



WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC TRADITIONS EXPLAINED

Question: How do we know when we receive the Holy Spirit?

Answer: Someone once said, "My brothers and I discovered something as we got older. There is a little bit of Dad in us. Each time we catch ourselves using one of his gestures, expressions, or comments about a meal, we say, 'I'm getting more like Dad!" In like way, when we are confirmed, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. There is no radical change in us that

makes us seem suddenly different. Over a period of time we come to see that there is a little bit of the Spirit in us. We catch ourselves using the gifts, and often end up wondering where a bit of wisdom came from, why we were so patient, or we feel an intensity in our prayer. Perhaps we felt drawn to deepen our spiritual life or found courage in witnessing to our faith. That is when we know we have received the Holy Spirit. We take on his image. Yes, we grow in age, grace, and wisdom, but we also grow in our awareness and understanding of the working of God in our life — we realize we are getting more and more like God. Our thoughts, words, and actions carry that quality and others also see it in us. You might call it holiness. But be confident — there is a little bit of God in all of us!

Gospel for the Sixth Sunday of Easter, Cycle A - John 14:15-21

"If you love me you will keep my commandments." It is really as simple as that. We are only paying lip service to the Lord if we externally declare ourselves to be Christians but do not follow through on a life that confirms it.

In our modern culture, we often think of love as a feeling or a kind of devotion. It is thus all too common to separate love from appropriate action. Perhaps we reassure ourselves that we love Jesus because we believe that he is the Son of God and our personal Savior. But these thoughts — or even any grateful or pleasant feelings that come along with them — are not the fullest manifestation of real love. Rather, as Jesus tells us directly in today's Gospel, "Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me."

Now, for those of us who may be asking what exactly these commandments are, it's helpful to remember Jesus' response when he was questioned on the subject. "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Mt 22:37-39). These fundamental principles embrace everything that Jesus calls us to do. If we put God first and foremost in our lives, and if we treat our neighbors as we would wish to be treated, then all the rest falls into place. The Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, and any other fundamental Christian codes of behavior are all summed up here. Indeed, if we truly seek to love Jesus, putting him first and following his ways will not feel like a burden but rather like a beautiful blessing.

Questions for the Week

John 14:15-21 - Jesus speaks of the Father sending to believers "the Spirit of truth." Where do you see the Spirit of truth at work in the Church today?

Acts 8:5-8, 14-17 - Why do you think Luke records the descent of the Holy Spirit onto the Samaritans?

1 Peter 3:15-18 - Peter encourages believers to defend the faith to non-believers. When have you found yourself in this situation?
