BISHOP'S SERVICES APPEAL

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

One just has to read the satirical Episotolary Short Story of CS Lewis appearing in the 1956, Saturday Evening Post to realize the attack upon Christian faith is currently occurring.

The prophetically pronounced approaches by the evil one in Lewis' story can be seen in what is happening daily in the decline of faith in our society. Christians are being murdered in third world countries for their beliefs. Here in our own country, while not being murdered, a mortal spiritual onslaught is occurring through an attack on our democracy as prophetically described in C.S. Lewis' article. Now more than ever it is important that we support and encourage vocations to the priesthood to fend off this attack.

We here are blessed to have three priests serving us. Vocations to the priesthood are waning and not all parishes are as fortunate as ours. (but then again many of us have experienced the persuasiveness of Fr. Hampton). The education of and support for vocations for seminarians is of vital importance in this battle against the evils trying to destroy Christianity and our democracy. In light of this I am asking you to prayerfully consider your commitment both financially and prayerfully to our BSA ongoing at this time.

I realize that even though we are now in a post covid state inflation is now impacting many if not all of us here. Your prayerful discernment is being requested at this time with respect to your financial support of the Bishop's Services Appeal. Over 80%of the monies from BSA go to the education of our seminarians.



We are proud to announce that we are at 40% of our goal as of Feb 28, 2023. Additionally, we are two thousand dollars ahead of where we were at this time last year. This speaks highly of your commitment to the BSA here in our parish. IF you have already made a contribution financially on behalf of our pastor, thank you. We ask you to prayerfully consider if you can contribute just a little more.

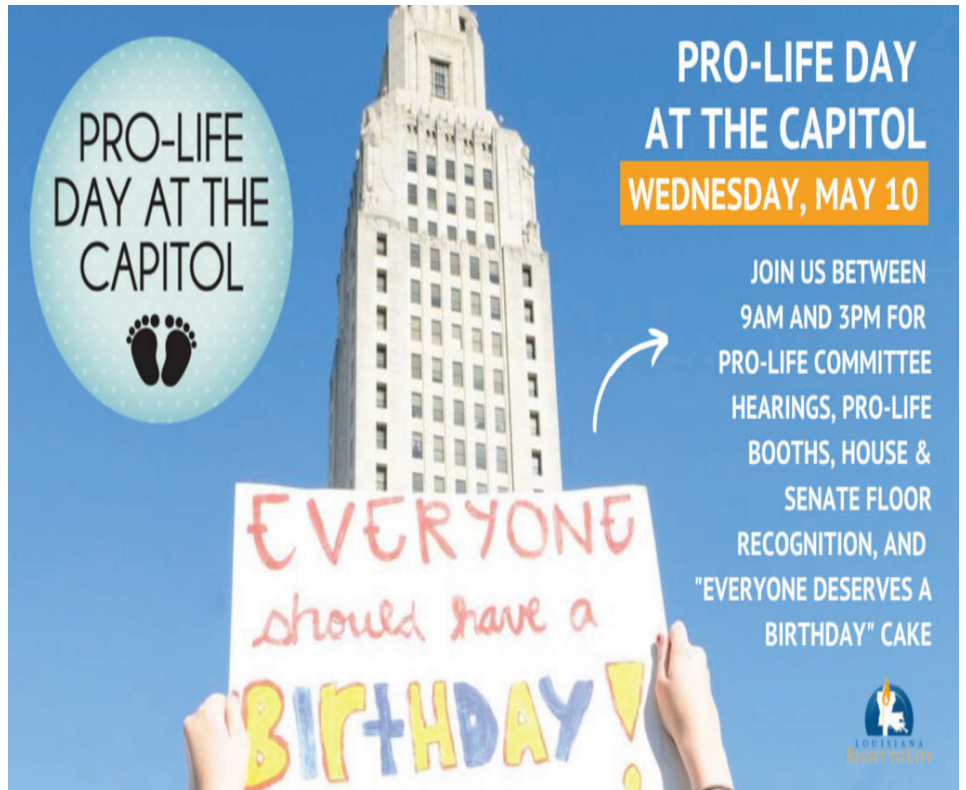
