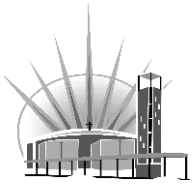

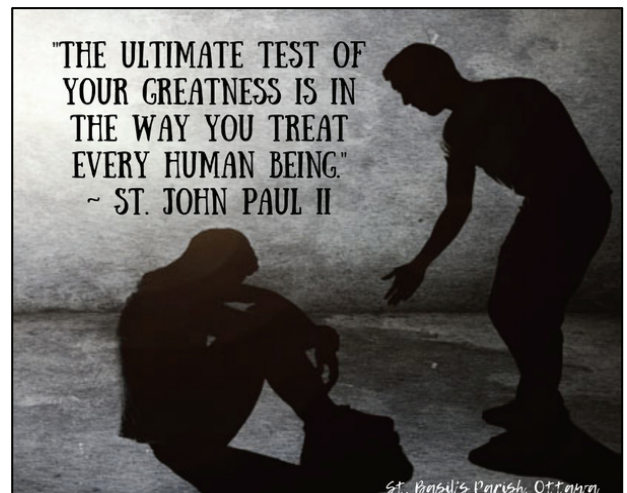
**The Parish's Synodal Consultations have Begun!** Our first consultations took place on March 5<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.
