For as the storm approached, most of us prayed something like this: "Lord - we so hope that Big Bad Barry turns out to be a Big Blustering Bully, with no bite to his bark! One of the most exciting and inspirational parts of our post-storm Pilgrimage of Gratitude happened for me after we received word, early Sunday morning,

that the parish wide curfew had been lifted. After prayerful consultation with our parish staff, a decision was made to celebrate Mass, for the few parishioners who might want to attend, on Sunday at 9:00 & 11:00 a.m. - and as previously scheduled - again at 6:30 p.m. Well much to my shocked delight, the Church was full at 9:00, and VERY FULL at 11:00 & 6:30!!! WOW - I had always heard stories about the deep faith and sincere gratitude of the people of Eunice & Duralde, but to witness that Faith and Gratitude so clearly in action on Sunday really lifted my Spirit, and really inspired my Soul!!! May our deep appreciation for God's many gifts and blessings continue to be articulated in our prayers, and on display for all to see whenever we gather to Celebrate the Eucharist!

Finally, I wanted to inform you of a slight adjustment to the hours of operation for our Parish Office. In order that our staff might be more free to join us for Holy Mass at Noon on Tuesday's and Thursday's - without compromising their lunch break - the Parish Office will be closed from 12:00 to 1:30 p.m. on both of those days. 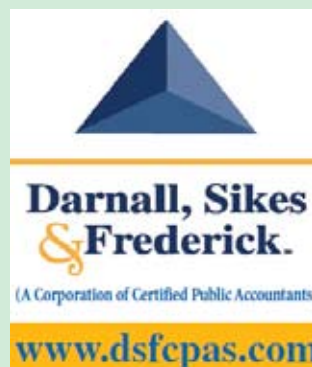
