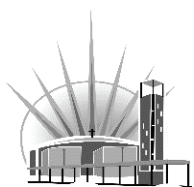

Parish Financial Situation:

A video was posted on the parish website in April on the 2021 Year End financial position of St Basil's. Those who have not yet seen the video are strongly encouraged to do so. An element covered in the video is the need for the parish to find ways to increase monthly revenues to cover the costs of operations: either by increasing Sunday collections and/or finding ways to generate other types of revenue. Four months into the new year and we are currently experiencing a \$10K operating deficit. In other words, our revenues collected are not enough to cover our current costs of operations.

We are exploring some possible ways to fundraise and/or generate additional sources of revenue, but *we are making a plea for all parishioners to please consider increasing their regular Sunday donations* to help offset the parish's ongoing operating deficit situation. Thank you to everyone who is helping us meet the financial demands associated with the parish. Every donation helps and is very much appreciated.

Request for Caring Adult Funeral Servers:

St. Basil's is known as a caring, and welcoming community! The Ministry of Servers for the Celebration of Life (funerals) is a very important way that we show our care for our beloved deceased parishioners and their families. Our presence at this celebration is a welcoming sign to others who are attending our Church, as they offer their support at this difficult time. During Covid-19, this Ministry ceased to perform this function. As we return to a post Covid environment, please consider joining this kind expression of caring. The funeral service requires four servers for each Mass. More volunteers in this valuable Ministry, lighten the time commitment and provide opportunities for others who may wish to be of service. New ministers can be partnered with existing ones, learning from our masters.
