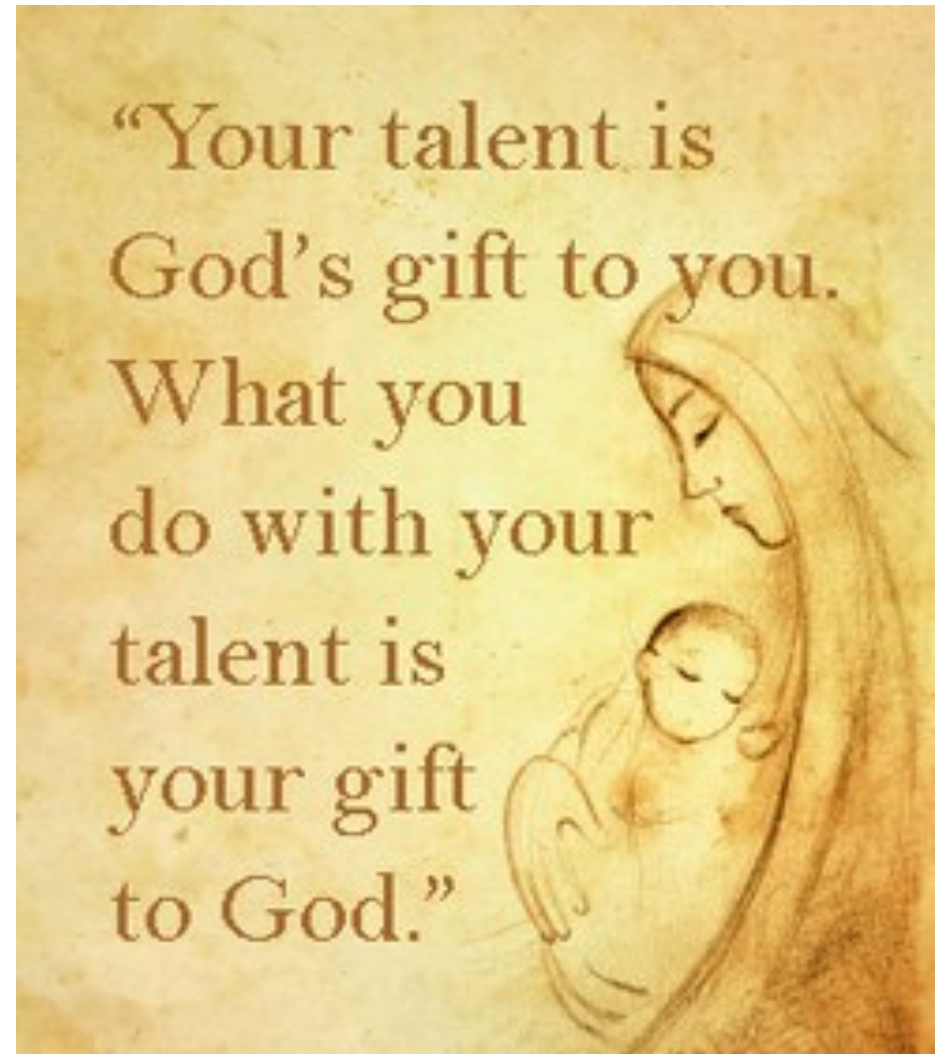

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners and Visitors:

Our Lady of the Mountains needs your help! June 30th marked the end of our fiscal year, and I would like to share a few pieces of financial information with you.

Offertory donations from both parishioners and visitors support the operations of our Parish. In the fiscal year that just ended, offertory was insufficient to cover all operating costs, and the Parish used some of its prudent reserve to cover expenses.

There are 313 registered families and based on the offertory information only about two thirds of our families are financially supporting the Parish. As Pastor, I am concerned about this number. Our Lady of the Mountains seeks to provide a welcoming, beautiful and sacred space to all. Our desire is that we have the staff and resources to serve the spiritual needs of everyone in the Parish, as well as our many visitors and summer residents. We cannot do this without your help.

For the past several years, our offertory amounts have not grown, while expenses inevitably have grown. We rely heavily on the volunteer services of our two deacons, Deacon Stan and Deacon George, who have taken over many tasks that were previously handled by paid staff. It is a blessing to have them with us, and I am grateful for their support.

Recently, the Archbishop assigned a Parochial Vicar to Our Lady of the Mountains. I hope you have had the opportunity to meet Father Salvador and welcome him. The addition of a second priest will bring many spiritual gifts to the Parishioners and visitors, as well. The addition of Father Salvador to Our Lady of the Mountains, brings our staffing to 4 full-time and 2 part-time staff. Many essential duties are handled by volunteers, which is greatly appreciated. Which brings me to the current need – to sustain the operations of the Parish, it is critical that offertory increase by 10 – 20%. Additionally, there are major capital improvements that are being analyzed right now and soon we will know what renovations and repairs are needed. If you are among the many parishioners currently donating, I thank you and ask you to prayerfully consider if you could increase your offering by at least 10%. If you are not among the current donors, but feel you can support us at some level, I urge you to do so. My goal is that 100% of our Parishioners and Visitors donate at some level, within their means. The result of 100 more families donating regularly would have a great impact on the Parish and its financial sustainability.

We are all called to Stewardship. God gives us in abundance and He calls us to give back in thanksgiving of what He has given us. God will never be outdone in generosity.

If you would like to talk to me personally about your financial stewardship, I would be glad to meet with you. If you are unable to support the Parish financially at any level, there are other ways to serve. Time and talent and treasure are the three pillars of stewardship, and all three are encouraged and appreciated.

Thank you for taking the time to consider this pressing need. I will speak more about stewardship in today's homily.

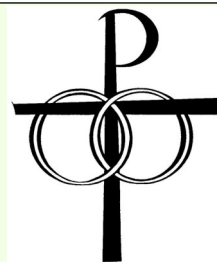

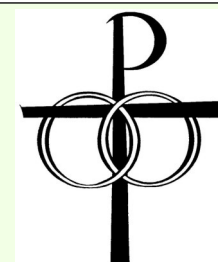
