The effects of sin

Sin is enemy number two. What are the consequences of sin? What was the result of the Fall of our first parents? Often, we answer this by saying the consequences of sin are separation from God,

which is true, to be sure! But it doesn't grasp the whole horror of the bad news. And I don't know about you, but when I was younger, this didn't matter to me. "So what?" I thought. "I'm separated from God. What's the big deal about that?"

The full force of the result of sin is better understood when we realize that our first parents unknowingly sold the whole human race into slavery to powers against whom we cannot compete. These powers include Sin and Death, which are best understood by being written with capital letters. Sin is not only something I do or don't do; it is first, and foremost a power, similar to an authority,

continually trying to exert pressure on me to cooperate in its rebellion. It's rather easy to prove by our experience. Have you ever done something you knew you shouldn't do, and you didn't want to do—in fact, perhaps you hated doing—but you did it anyway (see Romans 7:19)? Oh yeah, me neither! Have you ever wondered why? The Power of Sin is the answer (see Romans 3:9 and 6:1ff).

Without God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit, we are powerless to overcome sin. It's not enough for us to repent, as crucial as that is; we need to be delivered from the tyranny of sin.

It is easier to see that we are under the Power of Death. No matter how much money I have, no matter the medical care I have access to, no matter what area of the world I live in, the best I can do is delay death. It comes for us all, and anyone who has ever been there at the bedside of a loved one watching them

breathe their last knows painfully well how truly powerless we are in the face of this horific power.

A modern-day image

The most powerful way to enter into this part of the kerygma is to pray with the image of a human trafficker, a modern travesty of unimaginable proportions. The human race, because of the Fall, is in the hands of a human trafficker. We are being exploited, used, and abused by our captor. And there is no way out unless someone stronger comes to the rescue.

Praise God. Jesus came to rescue us from the strong man (Matthew 12:29). This week in pray with the terrible news of sin and death and recognize that there is no way to save yourself from them. If you do, next week, you will be prepared to surrender your life to the Good News.






