

The American College Alumni Reunion (August 6-12, 2017)

Background: As the American College was established in 1857, the Alumni Association gathered for the 160th year of the College. The College was first established as a Seminary for Europeans to study to be priests for the United States of America. Seminarians came from Germany, Flanders, Netherlands, Ireland, and Poland. "It required more than ordinary courage in those days to go to America; for it meant leaving an assured and quiet position at home, breaking affectionate family ties, and resisting the objections of timorous friends and anxious relatives." (Quote from The American College Bulletin of 1903 capturing the spirit expected from students at the American College, when it was established.) By 1887 the College provided 700 priests for service to the dioceses in the United States. In later years seminarians from the United States were sent by their Bishops to

study at the American College where they received priestly formation and attended theological lectures Catholic University of Leuven. Bishops closed the seminary function of the American College in 2011. Since then the American College came under complete ownership and responsibility



of the University of Leuven. The University uses the American College as a residency for both International Students (primarily from English speaking countries) and students from the Kingdom of Belgium.

Personal experience: I was very glad I was able to attend the reunion. There were 50 alumni attending. A few were from the time I was a student. I enjoyed visiting with alumni, our conferences and reconnecting with the

University and City of Leuven. Also I was blessed that Father Michael Froidurot and I were able to say mass at the tomb of Saint Damiaan De Veuster, the leper priest from Molokai, Hawaii. Saint Damiaan is a native of Belgium. were both ordained Deacons at church where Saint Damiaan is buried. I was ordained in 1974 and Father Froidurot



ordained in 1976. We concelebrated mass on August 10, 2017, Feast of Saint Lawrence, Deacon. Father Froidurot is a priest of the Diocese of San Diego. We were happy to pray for our parishioners, friends and families at Saint Damiaan's tomb.

Background to the Catholic University of Leuven:

The university was established in 1425. In the 592 years as a University it was closed and reopen by historical events, like French Revolutionary Wars, World War I, World War II. It is the oldest and largest Catholic University in the World. I am told that the student population is around 45,000. In 1968 the university, *Vniversitas Catholica Lovaniensis*, was split into two universities, *Katholieke Universiteit Leuven* (Dutch speaking) and *Universite Catholique de Louvain* (French speaking). The Dutch speaking university has many international programs (where English is used as the working language). The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. was modeled after the *Vniversitas Catholica Lovaniensis*.

Gospel for the Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A - Matthew 16:33-36


