



The Pillars of Catholic Catechism (Part Two): The Sacraments of Faith

The second pillar in *The Catechism of the Catholic Faith* is the sacraments of the faith. God's salvation is accomplished once for all through Christ Jesus and Holy Spirit, and today we remember His salvation and His presence in the sacred actions of the Church's liturgy and the seven sacraments. The seven sacraments are *Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance and Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony*. In future FlockNotes we will dig deeper into each of the seven sacraments of the faith, but for now I want to focus on what it means when it says that salvation is accomplished "once for all."

"Once for all"

God's salvation came through Christ Jesus, and it came **once for all**.

"Once" means that it happened, and it never needs to happen again.

"For all" means that salvation came for everyone, and no one can, or should be, excluded from God's saving grace.

Jesus' "once for all" covers everything and everyone. We only need to receive it by faith.

"Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen."

~ Hebrews 11:1

As we journey in faith and through the Sacraments, we grow in understanding and in relationship with our Heavenly Father. This is only possible through Jesus Christ and the gift of His sacrifice for our salvation.

"Since the law has only a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of them, it can never make perfect those who come to worship by the same sacrifices that they offer continually each year. Otherwise, would not the sacrifices have ceased to be offered, since the worshippers, once cleansed, would no longer have had any consciousness of sins? But in those sacrifices there is only a yearly remembrance of sins, for it is impossible that the blood of bulls and goats take away sins. For this reason, when he came into the world, he said:

"Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; holocausts and sin offerings you took no delight in. Then I said, 'As is written of me in the scroll, Behold, I come to do your will, O God.'"

First he says, "Sacrifices and offerings, holocausts and sin offerings, you neither desired nor delighted in." These are offered according to the law. Then he says, "Behold, I come to do your will." He takes away the first to establish the second. By this "will," we have been consecrated through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

~ Hebrews 10:1-10

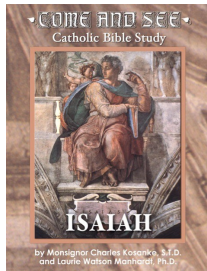
