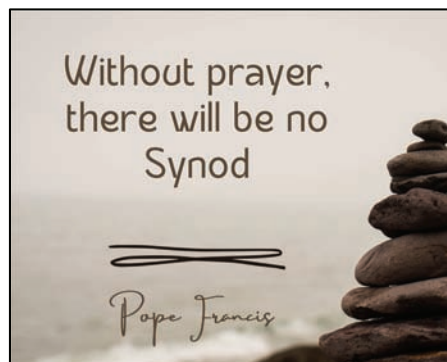
The Four Constitutions of Vatican II Webinar Series:
