

1911 - 2023

Founded in 1911, St. Edmund Catholic School has been a landmark in Eunice, Louisiana, for over 100 years. With her deep tradition founded on the morals of Christ and His Church, St. Edmund School has educated thousands of young people with the intention of forming soldiers for Christ who bring His gloriously, warm light into an often dark and cold world. Relying upon the help of Mary and St. Edmund, the school has excelled in good times and prevailed through bad times, never forgetting the words of St. Paul, "Do it all for the Glory of God."

Today, our school structure looks a bit different than it did 112 years ago, but the mission still stands firm:

To Teach the Catholic Faith, to use it in every aspect of learning, and to model it in daily life.



St. Edmund also has a rich history of athletics, including football. In the early 1930s, St. Edmund School was struggling to keep boys at the school. The schools pastor discovered that boys of high school age were leaving to go across town to the public school to play football. And so, Blue Jay football was formed.

The program started with a 6-man football team, but successes in the program and increases in enrollment allowed the school to enter 11-man play in 1955.

Since 1955, the Blue Jays have won 62 percent of their games with an overall record of 466-279-13, won 18 District Titles, made 52 play-off appearances, and have three state finals berths.

The Class 1A program has had 79 players selected to the All-State teams, numerous players named to the Academic All-State teams, and 27 named District Most Valuable Players.

Despite hurricanes and global pandemics, St. Edmund football has continued a tradition of success. Driven by faith and hard work, the program has built a reputation as a powerhouse team in Class A football across the state. Since its humble beginnings our school and our team believes:
