THE SEASON OF CREATION

1st September 1st – 4th October 4th, 2018

On 1 September 1989, His Holiness Dimitrious 1, Patriarch of Constantinople decreed the first day of September as a day of special reverence and Prayer for the Safeguarding of Creation. Since 2008 the World Council of Churches has encouraged all Christian denominations to observe and celebrate this day, and in 2015 Pope Francis announced that the Catholic Church would do the same. The Day has been extended to the Season of Creation – from 1 September – 4 October, the feast of St. Francis. This is a time for all Christians world-wide to gather in prayer for the wellbeing of the earth, our common home. Here at St. Basil's we add our prayers to those of our fellow Christians – our prayers for the environment will be heard each week and a celebratory Mass will be held 30th September.
