### **Parish Financial Situation:**

A video was posted on the parish website in April on the 2021 Year End financial position of St Basil's. Those who have not yet seen the video are strongly encouraged to do so. An element covered in the video is the need for the parish to find ways to increase monthly revenues to cover the costs of operations: either by increasing Sunday collections and/or finding ways to generate other types of revenue. Four months into the new year and we are currently experiencing a \$10K operating deficit. In other words, our revenues collected are not enough to cover our current costs of operations.

We are exploring some possible ways to fundraise and/or generate additional sources of revenue, but we are making a plea for all parishioners to please consider increasing their regular Sunday donations to help offset the parish's ongoing operating deficit situation. Thank you to everyone who is helping us meet the financial demands associated with the parish. Every donation helps and is very much appreciated.

There will be no Monday Mass during the summer months of July and August.


### <u>Part-Time</u> <u>Secretary</u> <u>Position</u>:
