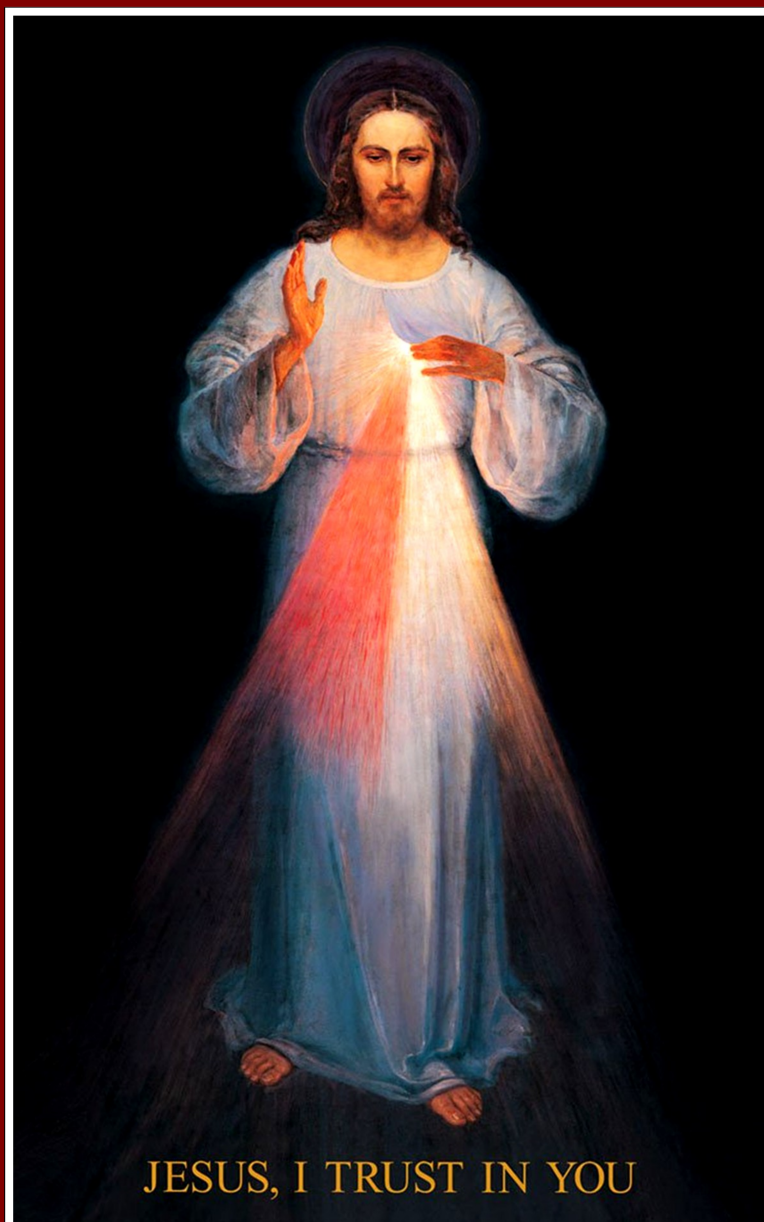

OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

The Parish of St. John Bosco is a multi-cultural, multi-lingual Catholic Faith community that proclaims Jesus Christ. In the spirit of St. John Bosco, we do this by being a **Home** that welcomes all especially the young and the poor; a **School** that prepares for life through religious, educational and social services; a **Parish** that evangelizes through Word & Sacrament, Worship and Faith Formation; a **Playground** where lasting friendship and relationships are formed and developed through recreational and social opportunities.

FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

My dear Parishioners,

Here are 6 things every Catholic should know about the Eucharist.

First, during Consecration the bread and wine of the Eucharist becomes the true transubstantiated body and blood of Christ. It is not a mere symbol.

Second, the Eucharist is the body, blood, soul, divinity of Christ Jesus.

Third, the Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life. The reception of Holy Communion is the Center of our Catholic Faith.

Fourth, Communion is by definition to be in union with God and with His Church, to be one in faith.

Fifth, to receive Holy Communion, a person must be a practicing Catholic in the state of Grace.

Sixth, only an ordained Catholic priest, in the person of Jesus Christ, the High Priest, and through the Power of the Holy Spirit can transform bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.

So, if the Eucharist is the greatest gift on earth, can I receive it multiple times a day? The answer might surprise you! Under the 1917 Code of Canon Law, Catholics could receive communion only once a day. After Vatican II, this changed. The current 1983 Code allows communion twice in one day but only if the second time is during a full mass you actively participate in. So, if you attend your regular morning mass and later find yourself at a wedding or a funeral mass, you're free to receive communion again.

There is one special exception: If a person is in danger of death, they are encouraged to receive again as Viaticum even if they have already received twice that day. But why is the limit at all?

First, it protects the sacredness of the Sacrament and avoids the idea that "the more I receive, the holier I become."

Second, it reminds us that the Eucharist is not just a personal devotion, but a communal celebration of the Church.

And finally, every mass ends with a mission – "Go Forth". We are sent out to carry Jesus whom we have just received into the world.

So yes! Receiving twice is possible but always within the rhythm of worship, reverence and mission.

DESDE EL DESPACHO PARROQUIAL

Queridos feligreses,

Aquí tienes 6 cosas que todo católico debería saber sobre la Eucaristía.

Primero, durante la Consagración, el pan y el vino de la Eucaristía se convierten en el verdadero cuerpo y sangre transubstanciados de Cristo. No es un simple símbolo.

Segundo, la Eucaristía es el cuerpo, la sangre, el alma, la divinidad de Cristo Jesús.

Tercero, la Eucaristía es la fuente y la cima de la vida cristiana. La recepción de la Sagrada Comunión es el centro de nuestra fe católica.

Cuarto, la Comunión es, por definición, estar en unión con Dios y con Su Iglesia, ser uno en la fe.

Quinto, para recibir la Sagrada Comunión, una persona debe ser católico practicante en estado de gracia.

Sexto, solo un sacerdote católico ordenado, en la persona de Jesucristo, el Sumo Sacerdote y mediante el Poder del Espíritu Santo, puede transformar pan y vino en el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo.

Entonces, si la Eucaristía es el mayor regalo del mundo, ¿puedo recibirla varias veces al día? ¡La respuesta puede sorprenderte! Según el Código de Derecho Canónico de 1917, los católicos solo podían recibir la comunión una vez al día. Tras el Concilio Vaticano II, esto cambió. El actual Código de 1983 permite la comunión dos veces en un día, pero solo si la segunda vez es durante una misa completa en la que participas activamente. Así que, si asistes a tu misa matutina habitual y luego te encuentras en una boda o misa de funeral, eres libre de recibir la comunión de nuevo.

Hay una excepción especial: si una persona está en peligro de muerte, se le anima a recibir de nuevo como Viático aunque ya haya recibido dos veces ese día.

¿Pero por qué es el límite en absoluto?

Primero, protege la sacralidad del Sacramento y evita la idea de que "cuanto más recibo, más santo me vuelvo."

Segundo, nos recuerda que la Eucaristía no es solo una devoción personal, sino una celebración comunitaria de la Iglesia.

Y finalmente, cada misa termina con una misión: "Adelante". Nos enviamos a llevar a Jesús a quien acabamos de recibir al mundo.

¡Así que sí! Recibir dos veces es posible, pero siempre dentro del ritmo de adoración, reverencia y misión.

Dios te bendiga.

DA MESA DO PÁROCO

Meus caros paroquianos,
Aqui estão 6 coisas que todo católico deve saber sobre a Eucaristia:

Durante a Consagração, o pão e o vinho da Eucaristia tornam-se o verdadeiro Corpo e Sangue transubstanciados de Cristo. Não é um mero símbolo.

A Eucaristia é o Corpo, o Sangue, a Alma e a Divindade de Cristo Jesus.

A Eucaristia é a fonte e o ápice da vida cristã. A recepção da Sagrada Comunhão é o centro da nossa fé católica.

A Comunhão significa, por definição, estar em união com Deus e com a Sua Igreja; ser um na fé.

Para receber a Sagrada Comunhão, a pessoa deve ser um católico praticante e estar em estado de graça.

Somente um sacerdote católico ordenado — agindo "in persona Christi" (na pessoa de Jesus Cristo), o Sumo Sacerdote, e pelo poder do Espírito Santo — pode transformar o pão e o vinho no Corpo e no Sangue de Cristo.

Então, se a Eucaristia é o maior dom na Terra, posso recebê-la várias vezes ao dia? A resposta pode surpreendê-lo! De acordo com o Código de Direito Canônico de 1917, os católicos podiam receber a comunhão apenas uma vez ao dia. Após o Concílio Vaticano II, isso mudou. O atual Código de 1983 permite receber a comunhão duas vezes no mesmo dia, mas apenas se a segunda vez ocorrer durante uma Missa completa da qual você participe ativamente. Portanto, se você assistir à sua Missa matinal habitual e, mais tarde, estiver presente em um casamento ou em uma Missa fúnebre, estará livre para receber a comunhão novamente.

Há uma exceção especial: se uma pessoa estiver em perigo de morte, ela é encorajada a receber a comunhão novamente como Viático, mesmo que já a tenha recebido duas vezes naquele dia.

Mas por que existe esse limite? Primeiro, isso protege a sacralidade do Sacramento e evita a ideia de que "quanto mais eu recebo, mais santo me torno". Segundo, isso nos lembra que a Eucaristia não é apenas uma devoção pessoal, mas uma celebração comunitária da Igreja.

E, finalmente, toda Missa termina com uma missão: "Ide!". Somos enviados para levar Jesus — a quem acabamos de receber — para o mundo.

Então, sim! Receber a comunhão duas vezes é possível, mas sempre dentro do ritmo de adoração, reverência e missão.

INFORMACJE OD PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie!

Oto 6 rzeczy, które każdy katolik powinien wiedzieć na temat Eucharystii.

Po pierwsze, na Mszy Świętej, podczas konsekracji, chleb i wino stają się prawdziwym, przeistoczonym Ciałem i Krwią Chrystusa. Nie jest to jedynie symbol.

Po drugie, Eucharystia to Ciało i Krew, Dusza i Bóstwo Jezusa Chrystusa.

Po trzecie, Eucharystia jest źródłem i szczytem życia chrześcijańskiego. Przyjmowanie Komunii

Świętej jest centrum naszej wiary katolickiej.

Po czwarte, Komunia Święta z definicji oznacza zjednoczenie z Bogiem i Jego Kościołem, jedność w wierze.

Po piąte, aby przyjąć Komunię Świętą należy być praktykującym katolikiem w stanie łaski uświęcającej.

Po szóste, tylko wyświęcony kapłan katolicki, działający w osobie Jezusa Chrystusa, Najwyższego Kapłana oraz mocą Ducha Świętego, może przemienić chleb i wino w Ciało i Krew Chrystusa. Skoro więc Eucharystia jest największym darem na ziemi, czy możemy przyjmować ją wielokrotnie

w ciągu dnia?

Odpowiedź może Was zaskoczyć! Zgodnie z Kodeksem Prawa Kanonicznego z 1917 roku katolicy mogli przyjmować Komunię Świętą tylko raz dziennie. Ale po Soborze Watykańskim II sytuacja się zmieniła. Obecny Kodeks z 1983 roku zezwala na Komunię Świętą dwa razy w ciągu jednego dnia, ale tylko wtedy, gdy druga Komunia Święta przyjmowana jest podczas Mszy Świętej, w której aktywnie i w całości uczestniczymy. Zatem jeśli uczestniczysz jak zwykle w porannej Mszy Świętej, a później idziesz się na ślub lub pogrzeb, możesz ponownie przyjąć Komunię Świętą.

Istnieje jeszcze jeden szczególny wyjątek: jeśli ktoś znajduje się w niebezpieczeństwie śmierci, zachęca się go do ponownego przyjęcia Komunii Świętej w formie Wiatyku, nawet jeśli przyjął ją już dwa razy tego dnia. Ale dlaczego w ogóle istnieje takie ograniczenie? Po pierwsze, chroni ono świętość sakramentu i pozwala uniknąć myślenia, że „im więcej przyjmuję Komunię to tym bardziej staję się święty”.

Po drugie, przypomina nam, że Eucharystia to nie tylko osobista pobożność, ale przede wszystkim wspólnotowa celebrowanie Kościoła. I w końcu, po każdej Mszy Świętej otrzymujemy misję: „Idźcie!”. Jesteśmy posłani, aby nieść

Jezusa, którego właśnie przyjęliśmy.

Podsumowując! Dwukrotne przyjęcie Komunii jest możliwe, ale zawsze trzeba pamiętać o czci, szacunku i posłaniu.

Niech Bóg Was błogosławi.

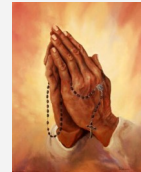

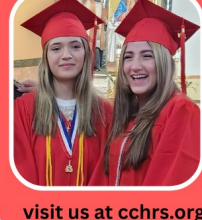
