

St. Basil's Catholic Women's League



Thanks You! Thank you everyone for helping your Catholic Women's League help others. We have used funds from our annual bake sale and from the funeral reception services to help the

following groups. Internationally we are helping Sr. Sizane in Mali, where she is working on an educational project in Sikasso and a sewing project for women in a nearby village and Sr. Catherine in Songdin, Burkina Faso where her community is building a hospital and school. Both Sisters were part of the parish while they studied at Saint Paul University. We are also supporting a long-term care home in the poorest part of the Dominican Republic, which is run by the Grey Sisters of Pembroke. Some of our parishioners such as Dodie and Don Taylor often brought supplies to the Sisters. We support the Canada Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA). CNEWA operates specifically in areas of concentrated mass poverty, war and displacement. providing human dignity and addressing the basic needs of vulnerable populations. This year they are working diligently in Syria and Turkey. We support Velma's Dream, an initiative of a past president of the CWL. This is a group which helps Palestinian youth in the Holy Land. Another of our causes is Chalice, a Catholic international aid and development charity. They work in impoverished communities to help struggling families overcome the cycle of poverty. Their child sponsorship program gives children the support needed to stay in school and allows their families to provide them with essential care.

At the national level, we have donated to **Momentum Single Mothers Group**. Founded by and for single mothers, **Momentum** has a bold vision to transform the culture surrounding single mothers in the Catholic Church. A chapter has now been established at St. Basil's.

Locally, we support **Birthright of Ottawa** founded by our late parishioner, Elaine Redmond. **Birthright** provides support for women facing unexpected pregnancies. We are long time members of and supporters of **Multifaith Housing Initiative**, which brings together a coalition of faith groups, local businesses, civil society, the City of

Ottawa and federal/provincial governments to establish innovative collaborative solutions to create affordable housing. Our Sister Jean Goulet is a founding member of the group and continues to be an active participant.

As a women's group, we are also pleased to support Cornerstone Housing for Women which provides emergency and safe affordable housing for women in Ottawa. Funds are also given to St. Joe's Women Centre which provides support for women facing financial, social and mental health challenges. For these two groups, we also organize our annual toiletries collections.

Children are important. For that reason, we also help Ottawa Network for Education – Breakfast Program.

And closer to home, we donate to the **Carlington Community Chaplaincy** which provides welcome and support to residents of Carlington. Last, but not least, we support the **Kateri Ministry**, the Indigenous Catholic Community which celebrates Mass in our Parish.

We could not provide this help if not for your generosity. Thank you. And we want to remind all the women in the parish that they are welcome to join us so that we can expand our reach.
