Internet fraudsters have been scamming parishioners by sending emails and text messages which appear to come from parish priest asking for help by purchasing gift cards and sending the pin number on the back of the card. Neither the pastor nor any member of the staff will ever make this request. If you receive this type of email immediately contact the local police as well as the Federal Trade Commission at ftccomplaintassistant.gov and click the link to chat with a technical support specialist.




