#### Q. & A. with Fr. Browning

## Q: Who is eligible to receive the Eucharist or Holy Communion?

A: Those who wish to receive the Eucharist should first be in a state of grace – a spiritual state of purity. If one knowingly commits a grave sin, receiving the sacrament of Confession before partaking in the Eucharist is required. One should refrain from receiving the Eucharist with unconfessed mortal sin because it will compound the sin (see 1 Corinthians 11:27-30).

## Q: How can one receive the Eucharist – on the tongue or in the hand?

A: The traditional practice is to receive the Eucharist on the tongue, but the Holy See has also granted permission for receiving in the hand.

## Q: What is the most essential aspect of receiving the Eucharist?

A: It's essential to approach the Eucharist with a deep awareness of the Real presence of Christ and a profound reverence for this divine gift. The Eucharist is the Jesus. So, this gift needs to be received with as much attention and commitment to Christ. We should be worthy vessels prepared to receive God's greatest gift – the Eucharist.

#### Q: Who should refrain from receiving the Eucharist?

A: Those who are not yet baptized or are below the age of 7, individuals conscious of unconfessed mortal sin, and those whose marriage hasn't been validated within the Church should seek spiritual guidance and the necessary sacraments before receiving the Eucharist. Reach out to one of our priests. We are happy to help.

## Q: What if I haven't had the chance to go to Confession before Communion?

A: If you could not get to Confession before Mass, remaining seated during Communion is more authentic than receiving the Eucharist with grave sin. While attending Mass is obligatory, receiving the Eucharist is required only once a year.

## Q: Is there a way to spiritually connect when unable to receive the Eucharist?

A: Absolutely. You can practice Spiritual Communion

– a way to express your longing for Christ's
presence when physical reception isn't possible.

**Spiritual Communion Prayer:** My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

Remember, these guidelines are rooted in the rich traditions of the Church and are meant to enhance your spiritual journey and connection with God.

#### **LETTER** from Fr. Browning

We will continue our journey through the Catechism of the Catholic Church and its teaching on the Eucharist, paragraphs 1328-1332. The Church speaks of the Holy Eucharist using different terms, and each one evokes a particular aspect of the Eucharist. These additional terms give us a 360-degree view of the great mystery of the Eucharist.

The first term the Church uses is the Eucharist, It comes from the Greek term, which means thanksgiving. The Eucharist is an action of thanksgiving of Jesus to the Father on our behalf, and He invites us to enter into this thanksgiving (see CCC 1328).

In paragraph 1329, it is called the Lord's Supper. Jesus instituted the pattern of this sacrifice in the context of the Jewish Passover on the night before he offered the sacrifice on the Cross. The Last Supper anticipates the wedding feast of the Lamb in the heavenly Jerusalem (Revelation 19:9).

The Breaking of the Bread is an ancient name for the Mass and Eucharist. Jesus, in the miracles of the loaves and fish and at the Last Supper - takes, blesses, **breaks**, and gives. The two disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35) only recognize Him after the Resurrection in the **breaking of the bread**. The early Christians used this term to describe the Mass, pointing to how God brings us

A denarius is equivalent to a daily wage equally received by all workers in the vineyard. The early workers complained about the seemingly unfair treatment by the landowner. But he did not violate any law or their own agreement. He was just exercising his right to be generous. If he

work, the late comers would only receive few penny that could not feed a whole family for a day. The landowner had just been so considerate of their basic needs and welfare. God rewards and blesses us according to His will and pleasure, not necessarily according to what we deserve. God follows the system of grace and not law. Thus, we are always going to notice that in terms of blessings in this world, we will never be equal. The key to happiness is to be

appreciative of what is on our hands.

into communion (common union) with Him and one another. This union is seen in another term used, the Eucharistic assembly, because it is the visible expression of the Church gathered with our Lord.

In paragraph 1330, the Church reminds us that Mass is a **memorial** of the Lord's Passion and Resurrection. Jesus said do this in remembrance of me. Another term used by the Church is the Holy Sacrifice. The Mass re-presents or makes present to us the one sacrifice of the Cross. It is the perfect sacrifice offered once in time but continually in eternity for the salvation of the world. We are brought real and spiritually to the foot of the Cross at each Mass. We must unite ourselves with this sacrifice, bringing our sacrifices to His.

We may also hear the term the Sacred Mysteries, and we speak of the Eucharist as the Most Blessed Sacrament as it is the Sacrament of sacraments.

The final two that round out our 360-view are familiar - Holy Communion and Holy Mass. Holy meaning set apart. Holy Mass is where we can leave the world behind and be with God. Our silence when we come into Church prepares us to leave the world and let God be our focus and let us better hear His voice. Holy Communion unites us to God through the reception of His body, blood, soul, and divinity. The adjective Holy reminds us of our need to prepare to receive this gift in the state of grace, having confessed any mortal sins sacramentally beforehand.

The terms used for the Eucharist and Holy Mass throughout the life of the Church can instruct us on the different aspects of this eternal gift of God. We can meditate on each name and it will guide us into a deeper appreciation for the Sacred Mysteries that leads us to Heaven.


