


NEW SANCTUARY CANDLE



The center operates in Mamou offering confirmation of pregnancies as well as helping to meet the mothers' material needs for pregnancy and child care. In addition to offering emotional support and encouragement to continue pregnancy as well as guide expecting mothers to medical care. It is the hope of this community-formed center to aid these mothers in choosing life rather than choosing abortion when they are overwhelmed in facing an unintended pregnancy.


PRAYER FOR THE HURRICANE SEASON
