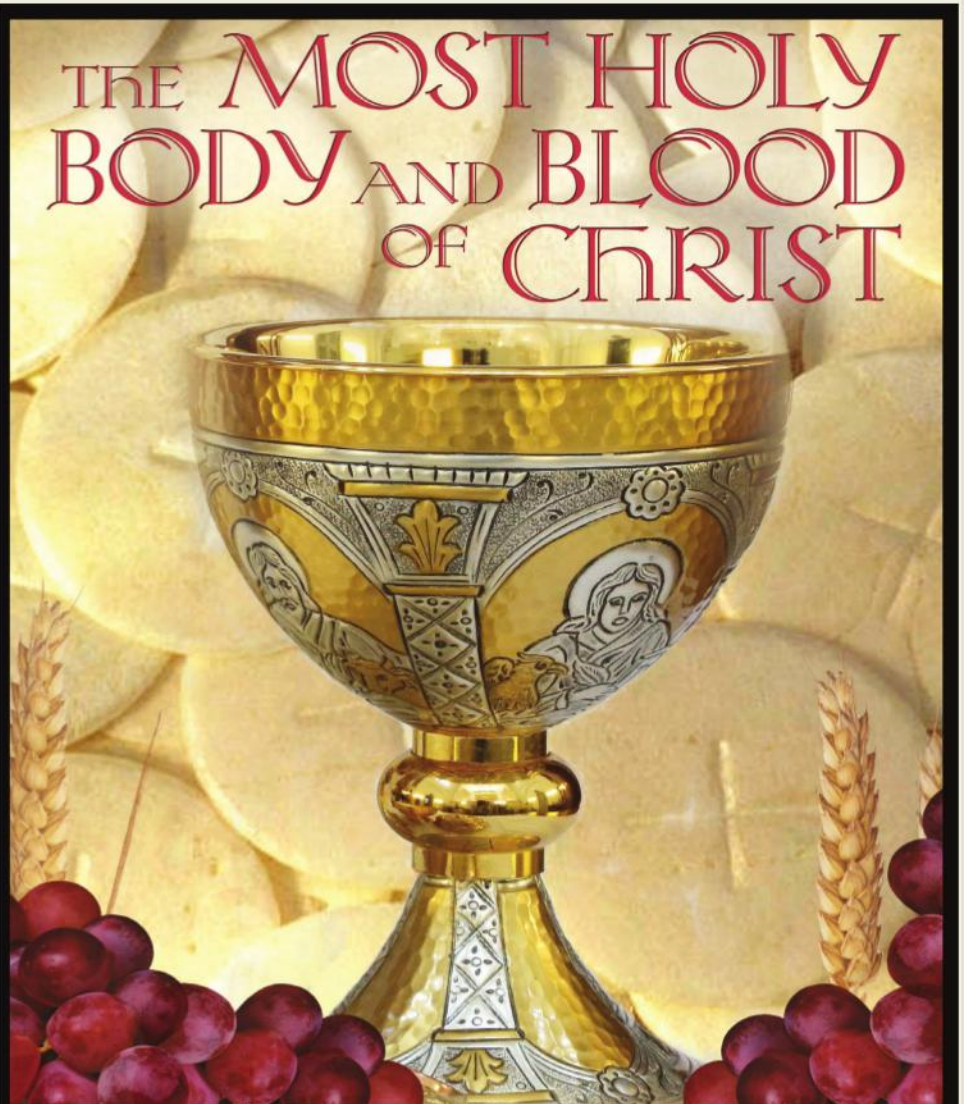

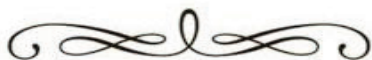
OUR SUMMER SEMINARIAN

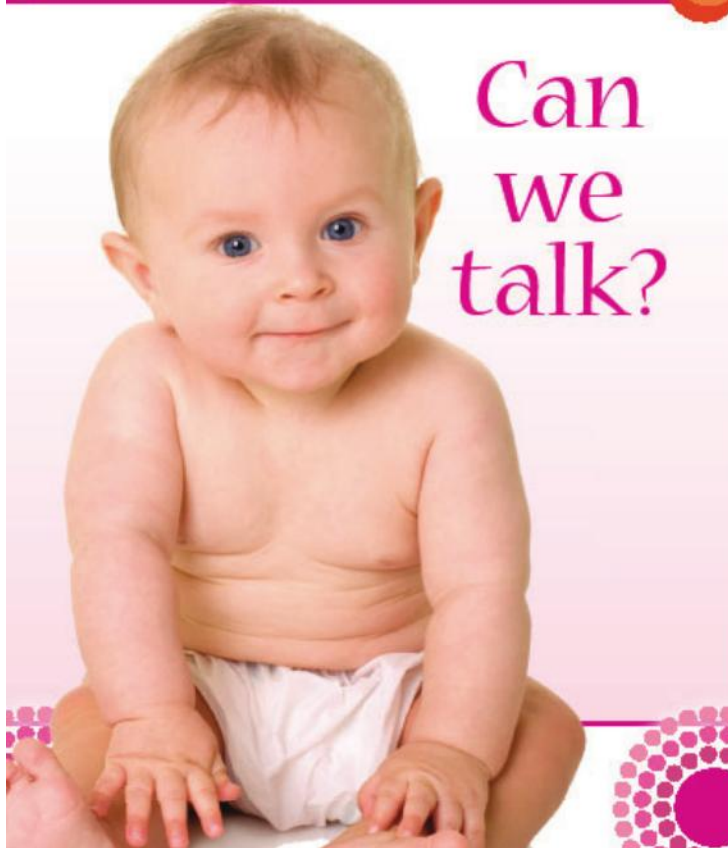

Baby bottles can be picked up beginning next weekend and can be returned anytime until Father's Day weekend with monetary donations to support the newest Pregnancy Center in our area.

New Life Pregnancy Center is a nonprofit support center for mothers in crisis pregnancies or unexpected pregnancies. The center operates in Mamou offering confirmation of pregnancies as well as helping to meet the mothers' material needs for pregnancy and child care. In addition to offering emotional support and encouragement to continue pregnancy as well as guide expecting mothers to medical care. It is the hope of this community-formed center to aid these mothers in choosing life rather than choosing abortion when they are overwhelmed in facing an unintended pregnancy.
