

#### **ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

Today we celebrate the "birthday of the Church!" Pentecost is described in the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. But before the great driving wind and tongues of fire empowering the Disciples, the Holy Spirit had already arrived. The Gospel for today's Mass during the day is from John 20. Jesus appears to the fearful disciples after his resurrection. He first speaks a message of calm. "Peace be with you." The apostles "rejoiced when they saw the Lord." When the enthusiastic response settles down, Jesus "breathed on them and said to them 'Receive the Holy Spirit."

This action is Trinitarian, and it has happened before. If you turn your Bible back to the beginning, you'll read: "The Lord God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so many became a living



being" (Genesis 2:7). In the Garden of Eden, we see God's first, original covenant with man. The breath of life signifies that original indwelling of grace, the special state of likeness and friendship with God

before the Fall. Here now, in this locked room, the Apostles receive the long-awaited promise: the very breath of God, new life, a new covenant.

In the pairing of these two readings, the Pentecost experience in Acts and the breath of Jesus in John's Gospel, we see that the coming of the Holy Spirit is not only an empowering, it is an indwelling. We have each received the breath of grace in our baptism. It is confirmed, strengthened, and deepened in each reception of the sacraments. If we persevere in virtue, the Spirit of God is alive in us, inspiring our actions of love. This Pentecost Sunday, how is the breath of God alive in you?

## **Vocations Corner**

Vocation to Life Some years ago, my brother and his wife were talking

about having their dog 'sterilized'. Their children overheard their conversation and were discussing between them. The five year old asked the older: "Hey Joss what does it mean to sterilize? What are they planning to do with our dog?" The older, who was 8 at that time, replied: "Oh don't worry sister, I am pretty sure that they are taking our

dog to have her hair and nails done". Both of my nieces in their innocence did not realized that they were confusing the words 'sterilize' and 'stylize'. That was a funny situation, but it gave me insight to think of something else.

It seems that the way our society thinks is not different from the way my nieces thought. Either by choice or by ignorance we tend to change words to make it sound nicer. For instance, 'abortion' is called 'early termination of the pregnancy', and 'Euthanasia or assisted death' is called 'dignified

end of life'. Some people argue that it is ok to use a different name, so 'we won't hurt anyone's feelings', but the reality is that when we change the name of something we are opening the door of evil to destroy our world beginning with our minds.

Jesus reminds us: "Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the evil one" (Mathew 5:37). So let us call things by its name; but more important, let us keep ourselves united to the source of truth, beauty, and goodness: God.
