THE KERYGMA, PART 4: Our Response

Given what Jesus has done for us, what should our response be? What is the reasonable response to someone who

saves you from death? What is the sensible response to someone who rescues you from Hell? What is the generous response to someone who has bound the strong man so you can go free? Isn't it reasonable to trust him? Isn't it wise to surrender to him? And isn't it sensible to tell others of this Good News?

I genuinely believe that when we allow the Good News to penetrate our hearts, our only response is to give Him everything. Imagine you are under the reign of a tyrant. There is no hope of escape only a life of pain and struggle, and you are powerless against your oppressor. You are utterly dependent on being saved by someone outside of this situation. Along comes the long-awaited One who has come to rescue you from the tyrant. He gave everything to save you. How would you respond to Him? Would your heart not be full of love and gratitude? Now imagine your

savior is also the God who created you. Is He not worthy of your love? Is He not worthy of your life? Is He not deserving of your trust?

My friends, our God is a God full of mercy and compassion. He is a God who wants to share His life and love with us, His creatures. Our response must be a daily resounding yes, reverberating through every aspect of our lives. Get rid of whatever keeps you from going all-in with the Lord because the Lord went ALL-IN for you!

Baptism: Children of all ages and adults are welcome to the sacrament of Baptism. Baptism for children is celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month at 1:00pm. Parents need to be registered members and should be faithful in attending Mass. Participation in a baptismal preparation class is required. 


