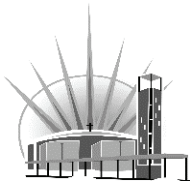

Annual CWL Collection for St. Joe's Women Centre:

For several years, the people of St. Basil's have generously helped women in need in our community. St. Joe's Women Centre is a day program and registered charity that is dedicated to the needs of low income/homeless women, those that identify as women, and their children, in a supportive and safe environment. That includes providing shower and laundry facilities. The Centre is asking for shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, toilet paper, toothpaste, toothbrushes, and sunscreen. Other items the women need include new socks, reusable grocery bags, portable hammocks, sun visors/caps and reusable water bottles. Always welcome are gift cards from grocery stores, Giant Tiger, Walmart, Tim Hortons, etc. During May, there will be a basket in the church narthex, and you can leave your donations there any time the church is open. The CWL will collect them and deliver them to the Centre on Laurier Ave. East. In the past, we have collected several large green bags of these necessary items, and everything is used almost immediately. Please help our sisters in need once again.
