

THOUGHTS, SCRIPTURE, AND MORE.

THE KERYGMA, PART 3.2 The Passion

We can view God's rescue of His creature made in His image and likeness and destined to share in His divine nature from many angles. I want to look at God's rescue through a question: Is Jesus the hunted or the hunter in His passion and death? Is He the victim or aggressor?

You may think the answer to that question is obvious - Jesus was arrested, chained, condemned, scourged, crowned with thorns, and nailed to a cross. He's the hunted and the victim. Is He, though? Jesus is God, after all. He is the Second Person of the Trinity made flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary. How is it possible to nail God to the Cross? Is there a nail big enough? There is only one way for God to get nailed to a cross. He has to want to be there. Ponder that

for a minute. Jesus has to want to be on that cross - the worst instrument of torture ever known to humans. There are three basic ways to understand the passion of Jesus.

The first way to understand Jesus' passion is to see it as the revelation of God's love. Have you ever seen the guy at a sporting event holding the John 3:16 sign: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." Jesus tells us, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" (John 15:13). Praise God that this is true. Praise God for many people are deeply moved when they hear and see the message of God's love for them on the Cross.

A second way of understanding Jesus' passion is to recognize that Jesus on the Cross is making atonement for our sins. St. Paul puts it this way: "For our sake he made him to be sin who did not know sin, so that we might become the righteousness of God in him" (2 Corinthians 5:21). St. Peter also speaks of this: "He himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed" (1 Peter 2:24). The truth is that Jesus offered Himself as the sacrifice for our sins. We do not understand this as well because we do not think our sins are that bad. Jesus didn't need to go through all of that for me.

Pray this week through these two understandings of Jesus' passion. Allow the Lord to show you the reality of His love and the reality of our sin. Next time we will tackle the third way of understanding His passion.

Gold: Elgin Mental Health Center-Men and Women




